SETTING THE SCENE

Coming off their most impressive win of the season on Tuesday, the Lehigh women's basketball team will face its first Patriot League road test on Friday when they travel to Holy Cross. The Mountain Hawks are off to a 2-0 start in league play after a pair of home wins over Lafayette and Navy, where they combined to shoot nearly 43 percent from the field and 50 percent (23-for-56) from three-point range.

In Tuesday's victory over Navy, Camryn Buhr picked up her second double-double of the season and Quinci Mann hit her 167th career three-pointer, moving her into third place on the school's all-time list. Lehigh held the Midshipmen to 37.7 percent shooting from the floor and 20 percent from long range, while improving their own three-point percentage to a league best 34.4 percent. Mann is averaging 18.5 points through the first two league games, good enough for third in the PL, while Buhr's 16 ppg is tied for sixth.

Holy Cross enters with the second-highest scoring offense in the league this season, and is coming off a home loss to Lafayette on Tuesday after taking their league opener by seven points at Colgate last week.

IF LEHIGH BEATS HOLY CROSS

- Lehigh would start Patriot League play 3-0 for just the second time in the last 10 seasons (2014-15).
- Lehigh would end a two-game losing streak at Holy Cross and their current two-game road losing streak.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 354-313 into Friday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. HOLY CROSS

Despite winning 17 of the last 22 matchups against Holy Cross since 2009, Lehigh still trails 42-23 in the all-time series. The two teams have split the pair of regular season matchups each of the last two seasons.

Lehigh defeated Holy Cross in the Patriot League Tournament in both 2015 and 2016, but Lehigh has dropped both road games each of the last two seasons in Worcester, including last year's 65-47 decision. Hailey Pascoe (16 pts) and Quinci Mann (15) led Lehigh, which was held to 30.8 percent shooting in the game while Holy Cross shot at 40.4 percent and had three players in double figures. The script flipped at Stabler Arena on Feb. 11 as Lehigh shot 52.1 percent and was 10-for-20 from 3pt range in one of their best games of the season, an 80-64 win with Mann (23) and Grundhoffer (20) both scoring 20+ points.

Both teams have enjoyed prolonged winning streaks in the series history, with Lehigh winning 10 straight from 2009-2013, and Holy Cross winning 18 straight as part of 26 wins in 27 games against Lehigh from 1991 to 2001.

SCOUTING THE CRUSADERS

Off to a 1-1 start in Patriot League play, Holy Cross has defeated Colgate 71-64 on the road and dropped a 69-65 decision to Lafayette at home on Tuesday. Lafayette is the only common opponent between the two schools so far this season.

Boasting the league's two leading scorers in Lauren Manis (18.3 ppg) and Infiniti Thomas-Waheed (18.1), HC enters the matchup with the second-highest scoring offense in the Patriot League at 69.3 points per game. On Tuesday vs. Lafayette, Manis scored 26 points on 9-of-20 shooting, but HC struggled to shoot just 31 percent. Thomas-Waheed scored 14 points and senior Katie Doherty added nine.

The Crusaders +2.8 scoring margin ranks fourth in the league, one spot ahead of Lehigh. HC is second in the PL, just behind Lehigh, with a 34.3 3FG%, and is also just behind the Mountain Hawks in field goal pct (40.2). Defensively, HC controls the glass with a rebounding margin of -3.1, good enough for seventh in the league while ranking third in steals and turnover margin.

Manis, the reigning PL Rookie of the Year, ranks sixth in the PL at 8.6 rebounds per game and is tops in the league at 78.7 percent from the free throw line. Thomas-Waheed became the 33rd player in program history to collect 1,000 career points in the team's overtime loss to Dartmouth on Dec. 20.

Senior guard Tricia Byrne averages 8.4 ppg while shooting 41.8 percent from the field and 40.5 percent from beyond the arc. Sophomore Kathryn Pedi (47.6%) and Madalyn Smith (39.5%) are also threats from downtown.

HOLY CROSS HEAD COACH BILL GIBBONS

Bill Gibbons is in his 33rd season at the helm of the Holy Cross women's basketball program, and his 37th season as part of the Holy Cross athletic department. He is the winningest coach in the history of the program, leading the Crusaders to an overall mark of 589-383 in his first 31 seasons.

