SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will kick off a two-game road trip on Sunday with a big showdown at first place American. Lehigh sits one game back of American in second place in the Patriot League after their 66-62 win over Bucknell on Thursday. After starting 7-1 at home for the first time in eight years, the Mountain Hawks will look to continue their strong play over the upcoming stretch where they will play six of their next seven games on the road.

During league play, Lehigh has found itself ranked near the top of the league in every major offensive category, ranking first in three-point percentage at .462, second in field goal percentage (42.4 percent) and third in points per game (65.0). Lehigh is fourth in scoring margin in league play, trailing American, along with Navy and Bucknell, two teams LU has already beaten.

While Lehigh leads the league in three-point percentage in league play, American ranks atop the league by allowing opponents to shoot just 18.2 percent from long range. Lehigh comes in second, holding opponents to 21.8 percent from outside the arc.

The Mountain Hawks have several individuals ranking atop the Patriot League in several categories during league play, with Quinci Mann leading the PL in scoring (18.4 ppg), three-pointers per game (3.2) and free throw percentage (1.000). She also ranks second in three-point percentage, trailing only teammate Camryn Buhr (66.7 percent). With Gena Grundhoffer shooting 54.5 percent from downtown, Lehigh has three of the top five three-point shooters during league play. Defensively, Lehigh sits fourth by surrendering 56.4 points in five league games.

IF LEHIGH BEATS AMERICAN

- Lehigh would start 5-1 in Patriot League play for the first time since the 2012-13 season.
- Lehigh would move into a tie for first place with American atop the Patriot League.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 356-314 into Sunday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. AMERICAN

American leads the all-time series vs. the Mountain Hawks 28-13. The Eagles swept the series last season by scores of 70-58 at Stabler Arena and 68-51 in Washington.

Gena Grundhoffer (17), Camryn Buhr (10) and Quinci Mann (10) all scored in double figures to lead Lehigh in their loss at American on Jan. 7, 2017 as American used a balanced effort and shot 48 percent to win by 17. The same three led Lehigh in scoring once again at Stabler Arena on Feb. 4, when American once again shot 48 percent, led by Emily Kinneston's 19 points to win by 12.

Lehigh's last win over American came in 2016 when then-sophomores Quinci Mann (16 pts) and Bernadette Devaney (11 pts) helped lead Lehigh to a 61-52 victory. That win is the lone triumph for Lehigh over American in their last nine matchups with the Eagles having won 11 of the last 14 games. All three Lehigh wins during that stretch have come on the road. Lehigh has not beaten American at Stabler Arena since the 2010 PL Championship game.

Since the 2013-14 season, American has averaged 67.0 points in their

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

Sitting in first place in the Patriot League standings, American is the only unbeaten team left in league play at 5-0. At 12-4 overall, American picked up non-league wins over Tulsa, La Salle, and Penn State among others. In Patriot League play, the Eagles have won each of their games by an average of 13.6 points and have held their opponents to 51.6 points per game, with no one scoring more than 58.

Lehigh and American have had four common opponents this season, with Lehigh going 2-2 and AU going 3-1. Both teams suffered defeats to Villanova and Lehigh lost to La Salle, while American won that contest by 18. Both teams have beaten Bucknell and Navy at home.

The Eagles leading scorer Emily Kinneston ranks eighth in the Patriot League with 14.0 points per game and Cecily Carl ranks fifth in the league in rebounding (8.5) while scoring 11.9 points per contest. Kinneston comes in second in the league with 4.1 asissts per game and Michael Harris sits fourth with a team-best .484 field goal percentage.

American's scoring margin of +4.9 ranks one spot ahead of Lehigh for third in the league. The Eagles rank second by allowing just 58.9 points per game this season, a number that drops to a league-low 51.6 ppg during league play. American also comes in just ahead of Lehigh by scoring 62.2 ppg in league play, tying them for first with Bucknell.

AMERICAN HEAD COACH MEGAN GEBBIA

Megan Gebbia is in the midst of her fifth season at the helm of the Eagles. In her second year in 2014-15, Gebbia guided American to its first Patriot League Tournament title, as the Eagles advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. AU posted a 24-9 overall mark in 2014-15, setting the program record for single-season victories. Her efforts earned her the 2015 Patriot League Coach of the Year.

