SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will travel to Army West Point this Saturday afternoon in a battle for fourth place in the Patriot League standings. The Mountain Hawks will look to end their first three-game losing skid of the season, while Army enters having won four of its last six games since losing by four to Lehigh at Stabler Arena on Jan 20.

Over their last five road games, Lehigh has allowed just 57.2 points per game, well below the season average of 65.0. The Mountain Hawks have also gathered 7.8 steals and a +1.4 turnover margin in those games.

Lehigh will look to get back on track, having lost five of their last six games since the last matchup against Army. Over that stretch, Lehigh holds a scoring margin of -4.3 while scoring 53.8 points per game. LU is shooting 35.2 percent overall and 26.4 percent from three-point range, and has not shot over 38 percent from the floor in five straight games.

During the team's three game losing streak, the Mountain Hawks are scoring an average of 48 points per game and shooting 31.8 percent from the field and 20 percent (11-for-55) from three-point range.

Lehigh will return home this coming Wednesday to face Loyola at 6 p.m.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 359-320 into Saturday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. ARMY WEST POINT

Lehigh enters Saturday's matchup trailing Army in the all-time series 33-31. The Black Knights have won 10 of the last 13 dating back to February 2013. The two programs met three times in 2014-15 and 2015-16, with Lehigh winning twice during the 2014-15 season, including a 76-57 win at Army in the Patriot League semifinals. Army has won three straight at Christl Arena.

Army won the first 11 matchups in the all-time series between the two schools, with their first meeting coming in the 1983-84 season. Lehigh had a six game winning streak from 2004-2006.

Earlier this year, Lehigh ended their five game losing skid to Army with a 59-55 win at Stabler Arena. Gena Grundhoffer tallied a career-high 21 points and seven rebounds on 7-of-9 shooting and Camryn Buhr had 14 points and eight rebounds on 6-of-10 shooting.

Last year at Christl Arena on Feb. 25, Army forced 20 turnovers and grabbed 13 steals in a 70-52 win. Despite Lehigh outshooting Army by a wide margin, Army outscored Lehigh 18-4 off turnovers and 20-4 on second chance points in the game.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS

Army has won four of its last six games since falling to Lehigh back on Jan. 20. After finishing 7-4 out of league, preseason co-PL favorite Army struggled to a 2-5 start to league play, but has fought its way back to 6-8 and fifth place in the Patriot League, just one game behind the Mountain Hawks. Scoring 62.0 ppg this season, the Black Knights have scored 55.9 ppg through 14 league games (9th in PL). Holding a +2.6 scoring margin and a .380 field goal pct. overall this season, Army is shooting 34.6 percent in league play and holds a -3.2 scoring margin, which has risen over six points since the last time the two teams met.

During their 4-2 stretch over the last six games, Army is 2-1 at home with wins of 62-47 over Loyola and 48-39 over Lafayette.

Preseason Player of the Year Madison Hovren has risen to third in the league in both scoring (15.1) and rebounding (10.4). She is seventh in field goal pct (.447). Last year's Defensive Player of the Year, Aliyah Murray, scores 10.5 ppg and is eighth in the league with 7.4 rebounds per game, but has not played in four consecutive games. Diazjah Morris ranks second in the league with 2.0 steals per game, leading the way for a team that ranks tied for second in the league with 9.0 steals per contest this season. As a team, Army ranks third by dishing out 12.7 assists per game, led by Janae McNeal (2.7 apg). McNeal is one of three Cadets to average double figures in league play with 11.2 ppg, which is third on the team.

Army also leads the PL by pulling in 15.5 offensive rebounds per game.

ARMY HEAD COACH DAVE MAGARITY

Dave Magarity is in his 12th season as head coach at Army and his 13th overall at West Point after serving as the associate head coach in 2005-06.

Magarity led the Black Knights to their third straight Patriot League regular season championship in 2015-16, capping a streak of four straight appearances in a national postseason tournament. Army earned an automatic bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament after also doing so in 2014. The Black Knights appeared in the WNIT during the 2013 and 2015 seasons.

