### SETTING THE SCENE

Coming off a 25-point win over Lafayette to open Patriot League play on Friday, the Lehigh women's basketball team will welcome Navy to Stabler Arena on Tuesday evening. Lehigh holds a strong 5-1 record at home this season, however Navy carries an 11-1 record into Stabler and is receiving votes for the first time this season in the latest Associated Press Top 25 Poll.

In Friday's matinee against Lafayette, the Mountain Hawks tied a school record with 15 three-pointers, putting the game away with a 29-4 run that spanned much of the third and fourth quarters. Camryn Buhr tied for a game-high 17 points while shooting 4-for-4 from three-point range. Quinci Mann added four triples of her own for 16 points and six rebounds. Gena Grundhoffer scored 11 points, Hannah Hedstrom came away with five rebounds and a career-high five steals, and Bernadette Devaney dished out a team-leading five assists.

Navy and Lehigh rank atop the league in three-point percentage and defensive rebounds.

Following Tuesday's clash, Lehigh will hit the road for the first time in league play to take on Holy Cross (6-6) on Friday evening.

### IF LEHIGH BEATS NAVY

- Lehigh would improve to 2-0 in Patriot League play for just the second time in eight seasons
- Lehigh would beat Navy at Stabler Arena for the first time since Feb. 22, 2012 (has lost 6 in a row at home).

### LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 353-313 into Tuesday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

### **ALL-TIME VS. NAVY**

Lehigh enters Tuesday's matchup with a 27-32 all-time record against the Midshipmen. Navy has controlled the tempo in the series in recent years, having won 11 of the last 12 matchups dating back to the Patriot League Tournament in March 2012. The teams are deadlocked at 15-15 all-time at Stabler Arena.

Since splitting two games in 2011, Lehigh took both regular season contests from Navy in 2012 before Navy won eight straight and swept the season series from 2013-2015. The two split the season series in 2015-16.

Each team has had an eight game winning streak during the course of the 58 matchups in the series, with Lehigh's coming from 2001-2004, and Navy's from 2012-2015. Lehigh also had a six game win streak from 2008-2010, and Navy has had a pair of five-game streaks.

Navy went 2-1 against Lehigh in the 1980s, with their first matchup coming in the 1981-82 season. Navy held a 12-6 advantage in the 1990s, and Lehigh dominated in the 2000s by winning 14 of the 20 games. Since 2010, Navy holds a 12-6 record.

### SCOUTING THE MIDSHIPMEN

Off to the best start in the Patriot League this season, Navy enters Tuesday's matchup with an 11-1 (1-0 PL) record, coming off a 73-44 win over Loyola at home on Friday. For the first time this season, Navy received a vote in the AP Top 25 Poll released on Jan. 1.

The team's only loss came on Dec. 10 in overtime at New Mexico, who is also receiving votes, when they set a Patriot League record with 16 three-pointers.

The Mids lead the Patriot League in numerous categories this season, including points (75.8), scoring defense (56.5), field goal pct. (42.3), 3pt percentage (35.0), 3-pointers per game (9.2) and assists (17.7). They are also the only PL team to have a scoring margin in double digits (+19.3).

Defensively, Navy is tops in the league in scoring defense, allowing just 56.5 points per game. They lead the league with 11.4 steals, a +5.4 turnover margin, are second in blocked shots (3.7) and are holding opponents to just 29.5 percent shooting from the outside.

Navy shoots particularly well from long range, where seniors Taylor Dunham (2.8) and Hannah Fenske (2.6) are tops in the league in three-pointers made per game. Sophomore Morgan Taylor boasts the best 3FG percentage in the league at 47.8 percent and Fenske ranks third at 43.7 percent.

Navy is 2-0 against common opponents this season, while Lehigh is 1-1 with both teams topping Monmouth by double digits, and Lehigh falling at LIU Brooklyn.

### **NAVY HEAD COACH STEFANIE PEMPER**

Stepfanie Pemper is in the midst of her 10th season as the head coach of Navy. Pemper led the Mids to winning records in eight of her first nine seasons, and Navy has never finished under .500 during her tenure. Pemper is a two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year (2011 and 2014).

Pemper has been at the helm for three 20-win seasons in 2010-11, 2012-13 and 2016-17, and the Mids have finished no lower than tied for third five times under her. Navy became just the second program in Patriot League history to win three consecutive tournament titles from 2011-2013. The 2014 season saw Navy win a program record 24 games before advancing to the first round of the WNIT.

