SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will welcome first place American to Stabler Arena this Saturday afternoon in their final weekend home game of the season. The game will serve as the team's annual Play4Kay game with \$1 being donated for every person in attendance to women's cancer foundations. Lehigh will also host National Girls and Women in Sports Day.

Lehigh is unbeaten at home in Patriot League play (5-0) and 9-1 at Stabler Arena this season. The Mountain Hawks are coming off a 59-52 loss on Wednesday at Bucknell where they struggled out of the gate offensively, scoring a season-low five points in the first quarter. Lehigh shot 46.7 percent overall in the second half and got within two points in the fourth quarter. Camryn Buhr had 14 points and Bernadette Devaney finished with nine. Devaney enters Saturday averaging 12 ppg over the last two games.

American enters riding a 13-game winning streak that dates back prior to Christmas. They have also won eight consecutive games at Stabler Arena. The Eagles are coming off a 69-56 win over Loyola on Wednesday night. Emily Kinneston scored 17 points to finish in double figures for the ninth straight game.

Lehigh will remain at home this coming Wednesday, Feb. 14 to host Colgate at 6 p.m.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 359-318 into Saturday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. AMERICAN

American leads the all-time series with the Mountain Hawks 29-13. The Eagles swept the series last year by scores of 70-58 at Stabler Arena and 68-51 in Washington, before winning the first matchup this season by 18.

In the first matchup this season in Washington, D.C., American hung 82 points on Lehigh, the second-most allowed by the Mountain Hawks this season. Three Eagles scored 20+ points as the team shot 50 percent from the floor and 63.2 percent from three-point range. Camryn Buhr scored 20 points and 11 rebounds for Lehigh and was 8-for-13 shooting. Quinci Mann and Gena Grundhoffer added 11 points each.

Lehigh has lost eight in a row to American at Stabler Arena with its last win coming in the 2010 Patriot League Championship game. Overall, American has won 13 of the last 16 games since the 2010 Patriot League Championship, and nine of the last 10 dating back to 2014. Since the 2013-14 season, American has averaged 68.5 points in 10 games against Lehigh, to LU's 59.3 points per game.

SCOUTING THE EAGLES

The last unbeaten team remaining in Patriot League play, American sits three-games up on second place Bucknell entering the weekend. American picked up non-league wins over Tulsa, La Salle, and Penn State among others in non-league play, and has not lost since Dec. 17 at George Washington. In Patriot League play, the Eagles have won each of their games by an average of 13.2 points and have held their opponents to 55.4 points per game, third best in the league.

American is averaging a league-best 68.8 ppg in league play, two spots ahead of Lehigh. American ranks third by surrendering 55.4 points per game, one spot ahead of the Mountain Hawks. Their scoring margin of +13.2 is one of only two in the league in double digits. They lead the PL overall this season in field goal pct. (.414), free throw pct. (.759) and 3pt defense (.301).

Holding an 11-0 record at home this year, two of American's last four games have been won in overtime at Holy Cross and vs. Army. The Eagles also had to rally from behind in the second half to win at Lafayette on Jan. 20.

The Eagles leading scorer Emily Kinneston ranks fifth overall in the Patriot League with 14.7 points per game and is tied for third in league play with 15.3 ppg. Junior Cecily Carl ranks sixth in league play with 14.5 ppg and is fifth in rebounding (8.5). Kinneston leads the league with 4.1 assists per game this season and is third in league play at 4.3 apg. Kinneston (45.4) and Michael Harris (44.5) lead the team in field goal percentage and Elina Koskimies leads the team from beyond the arc at an even 44 percent.

AMERICAN HEAD COACH MEGAN GEBBIA

Megan Gebbia is in the midst of her fifth season at the helm of the Eagles. In her second year in 2014-15, Gebbia guided American to its first Patriot League Tournament title, as the Eagles advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history. AU posted a 24-9 overall mark in 2014-15, setting the program record for single-season victories. Her efforts earned her the 2015 Patriot League Coach of the Year.

Entering this season, she held a .563 overall winning percentage and a .648 percentage in Patriot League play.

