SETTING THE SCENE

After a nearly three-week layoff, the Lehigh women's basketball team will open up Patriot League play this Friday at Stabler Arena against Lafayette. The matchup marks the earliest matchup ever between the two schools and the first time in 16 years the two teams will open up league play against each other.

Lafayette snapped a three-game losing streak with a 70-52 win in their last game on Dec. 20 at Wagner and are 4-3 over their last seven games. The Mountain Hawks struggled down the stretch, losing three of their last five heading into the holidays. Lehigh will look to extend its winning streak over the Leopards to five games, and its home court winning streak against the Leopards to eight games. Lehigh will also look to reverse its fortunes in afternoon games, where the team has gone 1-5 on the season.

Lehigh finished its non-league schedule with a winning record for the fourth time in the last five years. Lehigh has only been outrebounded in one of its 11 games so far this season, and ranks third in the league with 3.6 blocks per contest. Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom is tied for second in the PL with 3.9 assists per game, and has averaged 5.14 over her last seven games. Senior Quinci Mann (12.4 ppg) and sophomore Camryn Buhr (12.1 ppg) both rank in the top 10 in the league in scoring, and sophomore Cameryn Benz ranks sixth with a team-leading 48.3 field goal percentage.

Next, Lehigh will remain at home to begin 2018 with a matchup on Tuesday, Jan. 2 against Navy (10-1).

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 352-313 into Friday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. LAFAYETTE

Lehigh and Lafayette will meet for the 92nd time when the two rivals square off on Friday at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks own a 47-44 advantage in the all-time series since the Leopards claimed a 45-35 victory in the first-ever meeting on February 4, 1975.

Lehigh has won four straight after sweeping the Leopards in each of the last two seasons. Lehigh carries a seven game winning streak over Lafayette at Stabler Arena, with Lafayette's last win coming on Jan. 22, 2011. Lehigh's longest win streak over Lafayette is six games, which occurred twice (2001-03, 2008-10). The Leopards own the longest win streak of the series, winning eight-straight from the 1986-87 season to the 1988-89 season.

Since the turn of the century, Lehigh has taken victories in 30 of the 41 meetings with Lafayette. Lehigh has also won nine of the last 12 meetings dating back to 2012.

Since opening her career with five-straight wins over Lafayette, head coach Sue Troyan has lead the Mountain Hawks to wins in 35 out of 50 meetings against the Leopards.

SCOUTING THE LEOPARDS

Entering with a 4-6 record, Lafayette enters Patriot League play coming off a 70-52 win over Wagner in their final game before the holiday break. The Leopards are 2-1 this season against common opponents with Lehigh, while LU is 1-2. Both teams won road matchups by single digits at Cornell and lost to La Salle at home. Lafayette topped LIU Brooklyn at home 69-53, while the Mountain Hawks dropped a three-point decision to the Blackbirds at the Barclays Center.

Returning just two starters from last season, Lafayette has received major contributions this season from true freshmen Natalie Kucowski and Drew Freeland, who have combined to win three Patriot League Rookie of the Week awards. Kucowski leads the league and ranks ninth in the country with 12.1 rebounds per game, and senior Anna Ptasinski ranks fourth in the Patriot League with a 43.9 3FG pct. and 2.3 3FG/game. Kucowski and Ptasinski lead the team with 11.3 and 8.6 points per game, respectively. Freeland scores 7.7 points and ranks second with 4.3 rebounds per game. Senior point guard Sammy Stipa comes in sixth in the league with 3.4 assists per game.

Freeland is coming off a career-best 17 points while going 3-for-4 from three-point range on Dec. 20, leading the team to a season-best 70 points in their win over Wagner. Her efforts garnered her PL Rookie of the Week honors. Kucowski also had a career night with 15 points, 18 rebounds and five assists.

LAFAYETTE HEAD COACH KIA DAMON

Kia Damon is in the midst of her first season on College Hill after spending the previous 19 seasons as an assistant at Cincinnati, Penn State, UMass, Fairleigh Dickinson and Green Bay.

In her lone season at Cincinnati last year, Damon served as the offensive coordinator and led the Bearcats to their first winning season in a decade. She previously was at Penn State for nine years, where she mentored three All-Big 10 selections over her last four years, including two that went on to play in the WNBA.

While at UMass for five years, she served as the team's recruiting coordinator and helped pilot the team to its most successful season in 20 years in 2007. She also spent three years at Fairleigh Dickinson and got her coaching career started at Green Bay, where she helped lead the team to a pair of NCAA Tournament berths in the late 1990s.

Damon graduated from Millersville in 1997 with a degree in speech communication and earned a master's degree in corporate communication in from Fairleigh Dickinson in 2006. As a student-athlete at Millersville, she led the team to two appearances in the PSAC Tournament.

