#### SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team returns home for the final time in non-league play on Wednesday morning to face NJIT as the team and the University hosts the eighth annual Education Day, where they will welcome elementary and middle school students from Lehigh Valley area school districts. At last year's game, Lehigh set a women's basketball attendance record with 4,410 fans packing Stabler Arena.

Lehigh will look to remain unblemished all-time against NJIT, with both teams coming off defeats over the weekend. Lehigh turned around an 18-point deficit to get within one of Sacred Heart in the fourth quarter on Sunday before falling 66-55. Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer picked up 18 points and 13 rebounds in the game, sophomore Camryn Buhr had 13 points and seven rebounds, and senior Bernadette Devaney added 12 points. Lehigh held a 45-38 advantage on the boards, but was outscored in the fourth quarter for the first time all season, despite nearly completing the comeback attempt.

Lehigh will conclude its non-league schedule on Sunday afternoon against LIU Brooklyn at the Barclay's Center. After a break for final exams and the holidays, the Mountain Hawks will open Patriot League play Dec. 29 at home versus Lafayette.

#### IF LEHIGH BEATS NJIT

- Lehigh would improve to 5-3 all-time in Education Day games.
- Lehigh would improve to 12-0 all-time vs. NJIT. Their current 11-0 mark is the most wins without a defeat against any opponent.

#### LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 351-312 into Wednesday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

#### ALL-TIME VS. NJIT

The Mountain Hawks and Highlanders will meet up for the 12th time in program history, and the 12th year in a row, dating back to their first matchup on December 9, 2006 in Newark, N.J., which the Mountain Hawks won by a score of 70-44. Lehigh has won all 11 matchups between the two programs.

In the 11 meetings between the two teams, Lehigh has faced NJIT five times at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks have outscored NJIT by an average of 71.8-51.4.

Lehigh's largest margin of victory over NJIT at home was last year's 32-point, 84-52 win on Nov. 30, 2016. The 77-72 victory over the Highlanders on November 11, 2013 is the slimmest margin of victory for Lehigh at home. Lehigh's 84 points scored last year is the most points scored by either team in the series.

#### SCOUTING THE HIGHLANDERS

NJIT enters Wednesday's matchup with a 0-8 record on the season. NJIT is 0-5 on the road this year, including their most recent 55-43 setback at Morgan State on Saturday. Redshirt junior Tatianna Torres lead the Highlanders with 16 points and freshman Ellyn Stoll also netted double figures with 10 points.

Torres, a Preseason All-Atlantic Sun selection was also picked as the fan-voted ASUN Preseason Player of the Year, returns after scoring 10.3 ppg last season and setting a NJIT D-I program record with 67 steals. This season, she is leading NJIT with 11.6 points per game and senior Taj Lewis is also scoring in double figures at 10.8 ppg. Lewis leads the squad with a 52.8 field goal percentage, with all 72 of her shots attempts coming from inside the arc. Freshman Dez Allen is the Highlanders biggest threat from the outside, shooting 27.3 percent from three-point range, and sophomore Danielle Tunstall, the team's top returning forward as an ASUN All-Rookie pick last season, leads the Highlanders with seven rebounds per game.

Lehigh and NJIT have no common opponents yet this season. The Highlanders did drop a 79-49 decision to Patriot League foe Army West Point, and also fell 67-49 to LIU Brooklyn, who Lehigh will play this Sunday.

NJIT was picked to finish sixth out of eight teams in the Atlantic Sun Preseason Poll.

#### NJIT HEAD COACH STEVE LANPHER

Now in his sixth season at NJIT, Steve Lanpher led the team to its first conference championship when the Highlanders captured the Great West Conference Tournament title on March 16, 2013 in Chicago.

Upon taking over at NJIT, Lanpher already was a veteran of nearly 20 years coaching girls and women's basketball, having most recently been the women's basketball associate head coach at the UMass when he got the call to lead the Highlander program.

Lanpher, who has been a head coach at the high school, junior college and at the four-year college level in NCAA Division III, has seven years of experience as either an assistant coach or associate head coach at the NCAA Division I level.

A 1987 graduate of College of St. Joseph in Rutland, Vt., with a bachelor's degree and a master's degree three years later, Lanpher began his coaching career with a three-year stint as head girl's basketball coach at West Rutland High School. He returned to the College of St. Joseph as women's basketball coach in 1993-94, before serving in the United States Army as a Ranger in the First Ranger Battalion in Savannah, Ga.