Pemper arrived at Navy after posting a 235-48 record as the head coach of Bowdoin. Her 10-year winning percentage of 83 percent ranked fourth in NCAA Division III history upon her departure. She was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2009.

A native of Huntington Beach, Calif., the two-time All-Big Sky honoree graduated from Idaho State in 1992 and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2003.

### STARTING OFF LEAGUE PLAY

Lehigh is now 18-10 all-time in Patriot League openers, but has started 2-0 in the league only once (2014-15) over the last seven seasons.

### MUCH OF THE SAME

Lehigh and Navy are two of just three teams (American) in the Patriot League to have the same starting five players in all 12 games this season. Lehigh and Navy have two seniors in their starting lineups, while American boasts three.

### BLOCK PARTY COMES TO BETHLEHEM

Navy and Lehigh rank second and third, respectively, in the Patriot League in blocks per game. Navy rejects 3.7 shots per game with Lehigh not far behind with 3.5 blocks per čontest.

Lehigh recorded six blocks in its Dec. 6 win over NJIT, their most in a game since rejecting 11 shots vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 19, 2013.

### PARTYING IT UP DOWNTOWN

Lehigh tied a school record with 15 three-pointers on Friday against Lafayette, shooting 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from downtown. Navy leads the league by shooting 35 percent from three-point range and set a new Patriot League record on with 16 triples in their overtime loss at New Mexico on Dec. 10.

The two teams find themselves atop the Patriot League in 3FG percentage this season (Navy-1st/35.0%) and Lehigh (2nd/33.6%).

### **HOLIDAY THIEF**

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom has a combined nine steals over the last two games. She notched four steals at LIU Brooklyn on Dec. 10 and collected five more on Dec. 29 against Lafayette. She leads the team with 19 total steals (1.6 per game) this season.

### MANN'S MILESTONES

Senior Quinci Mann is just three three-pointers away from passing Erica Prosser '11 for third place on the school's career three-point field goals list. She enters Tuesday's matchup with 164 triples for her career.

Earlier this year, she sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's and connected on four in her last game vs. Lafayette. This season, she ranks eighth in the Patriot League with 12.7 ppg and is T-5th with 1.8 3FG/game.

### BERNING THE OPPOSITION IN DIFFERENT WAYS

Senior Bernadette Devaney dished out a career-high five assists against Lafayette on Dec. 29, while scoring six points on a pair of three-pointers.

She had a strong finish to non-league play, averaging 11.8 points over the last four non-league games. It began with a career-best 20-point performance on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's, besting her previous career-high of 13, which she had done three times. She also knocked down a career-best six three pointers on 6-of-9 shooting in the game. Over a three-game stretch from 11/29 to 12/6, she had 40 points on 12-of-25 shooting and 11-of-18 from three-point range.

### FINISHING STRONG

The fourth quarter has been the Mountain Hawks best quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 17.5-13.8. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter of only one game this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in all other quarters.

In their last game, Lehigh held Lafayette to just five points on 1-of-17 shooting in the fourth quarter.

### **EDUCATION DAY**

Lehigh hosted its eighth annual Education Day on Dec. 6 with a 64-50 win over NJIT. LU welcomed 4,009 elementary and middle school students from Bethlehem and Allentown to Stabler Arena, which was the third largest crowd in program history. Last year's event against Delaware State drew a LU women's basketball record crowd of 4,410, surpassing the previous benchmark of 4,078 that was set on Dec. 2, 2014 against Hampton.

### LIVING DOWNTOWN

Lehigh registered its best shooting night of the season against Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29, when they shot 50 percent overall and 56.5 percent from three-point range and drained 13 three-pointers in the game.

### **CRASHING THE BOARDS**

Lafayette became just the second team this season, along with La Salle, to outrebound Lehigh in a game. Through the first 12 games, Lehigh holds a rebounding margin of +2.9, which ranks fourth in the Patriot League, and the team has climbed to has high as second in that category this season. Lehigh also ranks second PL in defensive rebounding (28.0).

Last season, Lehigh's rebounding margin through its non-league schedule (11 games) was -2.0.

### PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

Lehigh was picked seventh in the Patriot League Preseason Poll and is looking to rebound after a ninth place finish in last year's Patriot League standings. LU fell in the first round of the league tournament to Loyola. It was the first time Lehigh had failed to qualify for at least the semifinals since the league went to the current tournament format in 2013-14.

