SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will play at home for the fourth time in five games to open up Patriot League play on Thursday evening when they welcome Bucknell to Stabler Arena. Both teams enter the showdown with identical 9-6 (3-1 PL) records and sit in a tie for second place in the Patriot League standings. Thursday's game is presented by Ready Nutrition.

The Mountain Hawks are coming off a 16-point victory on Monday over Boston University, where they shot 63 percent in the first half and 52 percent for the game, including a 45.5 percent clip from downtown. Five Mountain Hawks scored in double figures for the first time this season, led by Qunci Mann (21) and Camryn Buhr (18). Defensively, Lehigh forced 10 steals and held BU to 37.5 percent from the field and just 3-of-12 from beyond the arc.

The Mountain Hawks have climbed back into the top spot in the Patriot League by making 34.7 percent of their shots from three-point range, and are shooting a league-best 44.4 percent from downtown through the first four league games. Thursday's game will conclude a stretch of playing four of the first five league games at home, something Lehigh has not done since 2011-12. Lehigh has made the most of the early home stretch by winning each of the first three games. At 7-1, Lehigh is off to its best start at home in eight years.

Following Thursday's matchup, Lehigh will begin a two-game road trip Sunday afternoon at first place American.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 355-314 into Thursday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. BUCKNELL

Meeting for the 82nd time in program history, Lehigh holds a 42-39 record in the all-time series against the Bison.

Bucknell has won the last five matchups between the two schools, plus nine of the last 12 dating back to the 2011-12 season. Prior to that, Lehigh bested the Bison in 10 straight games from 2008-2012. Over the last 12 games, two of Lehigh's three wins over the Bison have come at Stabler Arena. The last 12 games played between the two have been decided by an average of 13.3 points, with Lehigh winning its three games by an average of 14.3 points. Over the same span, the Bison have outscored Lehigh by an average of 66.3-60.9.

Last season, Bucknell won a pair of 19-point decisions over Lehigh, with departed senior and PL Player of the Year Claire DeBoer leading the Bison in scoring in both games. Kyi English (16) and Kate Walker (10) led Bucknell's returners and helped the Bison shoot nearly 47 percent in a 77-58 win at Stabler Arena on Jan. 11. English and Catherine Romaine led the team in the game at Bucknell. Quinci Mann led Lehigh in scoring in both games, collecting her 1,000th career point at Bucknell on Feb. 8. Lehigh shot a combined 33.9 percent from the floor in the two games and 24.5 percent from three-point range.

SCOUTING THE BISON

Off to a 9-6 (3-1 PL) start, Bucknell enters Thursday's matchup on a three game winning streak after dropping their league opener to first place American. The preseason co-favorite to repeat as league champions, the Bison topped Boston U. 63-58 on the road and have beaten Army West Point (60-36) and Lafayette (83-53) at home. Bucknell is 4-4 on the road this season and 36-4 in Patriot League play over the last three seasons.

As a team, Bucknell leads the Patriot League with a rebounding margin of +6.9, three higher than second ranked Army. Their rebounding margin is also a PL best +9.8 in league play. Through four league games, the Bison sit atop the league by scoring 66.0 points per league contest and are third by allowing an average of 53.8 points. They are holding opponents to 35.3 percent from the field and 29.3 percent from three-point range in league games.

The Bison are led by junior forward and preseason all-league selection Kaitlyn Slagus at 12.6 points and 8.3 rebounds per game, both of which rank in the top 10 in the league. Juniors Kyi English (11.4 ppg) and Kate Walker (10.3) also score in double figures, and Bucknell is the only team in the league to have three players ranked in the top 15 in assists per game, led by English at 3.0 dimes per contest.

In Monday's win over Lafayette, the Bison set a school record with 14 three-pointers and received 47 points from their bench. In this week's RPI, Bucknell ranks third in the PL and 145th nationally.