OPENING WITH THE LEOPARDS

Lehigh will be opening up Patriot League play against Lafayette for the first time since the 2000-01 season. The two teams have opened up Patriot League play against each other just three times previously (1996-97, 1997-98, 2000-01), with Lehigh winning two of those three matchups. This is the earliest in the season the two teams have ever squared off, surpassing the previous date of Jan. 7, 1998.

PATRIOT LEAGUE OPENERSLehigh holds a 17-10 record in Patriot League openers. Overall, LU holds a 180-200 record through their first 27 years in league play.

AFTERNOON WOES

Lehigh is just 1-5 this season in games played in the afternoon, compared to 5-0 in games started in the morning or evening. LU has scored 59.3 ppg and holds a scoring margin of -12.0 in afternoon games, while scoring 70.6 points and holding a scoring margin of +14.2 in non-afternoon games. The team's only afternoon win came over Fairfield in the Christmas City Classic.

PLAYING ON THE BIG STAGE

Lehigh's last game on Dec. 10 against LIU Brooklyn was played at the Barclays Center, home of the Brooklyn Nets. This marked the first time in program history Lehigh played in an arena that served as the home for an NBA team at the time.

This season, Lehigh has also played at larger venues like PPL Center in Allentown, Pa. (Villanova) and Williams Arena in Minneapolis (Minnesota).

BETHLEHEM BLOCK PARTY

Lehigh recorded six blocks in its Dec. 6 win over NJIT, their most in a game since rejecting 11 shots vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 19, 2013. As a team, Lehigh ranks third in the Patriot League with 3.6 blocks per game.

EDUCATION DAY

Lehigh hosted its eighth annual Education Day on Dec. 6 with a 64-50 win over NJIT. LU welcomed 4,009 elementary and middle school students from Bethlehem and Allentown to Stabler Arena, which was the third largest crowd in program history. Last year's event against Delaware State drew a LU women's basketball record crowd of 4,410, surpassing the previous benchmark of 4,078 that was set on Dec. 2, 2014 against Hampton.

BERN BABY BERN

Senior Bernadette Devaney had a strong finish to non-league play, averaging 11.8 points over the last four games.

It began with a career-best 20-point performance on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's, besting her previous career-high of 13, which she had done three times. She also knocked down a career-best six three pointers on 6-of-9 shooting in the game. Over a three-game stretch from 11/29 to 12/6, she had 40 points on 12-of-25 shooting and 11-of-18 from threepoint range.

GETTING BEATEN THE BUZZER

This season, opponents have scored seven baskets, including six three-pointers, in the final three seconds of periods against Lehigh (out of a possible 44 periods). The Mountain Hawks have scored three buzzer-beaters of their own during the same stretch, combining for eight points.

MOVING UP THE LIST

Senior Quinci Mann has moved into fourth on the school's all-time three-point list with 160 career triples. She enters Friday's game just six three-pointers away from tying Erica Prosser for third on the school's all-time list. She sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's and ranks ninth in the Patriot League with 12.4 ppg and T-sixth with 1.5 3FG/game.

LIVING DOWNTOWN

Lehigh registered its best shooting night of the season against Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29, when they shot 50 percent overall and 56.5 percent from three-point range. Lehigh drained 13 three-pointers in the game, their most since they made 13 against Binghamton on Dec. 4, 2010.

TIS' THE SEASON OF GIVING

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom is averaging 5.14 assists per game over the last seven contests. In Lehigh's win over Mansfield on Nov. 22, she dished out a career-high 12 assists, coming just three shy of tying the program's single-game record of 15 held by Patty Garnish (1976) and Hope Pellicane (1993). Hedstrom also registered a pair of six-assist games against Fairfield on Nov. 25 and Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29. Her 3.9 assists per game ranks tied for second in the Patriot League.

FINISHING STRONG

The fourth quarter has been the Mountain Hawks best quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 18.1-14.6. Lehigh has only been outscored once in the fourth quarter of only one game this season (11-8 at Sacred Heart), while currently being outscored by their opponents in all other quarters.

CRASHING THE BOARDS

Lehigh's game against La Salle on Nov. 26 is the only time in eight games this season that Lehigh has been outrebounded. Through the first 11 games, Lehigh holds a rebounding margin of +3.9, which ranks fourth in the Patriot League, and the team has climbed to has high as second in that category this season. Lehigh also ranks fourth in the PL in offensive (12.0) defensive rebounding (28.0).

Last season, Lehigh's rebounding margin through its non-league schedule (11 games) was -2.0.

PATRIOT LEAGUE PRESEASON POLL

Lehigh was picked seventh in the Patriot League Preseason Poll and is looking to rebound after a ninth place finish in last year's Patriot League standings. LU fell in the first round of the league tournament to Loyola. It was the first time Lehigh had failed to qualify for at least the semifinals since the league went to the current tournament format in 2013-14.