Army completed the best season in team history in 2015-16, totaling a program-record 29 victories as part of a 29-3 overall record to match the Patriot League standard for most wins in a season. The 29 wins also gave Army their fourth consecutive 20-win season to mark the longest streak of that kind in program history.

The Black Knights finished 12-6 in league play last season to earn the third seed in the PL Tournament. They finished 17-1 in league play in 2015-16 last season en route to the No. 1 seed in the PL Tournament, which they won by defeating Loyola 69-51 in the championship game. The team earned the No. 13 seed in the NCAA Tournament, where they fell in the First Round to eventual national runner-up Syracuse.

ROAD PROGRESS

Over the last five road games, Lehigh's defense has held opponents to an average of 57.2 points and holds a +0.8 scoring margin, both well better than its season road averages. LU has gone 2-3 in those games, with two of those losses coming by three points at Loyola and Navy.

Over the last five road games, Lehigh has averaged 7.8 steals per game, 1.4 over its season average and holds a turnover margin of +1.4.

Lehigh has also trimmed nearly three points off its road scoring margin over the last five away games.

ROUGH ROUND TWO

Lehigh has struggled throughout the second half of league play, averaging 11.6 fewer points per game and going 1-4 over the second half, despite allowing over three fewer points per game than the first nine games.

AHEAD OF THE PACK

Hannah Hedstrom tied career highs with 11 rebounds and five steals on Wednesday against Colgate. It was the second time this season she achieved those totals, previously collecting 11 rebounds vs. Navy on Jan. 2 and five steals on Dec. 29 vs. Lafayette.

She also tallied seven assists, her second-highest total of the season.

MILESTONE TRACKER

Quinci Mann is eight points away from passing Jessica DePalo '05 and moving into sixth place on the school's all-time scoring list.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in six of its last nine games, with their 67-64 loss at Loyola and their two losses to unbeaten American being the only games where they have allowed 60 points during that stretch. The stretch includes holding Navy and their league-leading offense (67.4 ppg) to just 53 points in Annapolis.

POWER OUTAGE

Lehigh had its worst offensive output of the season at home in Saturday's loss to American, with their 44 points, 28.6 field goal pct., and 16 made field goals all home season lows. Overall, each of those stats was the second lowest output of the season, ahead of only the Nov. 17 game vs. Villanova at PPL Center.

On Wednesday against Colgate, Lehigh shot a season-low 15 percent (3-for-20) from three-point range.

DOWNTOWN CLOSED OFF

Through their first four Patriot League home games, Lehigh was 40-for-80 from three-point range. Over their last three, the team has gone a combined 9-for-54 (16.7 percent). Lehigh is shooting 32.9 percent from 3pt range this season (3rd in the PL) and is third in

POINTS IN QUARTERS

Four of Lehigh's seven lowest quarterly outputs of the season have occurred in the last three games. Lehigh scored seven points in the first quarter and six points in the fourth against American on Saturday. LU tied a season-low with five points in the first quarter last Wednesday at Bucknell. LU also had a five-point quarter earlier this season vs. Bucknell.

On Wednesday, Lehigh was held to eight points in the third quarter vs. Colgate.

FREE THROW STORY

Free throws were a common denominator in the outcomes of Lehigh's four games from Jan. 24-Feb. 7. Lehigh earned a big road win at Boston U. on Feb. 3 after converting 13-of-14 free throws in the fourth quarter and 20-of-23 in the game to help pull away from the Terriers for a nine-point win.

In their three losses over that stretch at Loyola, Navy and Bucknell, Lehigh was a combined 23-for-45 (51.1 percent), losing two of those games by just three points.

LOOKING FOR A REBOUND ON THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9, but has been outrebounded in nine of its first 14 league games, and drew even with Boston U. on Feb. 3. Lehigh's current rebounding margin in league play is -2.9, which is eighth in the league. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are sixth in rebounding margin at +0.1.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Jan. 17 at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 6.9 rebounds and ranks second with 13.0 ppg. In league play, she ranks eighth in rebounds (7.1) and is seventh with 3.1 assists per league game.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann is fifth with 15.3 ppg, is second with a 42.3 3FG% and ranks fourth with 2.1 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STORY OF THE FOURTH

Lehigh has been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in seven of its last nine games. Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 18 of 25 games this season, but 16 of those came in the first 17 games of the season.

