SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will take on Navy Saturday night in Annapolis, Maryland, with both teams entering the contest in a tie for second place with Bucknell in the Patriot League standings. Both teams will be looking to rebound from road losses on Wednesday night.

Quinci Mann scored a career-high 32 points at Loyola on Wednesday, but the Mountain Hawks struggled to connect from the free throw line, going 9-for-18 in the game. Both teams committed 14 turnovers with Loyola scoring 20 points to Lehigh's 13 off those miscues. Up in Lewisburg, Navy scored 14 points in the first half of their 47-39 loss at Bucknell. Navy was held to a season-low 26.2 percent from the floor, but only scored two points in transition and tallied just 14 points off 20 Bison turnovers.

In their first meeting this year, Lehigh topped Navy 66-63 back on Jan. 2 at Stabler Arena. Lehigh held Navy to 20 percent from beyond the arc and under 38 percent from the floor in the game, hanging on as Navy's game-tying attempt at the buzzer rattled out. Quinci Mann led all scorers with 21 points and Camryn Buhr had 15 points and 11 rebounds to lead Lehigh. Gena Grundhoffer added 14 points and Hannah Hedstrom had a career-high 11 rebounds.

Lehigh will have a week off before its next game on Saturday, Feb. 3 at Boston University.

IF LEHIGH BEATS NAVY

- Lehigh would sweep Navy in the season series for the first time since the 2011-12 season.
- Lehigh would avoid losing back-to-back games for the first time this season.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 358-316 into Saturday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. NAVY

Lehigh enters Wednesday's matchup with a 28-32 all-time record against the Midshipmen. Navy has controlled the tempo in the series in recent years, having won 11 of the last 13 matchups, including three of the last four, dating back to the Patriot League Tournament in March 2012. Navy leads the all-time series in Annapolis 17-12, while Lehigh has a 16-15 edge at Stabler Arena.

Since splitting two games in 2011, Lehigh took both regular season contests from Navy in 2012 before Navy won eight straight and swept the season series from 2013-2015. The two split the season series in 2015-16.

Each team has had an eight game winning streak during the course of the 59 matchups in the series, with Lehigh's coming from 2001-2004, and Navy's from 2012-2015. Lehigh also had a six game win streak from 2008-2010, and Navy has had a pair of five-game streaks.

Navy went 2-1 against Lehigh in the 1980s, with their first matchup coming in the 1981-82 season. Navy held a 12-6 advantage in the 1990s, and Lehigh dominated in the 2000s by winning 14 of the 20

games. Since 2010, Navy holds a 12-6 record.

SCOUTING THE MIDSHIPMEN

The Navy Midshipmen enter Saturday's matchup tied with Lehigh and Bucknell for second place in the Patriot League with a 6-3 league record. At 16-4 overall, Navy holds an unblemished 11-0 record at home this season.

The Mids are coming off a sluggish offensive performance in Wednesday's 47-39 loss at Bucknell, which ended their five-game winning streak. Navy leads the Patriot League in several categories including scoring offense (69.3 ppg), scoring defense (55.5 ppg), and their leaguebest +13.8 scoring margin is more than twice as much as the next closest team. The Mids issue a league-leading 16.1 assists per game.

Defensively, they have also held opponents to a league-low 35.2 percent shooting and 29.5 percent from beyond the arc. They average 3.8 blocks per contest which is good for second in the league, are first in steals (10.9) and rank one spot ahead of Lehigh in third with a +1.2 rebounding margin.

Taylor Dunham leads the squad with 14.9 ppg this season, with Hannah Fenske ranking second with 13.0 points and 4.2 rebounds per contest. Kaila Clark leads the Mids with 8.8 rebounds per game, good enough for fourth in the Patriot League. Fenske's 3.9 assists put her second in the Patriot League, and both Fenske (38.3) and Dunham (37.3) rank in the top eight in the PL in three-point percentage, with Dunham leading the way with 2.8 made three-pointers per game.

Navy received votes in the AP Top 25 poll earlier this year before suffering their first two league losses of the year on the road at Lehigh and

NAVY HEAD COACH STEFANIE PEMPER

Stepfanie Pemper is in the midst of her 10th season as the head coach of Navy. Pemper led the Mids to winning records in eight of her first nine seasons, and Navy has never finished under .500 during her tenure. Pemper is a two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year (2011 and 2014).

