SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will return home to start a two-game homestand on Monday night when they host Boston University. Stabler Arena has been friendly to the Mountain Hawks this season, where Lehigh is off to a 6-1 start, their best home start since 2010-11. Lehigh will be looking to get back on track after a five-point setback on Friday at Holy Cross. Camryn Buhr picked up her second consecutive double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds and Gena Grundhoffer added 10 points on 5-of-10 shooting.

Through the first three games of Patriot League play, Lehigh leads the league in three-point percentage (.441), is second in scoring margin (+7.7) and is third by allowing just 54 points per game. The Mountain Hawks will be challenged Monday by a Boston team that is also off to a 2-1 league start, which includes a 60-59 road win at preseason league co-favorite Army West Point, a five-point home loss to the other co-favorite Bucknell and a 19-point home win Friday vs. Loyola. Both Lehigh and BU rank in the top three in the league in three-point percentage, and the Terriers are second in the league in field goal percentage (41.2) and are shooting a league-best 45 percent from the field in their three league games.

Following Monday's matchup, Lehigh will host in-state foe Bucknell on Thursday evening.

IF LEHIGH BEATS BOSTON U.

- Lehigh would extend its home court winning streak to five games.
- Lehigh would improve to 7-1 at home, their best start at home since they went 16-0 in 2009-10. Lehigh is currently 6-1 for the first time since 2010-11.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 354-314 into Monday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. BOSTON UNIVERSITY

The Mountain Hawks enter Monday 5-6 all-time against Boston U. Lehigh has won five of the last eight meetings between the two schools dating back to when BU joined the Patriot League in 2013.

After the Terriers won the first four matchups in the series, Lehigh won five straight from February 2014 to January 2016 before BU won both matchups last season.

The last time the teams met at Stabler Arena on Jan. 2, 2016, BU overcame a 16-point deficit with just over five minutes remaining to stun Lehigh 69-64, outscoring LU 37-17 in the fourth quarter, including a 17-1 run over the final 3:38.

BU is Lehigh's least frequent league opponent, with the next closest being Loyola (15 games). Lehigh's highest scoring output came on Jan. 3, 2015 when the Mountain Hawks put up 85. The largest margin of victory for either side came in Lehigh's 28-point, 72-44 win on Dec. 30, 2012.

Lehigh holds a 3-3 record against BU at Stabler Arena and is 2-3 on the road

SCOUTING THE TERRIERS

Boston University enters Monday's matchup having won two of their last three games and coming off a 75-56 win over Loyola on Friday. BU previously defeated Army 60-59 on the road on Dec. 29 and fell 63-58 at home to Bucknell on Jan. 2.

The Terriers held Loyola to just 27.3 percent shooting from the floor in Friday's win as BU shot a season-best 56.1 percent from the floor, including an 8-for-11 clip in the third quarter. Sophomore Nia Irving led BU in scoring (11) and rebounding (7), freshman Katie Nelson registered 16 points and senior Sophie Beaudry added 11.

Irving leads the team with 11.7 points and 6.9 rebounds per game this season, and ranks fifth in the league with a .492 field goal percentage. She has four double-doubles on the season and was named the Patriot League Player of the Week after scoring 22 points and 14 rebounds in BU's win at Army on Dec 29.

Nelson has been a force in her first season, leading the league with 4.5 assists per game, including 5.7 assists per game in league play. She is second in the PL with 2.4 triples per game and is third with a .449 3FG percentage.

As a team, BU leads the league in 3FG pct. (.345) and blocks per game (5.77), and ranks second in field goal pct. (.412). BU has registered at least five blocks per game in each of their last five games, led by Beaudry, who is tops in the PL with 2.2 blocks per game.