Gebbia arrived at American after spending the previous 10 seasons at Marist College, serving as the associate head coach for her last seven seasons. Prior to joining Marist, Gebbia served as an assistant at Wright State for the 2002-03 season and was in the same role at UMBC from 1996-2002. Gebbia began her coaching career at her alma mater, Towson, and served as team captain of the Tigers' squad during her senior season in 1994.

HOME COOKING

Lehigh is off to a 9-1 start at home this season, their best home start since going undefeated at Stabler Arena in 2009-10. Lehigh is shooting 44.6 percent from the field in its five league home games and 45.2 percent from three-point range. Lehigh has also made an average of 8.4 three-pointers per game at home in league play.

ROAD PROGRESS

Over the last five road games, Lehigh's defense has held opponents to an average of 57.2 points and holds a +0.8 scoring margin, both well better than its season road averages. LU has gone 2-3 in those games, with two of those losses coming by three points at Loyola and Navy.

Over the last five road games, Lehigh has averaged 7.8 steals per game, 1.4 over its season average and holds a turnover margin of +1.4.

Lehigh has also trimmed nearly three points off its road scoring margin over the last five away games.

PROTECTING THE BALL

Lehigh turned the ball over just 12 times against Bucknell, their third lowest total of the season (11 vs. Bucknell and Monmouth). Lehigh has averaged 13.5 turnovers in their last two games, which is below their season average of 16 per game.

HOT N' COLD AT THE STRIPE

Free throws have been a common denominator in the outcomes in each of Lehigh's last four games. Lehigh earned a big road win at Boston U. on Feb. 3 after converting 13-of-14 free throws in the fourth quarter and 20-of-23 in the game to help pull away from the Terriers for a nine-point win. In their last three losses, Lehigh has struggled from the line going 6-for-13 at Navy, 9-for-18 at Loyola (losing both games by three points), and 8-for-14 at Bucknell.

Overall in their last three losses, LU is a combined 23-for-45 (51.1 percent).

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in five of its last seven games, with their 67-64 loss at Loyola being the only game where they have allowed 60 points during that stretch. The stretch includes holding Navy and their league-leading offense (68.3 ppg) to just 53 points in Annapolis.

PERFECT IN PINK

Lehigh is 9-0 when hosting pink games, dating back to the start of the initiative in 2009. The average margin of victory is 14.3 points.

FIRE BERNING

Bernadette Devaney is averaging 12 ppg over the last two games. On Feb. 3 at BU, she had a career-high five rebounds in a career-best 29 minutes. She scored 15 points, her second-highest total of the season, and went 7-for-8 from the free throw line in the fourth

Over the last five games, Devaney is averaging 7.7 points per game, nearly two points above her season average.

SERVING THEM UP

Hannah Hedstrom is averaging 5.5 assists over the last two games after averaging 2.6 through the first 10 league contests.

LOOKING FOR A REBOUND ON THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9, but has been outrebounded in eight of its first 12 league games, and drew even with Boston U. on Feb. 3. Lehigh's current rebounding margin in league play is -2.4, which ranks seventh. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are fourth in rebounding margin at +0.6.

Q IN THE CLUTCH

Senior Quinci Mann had a career night shooting the ball on Jan. 24 at Loyola, scoring a career-high 32 points on 12-of-19 overall and 5-of-8 from three-point range. Mann's previous career-high was 27 points against Bucknell on Jan. 11. She became the first Lehigh player to score 30+ points in one game since Jenny Callan (31) on February 15, 2006 vs. Colgate.

It was the third time this season Mann has had at least five-three-pointers in a game.

40 PERCENT BETTER

The January 24 loss at Loyola was Lehigh's first defeat this season when shooting over 40 percent from the field (11-1). Lehigh is 1-9 when shooting under 40 percent.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Jan. 17 at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 7.0 rebounds and ranks second with 13.1 ppg. In league play, she ranks ninth in rebounds (7.4), is tied for third with 35.2 minutes, and tied for sixth with teammate Hannah Hedstrom in assists (3.1) per league game.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann is tied for third with 15.4 ppg, and is third with a 44.6 3FG% and ranks fourth with 2.4 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STORY OF THE FOURTH

Lehigh has been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in five of its last seven games. Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 18 of 23 games this season, including 16 of the first 17 games to start the season.