Pemper has been at the helm for three 20-win seasons in 2010-11, 2012-13 and 2016-17, and the Mids have finished no lower than tied for third five times under her. Navy became just the second program in Patriot League history to win three consecutive tournament titles from 2011-2013. The 2014 season saw Navy win a program record 24 games before advancing to the first round of the WNIT.

Pemper arrived at Navy after posting a 235-48 record as the head coach of Bowdoin. Her 10-year winning percentage of 83 percent ranked fourth in NCAA Division III history upon her departure. She was inducted into the New England Basketball Hall of Fame in 2009.

A native of Huntington Beach, Calif., the two-time All-Big Sky honoree graduated from Idaho State in 1992 and was inducted into the school's Hall of Fame in 2003.

ROCKY ROAD

Lehigh has dropped four of their last five games on the road and is 3-6 in road games this season after finishing 2-12 away from Stabler Arena last season. Lehigh is in the midst of a stretch where they are playing six of seven games on the road.

HOME COOKING

Lehigh is off to an 9-1 start at home this season, their best home start since going undefeated at Stabler Arena in 2009-10. Lehigh is shooting 44.6 percent from the field in its five league home games and 45.2 percent from three-point range. Lehigh has also made an average of 8.4 three-pointers per game at home in league play.

40 PERCENT BETTER

Wednesday's loss at Loyola was Lehigh's first defeat this season when shooting over 40 percent from the field (11-1). Lehigh is 1-7 when shooting under 40 percent.

NOT SO CHARITABLE AT THE LINE

Lehigh struggled to convert at the free throw line in Wednesday's three-point loss at Loyola, going 9-for-18 from the charity stripe, including just 7-for-16 in the second half. It was their second-worst game from the line this season (5-for-13/38.5 percent at Sacred Heart). Lehigh entered the game shooting 75.6 percent at the line as a team in league play.

Q IN THE CLUTCH

Senior Quinci Mann had a career night shooting the ball on Wednesday at Loyola, scoring a career-high 32 points on 12-of-19 overall and 5-of-8 from three-point range. Mann's previous career-high was 27 points against Bucknell on Jan. 11. She became the first Lehigh player to score 30+ points in one game since Jenny Callan (31) on February 15, 2006 vs. Colgate.

It was the third time this season Mann has had at least five-three-pointers in a game.

SOMETHING TO BUILD ON

The Mountain Hawks had one of their better shooting performances of the season against the Greyhounds, going 24-for-53 (45.3 percent) from the field and 7-for-14 from three-point range. Lehigh entered Wednesday's game at Loyola shooting 36.1 percent from the floor and 36.6 percent from beyond the arc in league road games.

Despite shooting 36.3 percent (61-for-168) from the floor and 30.6 percent (15-for-49) from beyond the arc over a three-game stretch from Jan. 14-20, the Mountain Hawks still rank in the top four in most major offensive categories, and rank atop the league overall this season three-point percentage (.355). Lehigh is also one of two teams in league play to average over seven 3FGs/game (7.2). They rank third in scoring offense (63.4) in league play, and fourth in both scoring defense (59.7) and scoring margin (+3.8).

Lehigh has averaged 10 made three-pointers in home league games, while surrendering

BLOWN OFF THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games, but has been outrebounded in six of their first nine league games, including by a 43-25 margin against Bucknell. During non-league play, Lehigh held a +3.9 rebounding margin, but currently ranks sixth in league play at -2.6. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are fourth in rebounding margin at +1.0.

Navy enters Saturday just behind LU, seventh in PL play with a -3.3 rebounding margin.

MONKEY OFF THEIR BACKS

Despite getting outshot 34.5 percent to 33.9 percent on Jan. 17, Lehigh captured their first road win in league play at Colgate, ending their four game road losing streak. Colgate shrunk a 14-point fourth quarter deficit down to four with 1:23 remaining, but Cam Buhr scored a huge second chance jumper in the lane with 29 seconds left and Cam Benz tacked on two free throws to secure the win.