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – The Lehigh women's basketball team shot 4-for-24 and was outscored 32-17 in the second half in a 54-48 loss to Colgate. The Mountain Hawks finished the game 18-for-54 (33.3 percent) from the field and 3-for-20 from beyond the arc, while the Raiders shot 20-for-56 (35.7 percent), including 45 percent over the final three quarters. Lehigh outrebounded Colgate 39-37, while the Raiders held advantages of 30-20 in the paint and 19-8 off turnovers. Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom had game-highs of 11 rebounds, seven assists and five steals for Lehigh. Camryn Buhr scored 15 points on 6-of-14 shooting and Quinci Mann tallied 14 points. Colgate improves to 5-20 (1-13 PL), while Lehigh drops to 13-12 (7-7 PL).

"Colgate played hard and tough," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We can't take this team for granted because they're scrappy and have been in a lot of close games, they just haven't finished them. Tonight they finished it."

Lehigh started the game on a 6-0 run over the first 3:37 after a layup from Gena Grundhoffer and two straight baskets from Mann. LU went over three minutes without another basket before Buhr added a layup off a Hedstrom assist to go up 8-4 and Hedstrom went coast to coast for a fast break layup at 1:31 to make it 10-4. Lehigh went 5-for-12 in the opening quarter while Colgate shot just 2-of-16, while each squad turned it over five times.

"I don't think we executed very well on the offensive end," Troyan said. "Give their matchup zone credit; they did a good job of not allowing us to have comfortable looks at the basket. We had a number of turnovers as well as missed shots. You can't do that against any Patriot League opponent."

Both teams turned up the intensity in the second quarter with Colgate shooting 61.5 percent in the period to Lehigh's 56.3 percent clip. Lehigh built the lead to 12-4 in the opening seconds and got the lead to a game-high nine (19-10) following a three-pointer by Benz at the 7:02 mark. From there, Colgate went on a 9-0 run to knot the game at 19, before Lehigh answered with six straight on consecutive layups from Buhr and one from Mann to make it 26-19 with 2:44 remaining. Meagan Eripret added two free throws with 1:19 left and Mann drained a three to beat the halftime buzzer, capping a 12-3 run to make it 31-22 at the half.

Two Grundhoffer free throws made it an eight-point lead again just over two minutes into the third. Grundhoffer made it 35-28 with a layup at the 6:06 mark, which would be the last made field goal for the Mountain Hawks for 9:49, going 0-for-11 during that stretch. The Raiders outscored Lehigh 20-8 in the period, tying the game at 35-35 with 2:59 to play, before Mann used two free throws to retake the lead, 37-35. Colgate responded quickly with a three-pointer and moments later and grew the lead to five before Buhr hit two free throws with eight seconds left to cut it to 42-39 after three.

"I don't think we were really ready to shoot the ball against them," Troyan said. "We were really reactive to the defense versus being aggressive against it. That hurt us."

'Gate struck for the first points of the quarter just over 2:30 into the fourth with a Tegan Graham layup before Grundhoffer found Buhr down low for a layup to end the streak and make it 44-41. After a Colgate layup, Bernadette Devaney hit Lehigh's first three of the half to get within two, and Hannah Hedstrom made it a one-point game with a free throw moments later.

After a Colgate layup, Buhr stepped up and drained a game-tying three with 1:06 left, but Summer King had the answer for Colgate at the other end of the floor, finishing off a three-point play with a free throw with 38 seconds left to get the lead back at 51-48. Lehigh would miss their final three shots and Colgate added three more from the line to seal their first league win.

"We have four big games left," Troyan said. "You have to take them one at a time. Hopefully, it burns a lot for them because it's a disappointing loss. We're going to have to make up for it. We're right in the hunt and trying to stay in the mix for a top -four seed so we can get a home game."