Entering this season, she held a .563 overall winning percentage and a .648 percentage in Patriot League play.

Gebbia arrived at American after spending the previous 10 seasons at Marist College, serving as the associate head coach for her last seven seasons. Prior to joining Marist, Gebbia served as an assistant at Wright State for the 2002-03 season and was in the same role at UMBC from 1996-2002. Gebbia began her coaching career at her alma mater, Towson, and served as team captain of the Tigers' squad during her senior season in 1994.

TAKING IT ON THE ROAD

Sunday starts a stretch for Lehigh where six of their next seven games will be on the road. Lehigh is off to an 8-1 start at home this season, their best home start since going undefeated at home in 2009-10. Lehigh is 4-0 at home in Patriot League games, with their only league loss coming at Holy Cross. The Mountain Hawks are 2-4 on the road this season.

SOMETHING HAS TO GIVE

American enters the matchup allowing opponents to shoot just 18.2 percent from beyond the arc in league games. Lehigh enters the matchup hitting on 46.2 percent (43-for-93) of their threes in league play, over 10 percent more than the next closest team.

Lehigh ranks second behind American by allowing opponents to shoot just 21.8 percent from 3pt range.

SIZZLING FROM THE FIELD

Since the start of league play, the Mountain Hawks rank in the top four in every major offensive category, including a league leading three-point percentage of .462. That number is more than 10 percent higher than the next closest team (Bucknell) who sits at 35.9 percent. Lehigh also tops the league with 8.6 made 3FGs per league game, exactly two above second place Bucknell.

In their four league home games, Lehigh has shot 45.4 percent from the floor and an even 50 percent (40-for-80) from three-point range. Lehigh has averaged 10 made three-pointers in home league games, while surrendering just 3.5.

STEPPING UP IN THE SECOND HALF

After being held to just two points on 1-of-5 shooting in the first half against Bucknell, Quinci Mann scored 25 points in the second half, going 7-for-11 to finish with a career-high 27 points and lead the team to a comeback win. Her previous career-high of 26 was set last February vs. Loyola.

As a team, Lehigh shot 65.2 percent in the second half, including a 5-for-5 clip from threepoint range.

ONE-TWO PUNCH

Camryn Buhr and Quinci Mann rank one-two in Patriot League games from beyond the arc with Buhr shooting 66.7 percent (6-for-9) and Mann shooting 57.1 percent (16-for-28).

BLOWN OFF THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games, but has been outrebounded in three of their first five league games, including by a 43-25 margin against Bucknell. During non-league play, Lehigh held a +3.9 rebounding margin, but currently ranks eighth in league play at -3.8. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are fourth in rebounding margin at +1.5.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr has picked up two double-doubles in league play thus far, ranking second on the team with 14.0 ppg and leading the team with 7.4 rebounds. She leads the league by shooting 66.7 from three-point range, fourth in assists (3.6), eighth in rebounding and leads the league with 36.8 minutes per league game.

A HED ABOVE THE REST

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom has emerged as one of Lehigh's top rebounding threats, in addition to being among the league leaders in assists. During league games, she ranks second on the team with 6.4 rebounds per game.

Hedstrom also ranks fourth in the league with 3.6 assists per game and ranks tied for sixth in league games with 3.0 assists per league contest.

She has collected at least three steals in four games this season and leads the team with 1.4 steals per game this year.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann leads the Patriot League with 18.4 points per game, is first with 3.2 three-pointers per game, and is a perfect 16-for-16 from the free throw line to lead the league. She in second in the league with a 57.1 3FG% and ranks seventh in minutes played (31.6). She also holds a field goal percentage of .484. She is the only player averaging over three triples per contest.

Her recent dominating stretch at the free throw line has moved her into first place overall in the PL at 81.1 percent.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in four games this season and has had two games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

MANN'S MILESTONES

Quinci Mann is just three points away from passing Danielle Baldwin '00 and moving into 10th place on the school's all-time scoring list.

In the Jan. 2 win over Navy, she moved into third place on Lehigh's career three-point list, passing Erica Prosser '11.

