SETTING THE SCENE

With the final week of the regular season upon us, the Lehigh women's basketball team will travel over to Easton on Saturday afternoon for a showdown against Lafayette. The two teams have not met since the Patriot League opener back on Dec. 29 at Stabler Arena, where Lehigh captured a 70-45 victory, marking season-bests in points, scoring margin and points allowed during league play.

The Mountain Hawks, who have allowed 60 points or fewer in seven straight games, are coming off a 64-55 win over Loyola on Wednesday, which snapped a season-long four game losing streak. Lehigh enjoyed a solid night offensively, shooting 42.2 percent from the field and 38.5 percent from three-point range. LU outrebounded the Greyhounds by three and outscored Loyola 26-2 in bench points.

Lafayette struggled offensively in a 44-41 win over Boston U. on Wednesday, but moved up into sole possession of sixth place in the Patriot League standings.

Lehigh and Army are currently tied at 8-8 in the league and have clinched either fourth or fifth place in the upcoming Patriot League Tournament. Lehigh owns the tiebreaker with Army and can clinch the No. 4 seed and a quarterfinal home game as early as Saturday with a win, plus an Army loss.

The Mountain Hawks will close out the regular season this Wednesday at home on Senior Night against Holy Cross at Stabler Arena.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 360-321 into Saturday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. LAFAYETTE

Lehigh and Lafayette will meet for the 93rd time when the two rivals square off on Saturday. The Mountain Hawks own a 48-44 advantage in the all-time series since the Leopards claimed a 45-35 victory in the first-ever meeting on February 4, 1975.

Lehigh has won five straight overall, including two in a row at Kirby, having swept the Leopards in each of the last two seasons. Lehigh has won eight in a row at Stabler Arena, with Lafayette's last win coming on Jan. 22, 2011. Lehigh's longest win streak over Lafayette is six games, which occurred twice (2001-03, 2008-10). The Leopards own the longest win streak of the series, winning eight-straight from the 1986-87 season to the 1988-89 season.

Since the turn of the century, Lehigh has taken victories in 31 of the 42 meetings with Lafayette. Lehigh has also won 10 of the last 13 matchups dating back to 2012.

Since opening her career with five straight wins over Lafayette, head coach Sue Troyan has lead the Mountain Hawks to a 36-15 record during her tenure.

SCOUTING THE LEOPARDS

Lafayette enters the final week of the regular season carrying a 10-16 (6-10 PL) record. The Leopards are coming off a three-point, 44-41 victory at home over Boston U. on Wednesday, but have not won back-to-back games since taking down Holy Cross and Colgate in early January.

Returning just two starters from last season, Lafayette has received major contributions this season from freshmen Natalie Kucowski and Drew Freeland, who are combining for nearly 20 points per game this season. Kucowski's 10.9 rebounds leads the Patriot League, and she ranks second during league play with 10.1 rebounds per game. Senior Sammy Stipa leads the team and ranks seventh in the PL with 3.0 assists per game.

Kucowski has won a league-leading five PL Rookie of the Week awards this season, while Freeland also has one to her credit.

As a team, Lafayette ranks fifth overall this season by allowing 60.5 points per game, but is last in scoring offense at 55.3 ppg. During league play, the team is shooting 38.5 percent, which is tied with Lehigh for fourth in the PL, and is one spot behind Lehigh in third by shooting 33.7 percent from three-point range. Their rebounding margin of +0.5 sits fourth in the Patriot League this season and they also rank fourth by blocking 3.3 shots per contest.

Lafayette completed the season sweep over Boston U. with Wednesday's win. Lafayette shot 23.7 percent from the field in the game and held BU to 24.5 percent overall and 2-of-19 from three-point range. Freeland led the Leopards with 15 points and Kucowski added eight points and 13 rebounds.

LAFAYETTE HEAD COACH KIA DAMON

Kia Damon is in the midst of her first season on College Hill after spending the previous 19 seasons as an assistant at Cincinnati, Penn State, UMass, Fairleigh Dickinson and Green Bay.

In her lone season at Cincinnati last year, Damon served as the offensive coordinator and led the Bearcats to their first winning season in a decade. She previously was at Penn State for nine years, where she mentored three All-Big 10 selections over her last four years, including two that went on to play in the WNBA.