#### **EDUCATION DAY**

Lehigh is hosting its eighth annual Education Day on Dec. 6, welcoming elementary and middle school students from Bethlehem and Allentown to Stabler Arena. Last year's event against Delaware State drew a LU women's basketball record crowd of 4,410, surpassing the previous benchmark of 4,078 that was set on Dec. 2, 2014 against Hampton.

#### **GOING GOLD**

Lehigh will debut their new gold alternate uniforms against NJIT. It will mark the first time in program history that the Mountain Hawks will take the court in gold uniforms.

#### **BREAKING THEIR HEARTS**

Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer scored 18 points and added a career-high 13 rebounds at Sacred Heart on Sunday for her second career double-double. Grundhoffer's other double-double also came against Sacred Heart last year at Stabler Arena with a 19-point, 11 rebound performance.

#### **BERN BABY BERN**

Senior Bernadette Devaney was red hot last week, scoring 32 points over two games on 10-of-20 shooting, including a 10-for-15 performance from three-point range. She scored a career-high 20 points on Wednesday against Mount St. Mary's, besting her previous career-high of 13, which she had done three times. She also knocked down a career-best six three pointers on 6-of-9 shooting in the game.

#### **GETTING BEATEN THE BUZZER**

This season, opponents have scored six three-pointers in the final three seconds of periods against Lehigh (out of a possible 36 periods). The Mountain Hawks have scored three buzzer-beaters of their own during the same stretch, combining for eight points.

#### **MOVING UP THE LIST**

Senior Quinci Mann had a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's. In doing so, she moved into a tie for fourth on Lehigh's all-time three-point list, and enters Wednesday with 158 for her career. She ranks ninth in the Patriot League with 12.8 ppg.

#### LIVING DOWNTOWN

Lehigh registered its best shooting night of the season against Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29, when they shot 50 percent overall and 56.5 percent from three-point range. Lehigh drained 13 three-pointers in the game, their most since they made 13 against Binghamton on Dec. 4, 2010.

#### 2017 X-MAS CLASSIC RECAP

Lehigh advanced to the finals of the Christmas City Classic for the 16th time in the 20-year history of the tournament. After holding off Fairfield 56-53 in the opening round, Lehigh rallied from a 21-point fourth quarter deficit to get within four points of La Salle, before eventually falling 69-61. Lehigh has won four titles, with the most recent coming in 2010.

Sophomore Camryn Buhr scored a career-high 22 points against Fairfield in Saturday's first round action and added 10 more on Sunday to be named to the all-tournament team. Buhr averaged 16 points, four rebounds, one assist and one steal over the two games.

#### TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom is averaging 6.0 assists per game over the last five contests. In Lehigh's win over Mansfield on Nov. 22, she dished out a career-high 12 assists, coming just three shy of tying the program's single-game record of 15 held by Patty Garnish (1976) and Hope Pellicane (1993). Hedstrom also registered a pair of six-assist games against Fairfield on Nov. 25 and Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29. Her 4.1 assts/gm ranks second in the Patriot League.

#### FINISHING STRONG

The fourth quarter has been the Mountain Hawks best quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 18.9-15.2. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter of only one game this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in all other quarters.

#### CRASHING THE BOARDS

Lehigh's game against La Salle on Nov. 26 is the only time in eight games this season that Lehigh has been outrebounded. Through the first nine games, Lehigh holds a rebounding margin of +2.8, which ranks fourth in the Patriot League, and the team has climbed to has high as second in that category this season. Lehigh also ranks fourth in the PL in defensive rebounding (27.9).

Last season, Lehigh's rebounding margin through its first three games was -37.0.

#### PLAYING ON THE BIG STAGE

On Dec. 10, Lehigh will play LIU Brooklyn as part of a doubleheader at the Barclays Center, home of the Brooklyn Nets. This will mark the first time in program history Lehigh has played in an arena that served as the home for an NBA team at the time. Lehigh defeated NJIT 65-54 at the Prudential Center in Newark on Dec. 18, 2008, which two years later became the temporary home for the former New Jersey Nets. LU also played Villanova at PPL Center in Allentown, Pa. on Nov. 17.

#### PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

Lehigh was picked seventh in the Patriot League Preseason Poll and is looking to rebound after a ninth place finish in last year's Patriot League standings. LU fell in the first round of the league tournament to Loyola. It was the first time Lehigh had failed to qualify for at least the semifinals since the league went to the current tournament format in 2013-14.