Earlier this year, she sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's.

FINISHING STRONG

The Mountain Hawks have been at their best in the fourth quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 16.6-13.3. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart). On Dec. 29, Lehigh held Lafayette to just five points on 1-of-17 shooting in the fourth quarter.

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – Quinci Mann scored 25 of her career-high 27 points in the second half to help spur the Mountain Hawks to a 66-62 win over Bucknell on Thursday night at Stabler Arena in a game presented by Ready Nutrition. Mann was 8-for-16 from the field, 3-for-4 from downtown and a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line in the game, scoring the team's final eight points in the closing 2:26 to ice the game away. Sophomore Camryn Benz chipped in 13 points and five rebounds on 6-of-10 shooting, Gena Grundhoffer tallied nine points and Camryn Buhr scored eight with a team-high seven rebounds. The win moves Lehigh (10-6, 4-1 PL) into sole possession of second place in the Patriot League, with a showdown coming up this Sunday at first place American.

Despite Bucknell (9-7, 3-2 PL) outrebounding the Mountain Hawks 43-25, including 17-4 on the offensive glass, LU shot 62.2 percent from the floor in the second half, finishing 23-for-52 (44.2 percent) for the game and a season-best 58.3 percent (7-for-12) from three-point range, including 5-for-5 in the second half. Lehigh also sank 13 of their 15 free throw attempts.

"Quinci did exactly what you want a senior all-league guard to do," said head coach Sue Troyan. "She has taken a little bit of a backseat to what we've asked her to do in the past, when she had the ball in her hands a lot and was asked to shoot a lot more than she has this year. This was a game where we needed her to step up and take those shots, and she wants the ball in those moments. Every critical situation where we needed a basket it seemed like she stepped up and made the shot."

Bucknell led for most of the opening quarter until Mariah Sexe connected on a three-pointer to tie the game with 1:23 left, then Buhr added a layup in the final minute to take 16-14 lead after one.

Lehigh followed with a bad second quarter, shooting just 2-for-14 in the frame and missing nine straight shots as Bucknell outscored Lehigh 14-5. Benz opened the second quarter to increase Lehigh's run to 7-0 and give them an 18-14 lead. Lehigh then went cold from the floor as Bucknell ripped off 14 straight points to go up 28-18. Hedstrom broke the spell with a free throw with 1:31 remaining, and Meagan Eripret got a putback basket just ahead of the horn to make it 28-21 going into the half.

Lehigh bounced back and shot 8-for-11 (72.7 percent) in the third quarter, taking the lead for good at the 3:50 mark of the period. After Bucknell opened the frame with five straight, Lehigh rattled off 12 unanswered to tie it at 33-33, courtesy of seven points from Mann and five from Grundhoffer. After trading buckets for the next two minutes, Benz put Lehigh up with a layup, and Mann followed with a trey to make it 42-38 and cap a 21-5 LU run. Mann tacked on two free throws and Buhr hit a layup in the final minute to help LU hold a 46-45 lead entering the fourth.

"They're a team that can turn you over so I thought we did a good job in the first half of taking care of the basketball, which is probably why it was only a seven point deficit at the half," Troyan said. "We made some adjustments in terms of the offense we were running and just attacking some of their weaknesses and mismatches. In the first half we just did our own thing and didn't read the switches and things like that. We tried to put Slagus in a lot of mismatch situations and that's where Quinci took advantage. It felt like if we executed and looked for the opportunities that were there, we would get good shots and we did a much better job of that in the third quarter."

Mann opened the fourth with a triple and after a Bison basket, Benz netted three straight buckets to give Lehigh its largest lead of the game, 55-46 with 7:07 left. After the lead was cut to five, Benz sank a big three-pointer and Mann followed with a layup to grow the lead back to nine, 60-51, with 2:26 left.

Two Bison free throws made it 60-57 with 46 seconds left before Mann calm sank two from the charity stripe to make it 62-57. A Bucknell three-pointer made it 62-60 with 33 seconds to go, before Mann dribbled away the time and hit a big jumper in the paint with eight seconds left. Following another Bison basket, Mann closed the game with two more free throws to secure the 66-62 final.