While at UMass for five years, she served as the team's recruiting coordinator and helped pilot the team to its most successful season in 20 years in 2007. She also spent three years at Fairleigh Dickinson and got her coaching career started at Green Bay, where she helped lead the team to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths in the late 1990s.

Damon graduated from Millersville in 1997 with a degree in speech communication and earned a master's degree in corporate communication in from Fairleigh Dickinson in 2006. As a student-athlete at Millersville, she led the team to two appearances in the PSAC Tournament.

ROAD PROGRESS

Over the last six road games, Lehigh's defense has held opponents to an average of 56.8 points and holds a -0.1 scoring margin, both better than its season road averages. LU has gone 2-4 in those games, with two of those losses coming by three points at Loyola and Navy.

Over the last six road games, Lehigh has averaged 6.8 steals per game, just over its 6.2 season average and holds a turnover margin of +1.7. Lehigh has also trimmed nearly three points off its road scoring margin over the last six away games.

ROUGH ROUND TWO

Lehigh has struggled throughout the second half of league play, averaging 10.1 fewer points per game and going 2-5 over the second half, despite allowing nearly four fewer points per game than the first nine games. The team's 3pt percentage has also dropped 17.7 percent.

TWO FOR 20

Senior Bernadette Devaney tied her career-high with 20 points on Wednesday night against Loyola, shooting 7-for-10 from the field and 3-for-5 from three-point range. It was the second 20-point game of her career. Gena Grundhoffer also scored 20 points for the third time in her career, coming one shy of her season and career-high.

It was the second time this season Lehigh had two players score 20 points in the same game, joining Mann and Devaney (20 each) vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in eight of its last 11 games, with their 67-64 loss at Loyola and their two losses to unbeaten American being the only games where they have allowed 60 points during that stretch. The stretch includes holding Navy and their league-leading offense (67.1 ppg) to just 53 points in Annapolis.

40 PERCENT

Lehigh's win on Wednesday over Loyola moved the team to 12-2 this season when shooting at least 40 percent overall. The team's two losses had come in both of their previous games where they had shot 40 percent (1/24 at Loyola and 2/17 at Army).

UNDER 50

Lehigh's win over Loyola on Wednesday ended a streak of failing to reach the 50-point mark in back-to-back home games for the first time since Jan. 2013 when they scored 37 vs. Bucknell and 47 vs. Navy.

DOWNTOWN TURNAROUND

Lehigh enjoyed a solid night from three-point range on Wednesday, shooting 38.5 percent 5-for-13, its best night from downtown since shooting 7-for-14 at Loyola on Jan. 24. The game ended a stretch where LU failed to shoot at least 20 percent from three-point range in three straight games and a stretch of six straight without hitting at least 30 percent. Through their first four Patriot League home games, Lehigh was 40-for-80 from three-point range.

SKIDS IN GROUPS OF FOUR

From Feb. 7-17, Lehigh was held to 52 points or less in four straight games for the first time since a four-game stretch spanning the end of the 2010-11 season, and the first three games of the 2011-12 season, when the team combined for an average of 46.3 points (all four games were on the road).

AHEAD OF THE PACK

Hannah Hedstrom tied career highs with 11 rebounds and five steals on Feb. 14 against Colgate. It was the second time this season she achieved those totals, previously collecting 11 rebounds vs. Navy on Jan. 2 and five steals on Dec. 29 vs. Lafayette.

She also tallied seven assists, her second-highest total of the season.

POWER OUTAGE

Lehigh had its worst offensive output of the season at home in their Feb. 10 loss to American, with their 44 points, 28.6 field goal pct., and 16 made field goals all home season lows. Overall, each of those stats was the second lowest output of the season, ahead of only the Nov. 17 game vs. Villanova at PPL Center.

Last Wednesday against Colgate, Lehigh shot a season-low 15 percent (3-for-20) from three-point range.