BUCKNELL HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL

Now in his sixth season with the Bison, Aaron Roussell has improved the team's record in each of his first five seasons in Lewisburg. Coming off a program record 27 wins last season and 25 in 2015-16, Roussell piloted the team to 15, 16 and 18 wins, respectively, in his first three years on the job. Last season, he led the Bison to a Patriot League Tournament title and a First Round NCAA Tournament appearance.

Roussell is the two-time reigning Patriot League Coach of the Year and enters Friday with a career record of 271-112 and a 110-62 record at Bucknell. Two years ago in 2015-16, Bucknell finished 17-1 in league play, earning a share of the regular season title with Army West Point. The team went on to capture the program's first ever win in a WNIT game with a 74-70 win over Akron in the first round.

Prior to arriving in Lewisburg, Roussell spent eight years as the head coach at the University of Chicago, where he compiled a 161-50 record, making it to the Div. III NCAA Tournament four times and the Elite Eight once.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Iowa, Roussell double-majored in journalism/mass communications and political science. In 2002, he began a two-year stint as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Minnesota State, completing a master's degree in sports administration.

STELLAR AT STABLER

Lehigh (7-1) is off to its best start at home since 2009-10 when they went 16-0 at home as part of a 33-game home court winning streak, spanning the entirety of the 2008-09 and 2009-10 seasons.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Thursday's game will feature two of the top rebounding teams in the Patriot League. Bucknell enters the matchup with the best rebounding margin in the league at +6.9 this season, and also leads during league play at +9.8. Lehigh enters third overall with a rebounding margin of +2.8, and is fourth during league play at -0.2.

Lehigh has been outrebounded by their opponents in just three of their 15 games so far this season, although two of those three games have come during league play.

HEATING UP AT HOME

Since the start of league play, Lehigh has been hot from the floor at home, shooting 48.5 percent (33-of-68) from three-point range and 45.9 percent overall (73-of-159).

Lehigh tied a school record with 15 three-pointers on Dec. 29 against Lafayette, shooting 53.6 percent (15-for-28) from downtown.

Since the start of Patriot League play, Lehigh has held opponents to 21.5 percent (14-for-65) from three-point range and 35.8 percent overall.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr has picked up double-doubles in two of her last three games, averaging 15.5 points per game in league play, including 16.7 ppg over the last three games. She has registered at least 15 points in four of the last five games and has scored in double digits 10 times this season.

During Patriot League play, she ranks first with a .667 (6-for-9) 3FG% and is fourth in the league in scoring.

A HED ABOVE THE REST

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom has emerged as one of Lehigh's top rebounding threats, in addition to being among the league leaders in assists. During league games, she ranks second on the team with 7.0 rebounds per game.

She ranks tied for ninth in the Patriot League during league play with 7.0 rebounds per game and has pulled in at least nine rebounds in two of her last three games.

Hedstrom also ranks fourth in the league with 3.7 assists per game and is the only Patriot League player to rank in the top 10 in both rebounding and assists.

She has collected at least three steals in four games this season and leads the team with 1.4 steals per game this year.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann leads the Patriot League with 3.3 three-pointers per game. She is the only player averaging over three triples per contest.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in four games this season and has had two games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

MANN'S MILESTONES

Quinci Mann is currently 11th on the school's all-time scoring list and is just 30 points away from passing Danielle Baldwin '00 to enter the top 10.

In the Jan. 2 win over Navy, she moved into third place on Lehigh's career three-point list, passing Erica Prosser '11.

BERNIE LENDING AN ASSIST

Over the last four games, Bernadette Devaney is averaging 2.8 assists per game, over one full assist higher than her season average of 1.7. She dished out a career-high five assists against Lafayette on Dec. 29, while scoring six points on a pair of three-pointers.

FINISHING STRONG

The Mountain Hawks have been at their best in the fourth quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 16.3-13.1. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in the first and third quarters.

On Dec. 29, Lehigh held Lafayette to just five points on 1-of-17 shooting in the fourth quarter.

PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

Lehigh was picked seventh in the Patriot League Preseason Poll and is looking to rebound after a ninth place finish in last year's Patriot League standings. LU fell in the first round of the league tournament to Loyola. It was the first time Lehigh had failed to qualify for at least the semifinals since the league went to the current tournament format in 2013-14.