### **LAST TIME OUT FOR LEHIGH**

### **DECEMBER 29, 2017 LEHIGH 70, LAFAYETTE 45**

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – The Lehigh women's basketball team tied a school record with 15 three-pointers to power past Lafayette 70-45 in Friday afternoon's Patriot League opener at Stabler Arena. Sophomore Camryn Buhr was a perfect 4-for-4 from three-point range and 4-for-8 overall with a teamomore Camryn Buhr was a pertect 4-tor-4 from three-point range and 4-for-8 overall with a teamhigh 17 points, adding four assists and three steals. Senior Quinci Mann scored 16 points on 5-of-8 shooting, including four three-pointers and added a team-leading six rebounds. Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer added 11 points and five rebounds on 4-of-6 shooting. Hannah Hedstrom (career-high five steals), Bernadette Devaney (career-high five assists) and Mary Clougherty all scored six points and combined for five three-pointers. Lafayette's Natalie Kucowski had a double-double with 17 points and a game-high 14 rebounds. Lehigh improves to 7-5 (1-0 PL) on the season while the Leopards fall to 4-7 (0-1 PL).

As a team, Lehigh shot 43.8 percent from the field and 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from beyond the arc, compared to 30 percent (6-for-20) on two-pointers. Lafayette shot 27.4 percent (17-for-62) overall and 21.4 percent (3-for-14) from three-point land. The 45 points surrendered by the Mountain Hawks' defense was also a season low.

The single-game program record of 15 three-pointers was previously achieved by Lehigh on Dec. 20, 2008 vs. Binghamton at Stabler Arena.

"We can put a lot of different looks on the court that can knock down the three," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We're a pretty tough team to zone when we execute well. The 20-day break with finals and Christmas did allow us to get in the gym a lot and that was probably one of the most critical points of just getting better. Our emphasis over the last three weeks was making sure we get better individually and get better collectively as a group. The hard work that they've put in these last three weeks really showed on the court today."

After falling behind 2-0, Mann rattled off seven straight points to give Lehigh the early edge. Kucowski scored Lafayette's first eight points to get the Leopards within 10-8 at the first media timeout. Devaney hit back-to-back threes coming out of the break and Hedstrom added a layup to make it 18-10 at the 2:18 mark. The Mountain Hawks used a trio of free throws to go 21-16 after one quarter, shooting 6-for-11 in the frame.

Lehigh opened the second quarter on an 8-0 run to take a 29-16 lead, thanks to five straight from Grundhoffer and a three-pointer by Mann, forcing a Lafayette timeout at the 8:15 mark. After getting the lead up to 31-18, the Leopards would get back within 33-27 with just over two minutes remaining in the half. Buhr broke the run with a three pointer and Mann followed by beating the buzzer to give LU the 39-27 lead at halftime.

"We knew they were going to come in and play a lot of zone," Troyan said. "The focus really over the last two weeks was on executing against the zone. I thought our kids came in and played good basketball on both ends of the floor. It was a game we really needed in terms of confidence and starting Patriot League play on the right foot.'

Lafayette crept back within five points after starting the third on a 9-2 run, before Lehigh went on a 9-0 run of their own as Buhr buried two straight three-pointers to make it 47-36, forcing a Lafayette timeout. Mann followed with another three to make it 50-36 at the 4:30 mark and Buhr grew the lead to 59-40 by banking in an off balance three-point buzzer beater from in front of the Lehigh bench as the third quarter expired.

The Mountain Hawks' defense held strong in the fourth quarter, holding the Leopards to just 1-for-17 and kept them off the scoreboard for nearly the first eight minutes of the period, while Lehigh went on a 14-0 run, including 11 straight to begin the quarter. Mae Williams started the frame with a pair of free throws, Clougherty followed with back-to-back threes and Cameryn Benz hit from downtown to make it 70-40, before Lafayette closed the game with five straight points over the final 2:06.

Mann and Hedstrom, two of Lehigh's starting guards, led the team in rebounds with six and five, respectively.

"We're going to need that from our guard play," Troyan said. "I thought both Quinci and Hannah played really well. Hannah was really tough on the defensive end and did a really good job of controlling the game on both ends of the floor. Quinci hit big shots early in the game for us and played well on the defensive end, rebounded and had a really complete game.