LOOKING FOR A REBOUND ON THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9, but has been outrebounded in 10 of its 16 league games, and drew even with Boston U. on Feb 3. Lehigh's current rebounding margin in league play is -3.0, which is eighth in the league. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are sixth in rebounding margin at -0.2.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann is tied for seventh with 15.1 ppg, is second with a 40.3 3FG% and ranks fourth with 1.9 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STORY OF THE FOURTH

Lehigh outscored Loyola 17-11 in the fourth quarter on Wednesday, marking the first time in five games Lehigh outscored the opposition in the fourth quarter. Lehigh has either tied or been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in eight of its last 11 games. Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 19 of 27 games this season, but 16 of those came in the first 17 games of the season.

LEHIGH 64, LOYOLA 55

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – Senior Bernadette Devaney tied a career-high with 20 points and sophomore Gena Grundhoffer also scored 20 to help the Lehigh women's basketball team pull away from Loyola 64-55 on Wednesday at Stabler Arena. Devaney shot 5-of-10 from the field and 3-for-5 from beyond the arc, while Grundhoffer was 5-for-11 on the offensive end and led the team with nine rebounds. Senior Quinci Mann also scored in double figures with 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting. Camryn Buhr tallied seven points and six rebounds. The Mountain Hawks outshot Loyola 42.2 percent to 40 percent from the field and were 5-of-13 from downtown. Lehigh held a 36-33 edge in rebounds and a one-point advantage in points off turnovers, plus shot 14-for-19 from the free throw line.

The win clinches a first round bye for the Mountain Hawks in the upcoming Patriot League Tournament. Lehigh now sits at 14-13 (8-8 PL) while Loyola (7-20, 5-11 PL) drops their fifth straight.

"I was proud of our poise," said head coach Sue Troyan. "It could have gone either way. On the sideline they were focused in timeouts, they knew what they had to do and I thought they really did a good job coming out and executing, which was neat to see. If you're not doing those things and engaged or confident in what you're doing, it can go either way."

Mann hit an early three-pointer before Loyola tied it up 6-6 going into the media timeout at 4:43. Devaney answered a Loyola triple with a three of her own to get the lead back 11-9, which sparked an 8-0 Lehigh run to end the quarter. Camryn Benz and Mann combined for three free throws and Buhr nailed a pull-up jumper in the closing seconds to make it 16-9 after one.

A Grundhoffer layup got the lead back to seven early in the second quarter, 20-13. Loyola then went on a 7-0 run, with five of the points coming off turnovers, forcing a Lehigh timeout at the 6:11 mark. Both team traded buckets following the timeout before Grundhoffer drained a straightaway three and a layup to make it 27-22. She made it eight straight after hauling in a rebound and going coast-to-coast with juke move, and hit the ensuing free throw after a foul to go up 30-22.

Loyola responded with an 8-2 run to close the half as Lehigh led 32-30. Both teams shot over 40 percent in the opening half, with Lehigh leading the way at 45.8 percent. The Lehigh bench also outscored the Loyola bench 11-0 with seven from Devaney and four from Benz.

"It was a game that Gena really needed," Troyan said. "She's been struggling a little bit to find the basket on a consistent level, but to have her see the ball go through the basket, hit some mid-range jumpers and some free throws, it was a really important game for her confidence going into the last two games."

Two straight Lehigh turnovers led to four quick points for Loyola, giving them a 36-32 lead two minutes into the third quarter. Lehigh missed seven shots in a row as Loyola's run extended to 18-4 and gave them the 40-34 lead. Devaney broke the run with back-to-back threes to tie it, then retied it 42-42 with a layup at the 2:05 mark. Lehigh closed the frame with five straight points, starting with Mariah Sexe retying the game in the final minute with two free throws. Grundhoffer hit three free throws with one second left after being fouled attempting a shot at the horn to give Lehigh the 47-44 edge after three.

"Bernie's playing like a senior guard should," Troyan said. "She just has a good sense for the game and it's like having a coach out on the floor. She made big shots when we needed them and had those two big threes when we were down by six. Quinci did a great job of finding her and she hit back-to-back threes to tie it up. She had some big drives and finishes that we ran for her and really played a great floor game."

Devaney made it a 7-0 Lehigh run to make it 49-44 in the opening minute of the fourth. Loyola cut it to one on two separate occasions at the 7:52 and 3:39 marks, but Lehigh closed the game on a 9-2 run thanks to a Buhr jumper, and eight straight points from the charity stripe, including three from Grundhoffer and four from Devaney.