BETHLEHEM, Pa. - Five Mountain Hawks scored in double figures on Monday night as the Lehigh women's basketball team powered past Boston University 74-58 at Stabler Arena. Senior Quinci Mann has a game-high 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting, and sophomore Camryn Buhr had 19 points and six rebounds on 5-of-10 shooting with career-highs of seven assists and five steals. Sophomore Cameryn Benz tallied 11 points and tied her career-high with eight rebounds, senior Bernadette Devaney scored 10 points on 4-of-7 shooting and Gena Grundhoffer totaled 10 points on 4-of-6 shooting.

Lehigh (9-6, 3-1 PL) once again shot the ball well on their home court, going 28-for-54 (51.9 percent) from the floor and 10-for-22 (45.5 percent) from three-point range. The LU defense held Boston (7-7, 2-2 PL), who entered the game with the highest three-point percentage and second ranked field goal percentage in the Patriot League, to 37.5 percent from the field and just 3-of-12 from long range. As a team, the Brown and White dished out 20 assists and had a 34-32 edge on the glass. Lehigh used a 12-0 run to end the first half to outscore the Terriers 26-10 in the frame. The two teams tied in each of the other three quarters.

"They played tremendous basketball," said head coach Sue Troyan. "They really shared the basketball and played unselfishly. A lot of people stepped up and played all-around great games for us. I told our kids at the end of the game that we had the chemistry going today with Cam Buhr and Cam Benz – you look at their stat lines – and they were both really impressive. I was really proud of our posts and how they defended their inside game. BU's big kids inside are a big part of their offense and I thought our coaching staff did a great job preparing the posts for what they were going to see and taking away the looks they wanted to get on the offensive end."

Grundhoffer and Mann each connected from downtown in the opening minutes, while Katie Nelson hit two threes for BU to give the Terriers an 11-8 lead at the first media timeout. The back and forth quarter saw the lead change hands 10 times, as BU hit a late bucket to knot it at 19 after one quarter.

Lehigh took the lead for good right out of the gate in the second quarter following a three-pointer from Mann. The lead grew to six on three separate occasions over the first five minutes before Boston cut it to four at 33-29 with 5:13 left until halftime. After two minutes without a basket, Benz sank a three at the 2:52 mark to spark a 12-0 Lehigh run to close the half and open up the game at 45-29. Mann and Meagan Eripret each contributed baskets, Benz added a layup in the final minute, and Devaney capped the run with a steal and unassisted hoop, and tacked on a free throw to complete the and-one with eight seconds left.

Buhr had four steals in the opening half as Lehigh shot 63 percent through the opening 20 minutes.

Boston scored four straight coming out of the break to get within 12 points, but that was as close as they would get the rest of the game. After two Terrier free throws made it a 58-45 ballgame with 3:09 left in the third, Buhr stepped up and drilled a triple to get the lead back to 16, and Benz followed with a layup to make it 63-46. A Buhr bucket gave Lehigh a 64-48 lead in the closing seconds of the third before BU had a long three-pointer at the buzzer waived off following an official review.

After trading points through the first four minutes of the final quarter, Buhr found Benz with a lob underneath to make it 68-52 and Mann followed with her fifth and final three-pointer of the evening to grow the lead to a game-high 19 points with 4:19 to go.

"Across the board, Quinci was very patient waiting for her shots and we did a good job of finding her on the perimeter. Cam Buhr – just how she played on the defensive end and on the offensive end, distributing the ball, steals, rebounds played a really complete game. Hannah did a good job handling the ball and Gena when she had her minutes. She got into some foul trouble but did a nice job scoring the ball."

"Having four of our first five league games at home is important, especially after the year we had last year," Troyan said. "You take it a game at a time. BU is a really strong opponent and one of the best in the league. We'll see the same thing in Bucknell, then we go to American who's one of the preseason top teams in the league. This is one of our toughest weeks on the schedule and having two of those three at home is obviously very favorable."