LEWISBURG, Pa. – The Lehigh women's basketball team was unable to overcome a slow start offensively on Wednesday night in a 59-52 loss at Bucknell. The Mountain Hawks started the game 1-for-18 from the field before shooting 14-for-30 in the second half, trimming an 11-point first half deficit down to two in the fourth quarter. Sophomore Camryn Buhr finished with 14 points and nine rebounds on 6-of-12 shooting. Senior Bernadette Devaney tallied nine points, and sophomore Cameryn Benz registered eight points and seven rebounds on 3-of-6 shooting. Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer finished with seven points, all of which came in the fourth quarter. Mariah Sexe scored six points on two triples at the end of the second and third quarters.

Bucknell won the battle on the boards 37-34 and came away with nine blocked shots and nine steals. The Bison shot 41.7 percent from the field and 20 percent from long range, while Lehigh shot 33.3 percent overall and 28.6 from downtown. Lehigh falls to 13-10 (7-5 PL), while Bucknell improves to 15-8 (9-3 PL).

"I thought we looked a little tired today," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We missed a large number of point-blank layups with no one between us and the basket. We missed a lot of easy baskets at the rim, which are shots we typically finish."

Both teams got off to sluggish starts as the Bison started 2-for-9 and Lehigh began 0-for-6 as the Bison built a 6-0 lead at the first media timeout at the 4:15 mark. Lehigh's first basket came nearly seven minutes in when Devaney broke a 0-for-7 start with a three-pointer at the 3:14 mark to make it 8-3. Devaney added a pair of free throws in the closing seconds to make it 12-5 after one quarter. Lehigh went 1-for-13 in the quarter, but Bucknell was not much better as both teams combined to go 5-for-28 in the opening frame.

LU started the second 0-for-5 before Williams hit a baseline jumper and Hedstrom followed with a jumper to make it 17-11. Bucknell built a 24-13 lead before Mann got on the scoresheet with a jumper in the lane to make it 24-15, and Mariah Sexe drained a three with four seconds left in the half as Lehigh cut it to 26-18 at halftime. Lehigh closed the half by hitting five of their last 12 shots after the 1-for-18 start, shooting 6-for-30 in the opening half. Bucknell was 9-for-26 (34.6 percent) in the opening 20 minutes. The 18 points was the second lowest point total for a half this season and the five points in the first quarter was a season-low.

Lehigh returned from the locker room and shot much better in the third quarter, outscoring Bucknell 18-13 in the period and shooting 7-for-13 to trim the deficit down to three. Buhr started the half by hitting her first four shots as Lehigh got within 31-26. Lehigh hit two out of a possible four free throws to make it 35-28 following a personal foul and technical foul coming out of the media timeout at 4:17. Benz scored three straight points to make it 39-33 in the final minute, then Sexe hit her second buzzer-beater in as many quarters, draining a long three from the corner as time expired to make it a three-point ballgame entering the fourth quarter.

"Mariah did a good job stepping up and doing her job," Troyan said. "She's a very strong perimeter shooter and knocked down some key buckets to keep us in the game."

"Cam Buhr stepped up and played really well for us," Troyan said. "She wanted the ball in her hands on the offensive end and I think we got all out of sorts when she had to sit in the first quarter with those two quick fouls before we made a run with her back in there in the second. I think that goes to show you how important she is to our team."

Benz hit a free throw to make it a two-point game 15 seconds into the fourth. Bucknell scored the next five points and kept the lead to no less than five until Gena Grundhoffer drilled a three-pointer as part of back-to-back hoops to make it 48-44 with 5:40 left. Bucknell started the quarter 4-for-5 from the field to hold a 50-44 lead at the media timeout. Benz and Devaney added back-to-back layups to cut the deficit down to four on two separate occasions, but from there, Bucknell went on to score their final seven points from the free throw line as Lehigh missed six of its last eight shots over the final 3:08.

"We didn't turn the ball over, but we didn't make a lot of shots," Troyan said. "In the last six possessions of the game, we had great open looks at the basket, but they just didn't go down."