### **DECEMBER 3, 2017** SACRED HEART 65, LEHIGH 55

FAIRFIELD, Conn. - Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer registered her second career-double-double FAIRFIELD, Conn. - Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer registered her second career-double-double with 18 points and a career-high 13 rebounds, but a second half rally by the Mountain Hawks fell short in a 65-55 loss at Sacred Heart on Sunday afternoon. Grundhoffer was 8-for-20 from the field and 2-of-4 from beyond the arc. Sophomore Camryn Buhr added 13 points and seven rebounds on 6-of-13 from the field, and senior Bernadette Devaney scored in double figures for the second straight game with 12 points on 4-of-7 from three-point range. After being down by 18 late in the first half, the Mountain Hawks rallied to get within one midway through the fourth quarter, before SHU ran off the final eight points of the game to hold off the Lehigh rally.

Lehigh shot 36.7 percent from the field and was 6-for-17 from three-point range, while SHU went 24-for-62 (38.7 percent) from the field and was 8-for-19 from the outside. The Mountain struggled at the free throw line in the game, going 5-for-13 and SHU came away with nine steals off 18 Lehigh turnovers. Lehigh (5-4) outrebounded the Pioneers (3-4) 45-38, while SHU held a 17-7 edge in points off turnovers, and a 32-24 advantage in the paint.

"We definitely did not execute down the stretch like we needed to," said head coach Sue Troyan. "I think we did a good job of fighting and clawing our way back into it in the third and fourth quarters, but turnovers came back to be our nemesis for the entire game. They did a good job pressuring us and not allowing us to do what we wanted to do down the stretch."

Grundhoffer started 3-for-5 including a three-pointer to help Lehigh go up 9-6, before Sacred Heart used a series of steals to go on a 5-0 run and take an 11-9 lead into the first media timeout at 4:29.

SHU hit a three following the timeout before Sexe found Buhr underneath to get Lehigh within two at 14-12. SHU added a fast break layup and Candice Leatherwood beat the first quarter buzzer with a three to give the Pioneers a 19-12 lead after one.

Sacred Heart began the second quarter on a 9-2 run, extending their overall run to 22-5 to take a 28-14 lead with 4:51 to go in the quarter. Grundhoffer and Mae Williams each added layups, but SHU had the answer each time to ensure Lehigh got no closer than 12 points. Devaney sank back-to-back three-pointers that got Lehigh within 36-24 with 1:14 to go and Cameryn Benz used two free throws with under a minute to go to get Lehigh to within 11. Katherine Haines drained an open three from the left wing to give the Pioneers a 40-26 edge at the half.

Sacred Heart used five steals on seven Lehigh turnovers and held a 12-3 edge in points off turnovers through the opening 20 minutes. Grundhoffer led all players with 11 points and seven rebounds at the break.

Buhr started the second half 3-for-5 with six points and Grundhoffer connected from downtown to get Lehigh back within single digits at 44-35 with 4:49 to go in the third quarter. Benz and Grundhof-fer added back-to-back layups to cut it to 44-39, before SHU's Erin Storck drained a three to end the 9-0 Lehigh run. Buhr answered a short time later with a layup, and Devaney answered a Storck layup with another three-pointer to make it 50-44. After SHU got the lead back to 10, Devaney added her fourth three of the game in the final minute to make it 54-47 entering the fourth.

"We defended a lot better in the second half, and if we had a little better intensity in the first half, it probably would have been a different game," Troyan said. "We certainly dug ourselves a hole in the first half allowing them to do whatever they wanted to do offensively."

Grundhoffer and Mariah Sexe scored the first three points of the fourth to get Lehigh within four. After a SHU free throw, Hannah Hedstrom found Buhr, who juked past a defender underneath and laid it in to make it a one-point game at 55-54 with 5:27 to play. However, that would be the final field goal of the game for Lehigh, who missed their last seven shots from the field. Following a Haines layup with 3:50 to go, and Sexe got Lehigh back within two points with a free throw. Tykera Carter drained a three-pointer to make 60-55 after a LU turnover with just over two minutes left, and Haines delivered the dagger with a three-pointer after two Lehigh missed free throws to make it 63-55 with 1:19 left. Carter would add a breakaway layup following a steal to finalize the scoring for SHU and cement the 10-point victory.

"The free throws and turnovers were probably the difference in the game," Troyan said. "It was disappointing because I thought we gave the game away."