On Dec. 3, 2011, Gibbons earned his 500th victory as Holy Cross' head coach; becoming the 24th active Division I coach to reach 500 wins. He crossed the 550-win plateau on Feb. 19, 2014.

The sixth coach of the women's program at Holy Cross, Gibbons has enjoyed the longest tenure in the position. He has led the Holy Cross women's basketball program to more victories than any other coach, and is the winningest coach in Holy Cross basketball history.

A Worcester native, Gibbons graduated from Clark University in 1981. He then went on to earn a master's degree in business administration from Clark while serving as an assistant coach for the Holy Cross men's basketball team.

STARTING OFF LEAGUE PLAY

Lehigh is 2-0 in Patriot League play for just the second time in the last seven seasons (2014-15). Lehigh has only started 3-0 once in the last nine seasons (also 2014-15).

FLYING TO THE TOP

After Tuesday's game, Lehigh has moved into the top spot in the Patriot League with a 34.4 3FG percentage, just ahead of Holy Cross' 34.3 percentage. Over the last two games, both in league play, Lehigh is hitting exactly 50 percent (23-for-56) from three-point range.

Lehigh tied a school record with 15 three-pointers on Dec. 29 against Lafayette, shooting 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from downtown, one shy of Navy's Patriot League record of 16, which they set at New Mexico on Dec. 10.

IT TAKES TWO

Camryn Buhr (15) and Hannah Hedstrom (11) both recorded double-digit rebounds in Tuesday's win over Navy, marking the first time Lehigh had two players with 10+ rebounds since Lexi Martins (15) and Kerry Kinek (10) on Feb. 13, 2016 in an overtime defeat at Holy Cross.

BETHLEHEM BLOCK PARTY

Lehigh ranks third in the Patriot League by rejecting 3.5 shots per game.

Lehigh recorded six blocks in its Dec. 6 win over NJIT, their most in a game since rejecting 11 shots vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 19, 2013.

A HED ABOVE THE REST

Sophomore point guard Hannah Hedstrom pulled in a career-high 11 rebounds in Tuesday's win over Navy, marking the first time she's had double digit rebounds in her career. She is averaging 7.3 boards per game over the last three games and six boards over her last five games.

She has a combined 10 steals over the last three games, including nine over a two-game stretch. She notched four steals at LIU Brooklyn on Dec. 10 and collected five more on Dec. 29 against Lafayette. She leads the team with 20 total steals (1.5 per game) this season.

Hedstrom also ranks third in the league with 3.9 assists per game.

MANN'S MILESTONES

Senior Quinci Mann moved into third place on Lehigh's career three-point list on Tuesday night with her 167th career three-pointer, passing Erica Prosser '11. She also moved into 12th place on the school's all-time scoring list.

Through the first two league games, Mann is 7-for-12 from long range and ranks second in the league by averaging 18.5 ppg.

Earlier this year, she sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's. This season, she ranks seventh overall in the Patriot League with 13.3 ppg and is T-5th with 1.8 3FG/game.

BERNING THE OPPOSITION IN DIFFERENT WAYS

Senior Bernadette Devaney dished out a career-high five assists against Lafayette on Dec. 29, while scoring six points on a pair of three-pointers.

She had a strong finish to non-league play, averaging 11.8 points over the last four non-league games. It began with a career-best 20-point performance on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's, besting her previous career-high of 13, which she had done three times. She also knocked down a career-best six three pointers on 6-of-9 shooting in the game. Over a three-game stretch from 11/29 to 12/6, she had 40 points on 12-of-25 shooting and 11-of-18 from three-point range.

FINISHING STRONG

The Mountain Hawks have been at their best in the fourth quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 17.4-13.8. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in the first and third quarters.

On Dec. 29, Lehigh held Lafayette to just five points on 1-of-17 shooting in the fourth quarter.

EDUCATION DAY

Lehigh hosted its eighth annual Education Day on Dec. 6 with a 64-50 win over NJIT. LU welcomed 4,009 elementary and middle school students from Bethlehem and Allentown to Stabler Arena, which was the third largest crowd in program history. Last year's event against Delaware State drew a LU women's basketball record crowd of 4,410, surpassing the previous benchmark of 4,078 that was set on Dec. 2, 2014 against Hampton.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

On Dec. 29, Lafayette became just the second team this season, along with La Salle, to outrebound Lehigh in a game. Through the first 13 games, Lehigh holds a rebounding margin of +3.2, which ranks fourth in the Patriot League, with the team having climbed to as high as second in that category this season. Lehigh also ranks T-2nd in the PL in defensive rebounding (28.2).