ONE-TWO PUNCH

Camryn Buhr and Quinci Mann have finished as the team's top two scorers in five of the first nine league games, after being simultaneously among the team's two leading scorers just once in 11 non-league contests. After Wednesday's defeat, Lehigh is 5-1 when Buhr and Mann are the team's top two scorers.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Jan 17 at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 7.3 rebounds and ranks second with 13.0 ppg. In league play, she ranks fifth in rebounds (8.1), sixth in assists (3.3), and leads the league with 36.6 minutes per league game.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann has moved up to second in the Patriot League in scoring with 17.4 ppg, and is second with a 51.0 3FG% and ranks third 2.8 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STUMBLING TO THE FINISH

The Mountain Hawks were outscored in the fourth quarter only once through their first 17 games of the season. However, Lehigh has been outscored in the fourth quarter in each of its last four games by an average of 17-13.8. Despite their recent struggles late in games, the fourth quarter has been the Mountain Hawks best this season, outscoring the opposition 16-14.1.

BALTIMORE, Md. - Alexis Gray's long three-pointer with 1.2 seconds left lifted Loyola past Lehigh 67-64 on Wednesday night. The Mountain Hawks, who entered the game shooting 75.6 percent in league play from the free throw line, went just 9-for-18 from the charity stripe in the game, including a 7-for-16 clip in the second half. Quinci Mann scored 32 points on 12-for-19 shooting to become the first Lehigh player to score 30+ points in a game since Jenny Callan (31) in February 2006. Camryn Buhr scored 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting, and Cameryn Benz and Gena Grundhoffer scored eight points apiece. Mann and Buhr led the team with seven rebounds each.

Loyola shot 49.1 percent overall and was 6-for-10 from three-point range, while Lehigh shot 45.3 percent and went 7-for-14 from beyond the arc. Each team committed 14 turnovers and had 10 assists, and Loyola won the rebounding battle 30-29. The Greyhounds also had a 20-13 edge in points off

"We definitely missed a lot of opportunities by leaving a lot of points on the foul line," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We knew it was going to be a dogfight coming in. They have a number of players that can score in a number of different ways. Give them credit for hitting last shot. It was a well played game on both sides."

Loyola scored seven straight points to go up 7-2 before Grundhoffer hit a three-pointer and went coast-to-coast to knot it 7-7. After a Loyola made a layup, Grundhoffer made her third straight field goal to tie it at nine at the 4:27 mark. Buhr gave Lehigh a 13-11 lead on assist from Bernadette Devaney at 2:33. After Loyola made it 13-12, Lehigh scored six straight, including four from Benz to give Lehigh the 19-14 after one.

Mann opened the second quarter on fire, hitting three consecutive three-pointers to help Lehigh build their lead to 28-18 at the 6:31 mark. From there, Loyola went on an 18-4 run to close the half, including a 9-0 stretch to make it 28-27, before Devaney went around a defender for a basket to make it 30-27 with 3:34 to go. After a three-pointer gave Loyola a 32-30 lead, Buhr tied it with a layup with 1:39 to go before the Greyhounds scored the final four points to take a 36-32 lead into the locker room. After not committing a turnover in the first quarter, Lehigh turned it over seven times in the second, leading to 12 Greyhound points. The Greyhounds shot 51.7 percent in the opening 20 minutes to Lehigh's 43.3 percent

"There were parts throughout the game where we didn't run a great offense and I thought they dug in on defense there in the second half on us," Troyan said. "We didn't defend strongly in the first half and I thought we got much better in the third quarter on both the offense and defensive ends." Lehigh took a 44-43 lead in the third quarter following a Mann three-pointer. Benz followed with a layup, and Mann hit another layup to extend the LU run to 9-0 and give Lehigh the 48-43 lead. Loyola responded with seven straight points of their own to go up by two, before Buhr tied it with two free throws. Gray put Loyola up 53-50 late with a three-pointer, but Mann responded with her fifth triple of the night to retie the game 53-53 in the closing seconds of the third quarter.

Lehigh built a three-point, 57-54 lead in the opening minutes of the fourth quarter before the Greyhounds rattled off eight consecutive points to go up 62-57 with about five minutes left. After Mann and Grundhoffer each hit one free throw, Mann used back-to-back layups to give Lehigh the lead back at 63-62 with 55 seconds remaining. After a steal by Benz, Mae Williams hit one of two from the line to make it 64-62, before Stephanie Karcz retied it on a layup with 30 seconds left. After fouling, Loyola got the ball back following two missed free throws and Gray swished a long three to the left of the key with 1.2 seconds left. Lehigh called timeout and advanced the ball to the frontcourt, but a game-tying attempt by Mann hit the front of the rim. Lehigh converted on just three of their 10 attempts from the charity stripe in the fourth quarter.