BOSTON UNIVERSITY HEAD COACH KATY STEDING

Katy Steding is in her fourth season as the Terrier's head coach. A 16-year coaching veteran, Steding came to BU after spending two seasons at California where she helped lead the Golden Bears to their first Pac-12 title and a pair of trips to the NCAA Tournament. Before joining the coaching staff at Cal, Steding was an associate head coach at the University of San Francisco from 2010-12, an assistant at Columbia in 2009-10, and an assistant for the WNBA's Atlanta Dream in 2008.

BU is Steding's second head-coaching position, as she spent seven seasons at the helm of the Warner Pacific College (NAIA) program in her native Oregon, helping it transition from a club-level program to a varsity team.

A three-time Pac-10 All-Conference selection at Stanford, Steding helped lead the Cardinal to their first NCAA Championship in 1990.

Steding graduated from Stanford in 1990 with a degree in psychology, embarked on a professional playing career overseas, and earned a spot on the U.S. National Team in 1995. The team compiled a 60-0 record that culminated with a gold medal at the 1996 Atlanta Olympics. Steding played professionally in the American Basketball League before playing with the Sacramento Monarchs and Seattle Storm of the WNBA. She retired from professional basketball in 2001.

HEATING UP AT HOME

Lehigh has been hot shooting the ball over their last two home games, shooting exactly 50 percent (23-for-56) from three-point range and 42.9 percent (45-for-105) overall.

Lehigh tied a school record with 15 three-pointers on Dec. 29 against Lafayette, shooting 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from downtown.

Since the start of Patriot League play, Lehigh has held opponents to 20.8 percent (11-for-53) from three-point range and 35.3 percent overall.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr has picked up double-doubles in her last two games with 15 points and 11 rebounds against Lafayette, and 12 points and 10 rebounds against Navy.

She has scored at least 12 points in five of her last six games and has scored in double digits nine times this season.

She is first in the PL during league play with a .715 (5-for-7) 3FG%.

A HED ABOVE THE REST

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom has emerged as one of Lehigh's top rebounding threats, in addition to being among the league leaders in assists. Over the last four games, she leads the team with 7.8 rebounds per game.

She ranks fifth in the Patriot League during league play, leading the team with 8.3 rebounds per game. She has collected at least five rebounds in each of her last four games.

She has collected at least three steals in four games this season and leads the team with 1.5 steals per game this year.

Hedstrom also ranks third in the league with 3.7 assists per game.

She is the only Patriot League player to rank in the top 10 in both rebounding and assists during league play.

TOP WOMANN

Senior Quinci Mann leads the Patriot League during league play with 2.7 three-pointers per game.

MANN'S MILESTONES

Quinci Mann moved into third place on Lehigh's career three-point list last Tuesday vs. Navy, passing Erica Prosser '11.

She is currently 12th on the school's all-time scoring list, just 51 points away from entering the top 10.

Earlier this year, she sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's. This season, she ranks seventh overall in the Patriot League with 12.9 ppg and is 6th with $1.8\ 3FG/game$.

BLOCK PARTY COMES TO BETHLEHEM

Lehigh ranks tied for third in the Patriot League by rejecting 3.1 shots per game, and Boston U. leads the Patriot League by a wide margin with 5.8 blocks per game (2.4 more than second place Navy). The Terriers have blocked at least five shots in each of their last five games.

Lehigh recorded six blocks in its Dec. 6 win over NJIT, their most in a game since rejecting 11 shots vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 19, 2013.

FINISHING STRONG

The Mountain Hawks have been at their best in the fourth quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 16.8-13.3. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in the first and third quarters.

On Dec. 29, Lehigh held Lafayette to just five points on 1-of-17 shooting in the fourth quarter.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Lehigh has outrebounded their opponents in 11 of their 14 games this season. However, Lehigh has been outrebounded in two of their three games thus far in Patriot League play.

Through the first 14 games, Lehigh holds a rebounding margin of ± 2.9 , which ranks fourth in the Patriot League.

PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

Lehigh was picked seventh in the Patriot League Preseason Poll and is looking to rebound after a ninth place finish in last year's Patriot League standings. LU fell in the first round of the league tournament to Loyola. It was the first time Lehigh had failed to qualify for at least the semifinals since the league went to the current tournament format in 2013-14.

WORCESTER, Mass. - It was tale of two halves for the Lehigh women's basketball team on Friday night, as a strong second half rally fell short in a 54-49 defeat at Holy Cross. Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her second straight double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds, Gena Grundhoffer (5-for-10) added 10 points, Quinci Mann and Bernadette Devaney chipped in seven points apiece and Meagan Eripret had four points. Lehigh shot 31 percent from the floor and was 3-for-13 from three-point range, and Holy Cross shot 42 percent overall and was just 3-of-14 from the outside. The Crusaders (7-7, 2-1 PL) held a 38-36 edge on the glass outscored Lehigh (8-6, 2-1 PL) 36-24 in the paint.

Trailing by 15 at the half, Lehigh outscored the Crusaders 29-19 in the second half, forcing 11 turnovers and coming away with six steals over the final 20 minutes.

"I honestly didn't think we were ready to play the first two quarters," said head coach Sue Troyan. "Defensively, we came out pretty lethargic and didn't play with a lot of intensity or competitiveness. We didn't play with the things that helped us win against Navy and we talked about that at halftime, then came out and played with a higher level of intensity. Had we seen that for 40 minutes, I think we would have seen a different result."

Buhr scored two early hoops for Lehigh, but the Crusaders started strong, hitting a three and taking advantage of two early turnovers to hold a 14-4 lead at the first media timeout. Holy Cross scored 11 points of five LU turnovers in the opening quarter, and Devaney and Buhr combined for 10 points as Lehigh ran off six straight towards the end of the frame, but Lehigh trailed 25-14 after one.

The second quarter was a period of runs, as HC kept the pressure on with an 8-0 run to start the frame and up the advantage to 33-14. Lehigh responded with six straight of their own, starting with a free throw from Devaney at the 3:30 mark. Buhr followed with Lehigh's first three of the night after starting 0-for-7. Mann followed with a pair of free throws with 2:32 remaining to cut it to 33-20, before Holy Cross hit a layup in the final minute to take a 35-20 lead into the break. The Crusaders shot 50 percent (14-for-28) in the opening half, while Lehigh struggled to the tune of a 26 percent clip, including a 1-for-14 performance in the second quarter. HC scored 15 of their points off eight Lehigh

Lehigh emerged from the locker room a completely new team in the second half, ripping off 10 straight points to start the third and get within five. Five from Mann, and four from Grundhoffer highlighted the run before HC answered with four quick points of their own to make it 39-30 at the 6:03 mark. Benz upped the run to 14-4 with a three-pointer heading into the media timeout with the score 39-34, but Holy Cross would eventually up the lead to a dozen once more with 2:28 to go. Buhr and Benz hit two free throws apiece to make it an eight-point ballgame, 48-40, after three quarters.

Lehigh shot 6-for-9 overall and connected on two of their three attempts from downtown in the period, outscoring Holy Cross 20-13.

Lehigh outscored the Crusaders 9-6 in the fourth quarter and defensively, held HC to 1-of-10 shooting and forced five turnovers, and pressured the Crusaders to miss their last nine shots from the field over the final eight minutes. Lehigh had many solid looks at the hoop, but struggled to find the bottom of the basket down the stretch, going 4-of-17 in the final frame.

Lehigh battled back to within 50-46 after back-to-back jumpers and a steal from Eripret with 7:12 to go, and answered two Crusader free throws with a Grundhoffer trey to get back within four at 52-48 with 3:46 remaining. Buhr sank a free throw to make it a three-point game with 2:10 to go. After a couple of empty possessions by both teams, Lehigh had the ball with a chance to tie the game in the final minute, but Holy Cross' Katie Doherty came away with a huge steal with 19 seconds left, and the Crusaders tacked on two late free throws for the five-point victory.