LAST TIME OUT FOR LEHIGH

DECEMBER 10, 2017 LIU BROOKLYN 72, LEHIGH 69

BROOKLYN, N.Y. – A last second three-point attempt was off the mark as the Lehigh women's basketball team fell 72-69 to LIU Brooklyn on Sunday afternoon at the Barclays Center. Sophomore Camryn Buhr scored a game-high 18 points, and sophomore Hannah Hedstrom scored 10 second half points to finish with 12 for the game along with six rebounds and four steals. Sophomore Cameryn Benz netted 10 points and freshman Mariah Sexe scored seven points and collected a career-high seven rebounds. Senior Mae Williams added five points and four rebounds and senior Bernadette Devaney added seven points. The Mountain Hawks conclude non-league play at 6-5 overall.

Lehigh struggled in the game, failing to convert on 24 LIU turnovers and on multiple shot attempts underneath. Lehigh shot 36.6 percent overall and was just 4-for-22 from three-point range. The Blackbirds (4-5) shot nearly 45 percent for the game and 43 percent from three-point land. Lehigh committed 22 turnovers to LIU's 24, while Lehigh held a 36-28 edge in the paint and 15-6 on second chances.

"It's a disappointing loss for us," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We're going to look back at this and see there were a lot of missed opportunities. I thought we played hard, but didn't execute very well. When you get good looks at the basket, you hope to convert on those and we didn't do a good job of that."

Lehigh got off to a 3-for-6 start from the field to hold a 9-8 lead at the under-five media timeout. Back-to-back buckets by Sexe, one on a second chance, helped Lehigh tie it at 13, before Buhr got her own offensive rebounds and put it in while drawing a foul. She hit the ensuing free throw to give Lehigh the 16-13 lead. LIU put in a jumper with just over a minute left to cut it to 16-15 after one.

After trading buckets through the first three minutes of the second quarter, LIU built the lead to a half-high four points at 28-24 at the 6:27 mark. From there, Lehigh ran off on a 10-0 run, and extended it to 16-5 overall over the next four minutes to take a 40-33 lead. Devaney found Hedstrom for a layup to give Lehigh the 30-28 lead, then Devaney drew the charge on the defensive end, which led to a Benz second-chance layup to make it 32-28. Devaney then added a bucket to make it 34-28, before Denisha Petty-Evans hit a three-pointer for LIU to make it 34-31. After two free throws by Benz, Buhr tacked on a layup after a LIU turnover and Sexe added two free throws to make it 40-33 with 2:14 remaining. The Blackbirds scored the final basket of the half to cut it to 40-35 at the break. Buhr led all scorers with 14 points at the half, while Benz, Sexe and Mann each had six.

LIU scored six straight to take a 41-40 lead to start the second half, before Hedstrom got Lehigh the lead back with a layup, then Buhr found Williams up ahead of the field for a quick basket to make it 44-41 Lehigh. LIU regained the lead and extended the run to 13-4, building a four-point edge before Lehigh tied the game at 50. Mary Clougherty grabbed a steal, then fed Devaney down court for a layup while being fouled. Devaney completed the three-point play to put the Mountain Hawks back up 51-50 at the 2:39 mark before LIU scored seven of the next nine points to take the lead for good.

The Blackbirds dominated the period on the glass, outrebounding Lehigh 12-5 in the frame and outscoring them 22-13 to hold a 57-53 lead to start the fourth quarter.

"I thought they went to the boards hard in the third quarter and we didn't respond well," Troyan said. "I thought in the first half we did a good job keeping them off the offensive glass, but the third quarter was a critical point for us in giving them second chance opportunities."

Lehigh got within one point with 6:05 to go in the fourth, but LIU's Jeydah Johnson answered with a three-pointer to make it 62-58. A pair of free throws with 2:43 left gave LIU its largest lead of the game at 67-60, before Lehigh forced a pair of turnovers, but was unable to convert them into points. Hedstrom got it back to a two-possession game with a three-pointer, before LIU responded with two free throws to go back up by six, 69-63 with 43 seconds left.

Following a turnover by each team, Williams responded with a three from the corner to make it 69-66 with 27 seconds left. After a loose ball foul with 20.7 seconds left, Johnson hit one free throw to make it 70-66, but Hedstrom came right back by driving the lane, drawing the foul and hitting the layup with 13 seconds left to get the Mountain Hawks within one at 70-69. The Lehigh defense then stepped up and forced another Blackbird turnover on the ensuing inbounds pass, giving them the ball back with 12 seconds left and a chance to take the lead. Quinci Mann's baseline jumper off the inbound was off target and Lehigh was forced to foul after the defensive rebound. Two free throws made it a three-point game with seven seconds left, as Lehigh turned to Buhr for a potential game-tying three, but the shot was off the mark as LIU hung on for the close win.

"I thought we had a lot of easy looks at the basket and just couldn't knock them down without any defensive pressure," Troyan said. "I thought in the fourth quarter we fought to create turnovers but just couldn't convert off of them."