Last season, Lehigh's rebounding margin through its non-league schedule (11 games) was

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – A last second game-tying three-point attempt from Navy rattled out as the Lehigh women's basketball team hung on for a thrilling 66-63 victory on Tuesday night at Stabler Arena. Senior Quinci Mann led all scorers with 21 points and moved into third place all-time on the school's career three-point list. Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her second double-double of the season with 15 points and 11 rebounds, sophomore Gena Grundhoffer scored 14 points and sophomore Hannah Hedstrom had five assists and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds. Lehigh finished the game 24-of-57 (42.1 percent) from the field and outrebounded the Midshipmen 39-32. Lehigh held Navy, who received votes in this week's AP Top 25 poll, to just 37.7 percent (23-of-61) from the field and just 20 percent from three-point range, well below their Patriot League leading averages of 42.3 percent and 35 percent, respectively. Lehigh moves to 8-5 overall (2-0 PL), while Navy drops to 11-2

"Early in the season this is an important win for us," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We talk about "Early in the season this is an important win for us," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We talk about protecting our home court, and in this league that is going to be really important. This game tonight is probably going to be indicative of a lot of games in this league because I don't think there's a big difference between the top and the bottom. It was good being in a close game like this, having to execute down the stretch and pulling it out is probably a sign of things we'll see in the rest of the year. It's certainly a big confidence booster coming in and getting a win over a good Navy win."

Lehigh started the game 1-for-8 before Buhr added a putback layup to cut the early deficit to 7-5 headed into the first media timeout. Cameryn Benz drained back-to-back three-pointers to give Lehigh its first lead of the game at the 3:36 mark before Navy, retook the lead and carried a 19-15 edge into the second. into the second.

Holding the lead through most of the second quarter, the Mids scored four straight to take a gamehigh 34-27 lead, forcing a Lehigh timeout with 3:47 to go until halftime. Coming out of the timeout, the Mountain Hawks exploded on a 12-0 run to close the half and take a 39-34 lead into the locker room. Buhr started the run with a jumper, and then followed with another trey on the break after grabbing a steal to make it 34-31. Following a missed Navy layup, Mann knocked down a three to knot the score 34, and Benz tacked on a layup to give Lehigh the lead back at 36-34 in the final minute. After another Navy miss, Hedstrom fed Mary Clougherty on the left wing, who swished home a three at the buzzer to cap a spectacular end to the half and give LU the five-point lead.

Navy was just 2-of-9 from three-point range in the opening 20 minutes, while Lehigh connected on 53.3 percent of their shots and hit 54.5 percent from the outside.

"This is a team that has a lot of good weapons," Troyan said. "Last year we ran a lot of our offense through Quinci. We've changed up a lot this year and Quinci, to her benefit, she has bought into it. The ball was not in her hands as much but tonight was a night where we called her number a lot. Every time we called her number she stepped up and made big shots for us. Cam Buhr and Gena made big shots for us. Hannah distributed the ball well and did a great job rebounding. Cam Benz in the first half had a big stretch for us by hitting some big threes. This is a team that has a lot of different weapons. That will be a strength going through the rest of the league."

Navy hovered within four points the entire third quarter, pulling within one in the first three minutes before eventually tying the score at 44 with 3:45 on the clock. Navy took the lead off two free throws moments later before Buhr retied it with a layup and Mann followed with a bucket to go up 48-46. Navy would retake the lead once again before Grundhoffer used a pair of free throws to give LU the 50-49 edge heading into the fourth quarter.

Navy tied the game 54-54 with 7:17 remaining before the Mountain Hawks took the lead for good off a Mann three with 7:02 remaining. However, Navy hung tough, never letting the deficit grow to more than five and battled back within three with 3:47 to go and got within two after a free throw with 1:26 remaining. After Mae Williams made it a three-point game once again with a free throw, both teams traded long range misses, before Hedstrom forced a Navy turnover underneath the basket with 18

Mann hit two free throws after getting fouled on the inbounds pass to make it a 66-61 game, and Navy got within one possession with a jumper to make it 66-63 with six seconds left. After a LU timeout, Navy stole the ensuing inbounds pass and Lehigh quickly fouled with one second left, leaving time for one last Navy heave to force overtime.
