SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team returns home this Saturday for the lone time in a seven game stretch to on Army West Point on Alumnae Day. Lehigh will be welcoming back many players from over the years and will hold a halftime ceremony paying tribute to the 1996-97 team that captured the program's first Patriot League Championship and NCAA Tournament berth.

Lehigh has won three of its last four games, and is unbeaten at home in league play at 4-0. The Mountain Hawks are coming off their first road win during PL play on Wednesday night at Colgate, holding off a late 12-2 Raiders' run for a 59-51 win. Lehigh never trailed in the game and notched nine steals off 14 Colgate turnovers in the game, but the Raiders held a 15-14 edge in points off turnovers. Senior Quinci Mann led the Mountain Hawks with 15 points to move into seventh place on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,348 points. Camryn Buhr picked up her team-leading fifth double-double of the season (fourth during league play) with 12 points and 10 rebounds, and Cameryn Benz tied a career-high with eight rebounds.

Army West Point dropped an eight-point overtime decision on Wednesday night at home to Holy Cross. Army's bench contributed a season-high 25 points, while outrebounding Holy Cross 43-39 and outscoring them 16-7 in second chance points.

After this weekend, Lehigh will head out on a four-game road trip, beginning Wednesday evening at Loyola (Md.).

IF LEHIGH BEATS ARMY

- Lehigh would improve to 5-0 at home in league play for the first time since 2009-10.
- Lehigh would surpass its win total in league play from last season.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 357-315 into Saturday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. ARMY WEST POINT

Lehigh enters Saturday's matchup trailing Army in the all-time series 33-30. The Black Knights have won 10 of the last 12 dating back to February 2013. The two programs met three times in 2014-15 and 2015-16, with Lehigh winning twice during the 2014-15 season, including a 76-57 win at Army in the Patriot League semifinals. Army has won three straight at Stabler Arena.

Last season, Quinci Mann and Bernadette Devaney scored 13 points each and Cameryn Benz added 11 in a 75-71 defeat to open league play. Both teams combined for 57 points in a seesaw fourth quarter before Army ended the game on a 7-0 run.

In their second matchup last year on Feb. 25, Army forced 20 turnovers and grabbed 13 steals in a 70-52 win. Despite Lehigh outshooting Army by a wide margin, Army outscored Lehigh 18-4 off turnovers and 20-4 on second chance points in the game.

Army won the first 11 matchups in the all-time series between the two schools, with their first meeting coming in the 1983-84 season. Lehigh had a six game winning streak from 2004-2006.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS

After finishing 7-4 out of league, preseason co-PL favorite Army has struggled to a 2-5 record in Patriot League play. Scoring 63.8 ppg this season, the Cadets have scored just 54.4 ppg through seven league games. Holding a +2.6 scoring margin and a .385 field goal pct. overall this season, Army holds a -9.3 scoring margin and is shooting 32.5 percent in league play (20.5 3FG%), all of which rank in the bottom two of the league.

Both of Army's league wins have come on the road at Lafayette and Loyola. They have averaged 67 points in those two wins, while scoring just 49 points in their league losses. The Cadets were outscored 18-10 in overtime of their game Wednesday at home against Holy Cross, dropping a 70-62 decision.

Preseason Player of the Year Madison Hovren ranks fifth in the league in both scoring (14.6) and field goal percentage (.438), while ranking third with 10.3 rebounds per game. Last year's Defensive Player of the Year, Aliyah Murray, scores 10.1 ppg and 7.3 reb. per game. Diazjah Morris ranks second in the league with 2.1 steals per game, leading the way for a team that ranks second in the league with 9.7 steals per contest this season. As a team, Army ranks second in the PL by holding a +3.7 rebounding margin and sits atop of the group by hauling in 14.8 offensive rebounds per game.

Margaret Anne Hubbell has come off the bench in all 18 games to shoot over 50 percent from the floor, with Libby Tacka (40.9) and Destinee Morris (25.4) as their top threats from beyond the arc.

ARMY HEAD COACH DAVE MAGARITY

Dave Magarity is in his 12th season as head coach at Army and his 13th overall at West Point after serving as the associate head coach in 2005-06.

Magarity led the Black Knights to their third straight Patriot League regular season championship in 2015-16, capping a streak of four straight appearances in a national postseason tournament. Army earned an automatic bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament after also doing so in 2014. The Black Knights appeared in the WNIT during the 2013 and 2015 seasons.

Army completed the best season in team history in 2015-16, totaling a program-record 29 victories as part of a 29-3 overall record to match the Patriot League standard for most wins in a season. The 29 wins also gave Army their fourth consecutive 20-win season to mark the longest streak of that kind in program history.

The Black Knights finished 12-6 in league play last season to earn the third seed in the PL Tournament. They finished 17-1 in league play in 2015-16 last season en route to the No. 1 seed in the PL Tournament, which they won by defeating Loyola 69-51 in the championship game. The team earned the No. 13 seed in the NCAA Tournament, where they fell in the First Round to eventual national runner-up Syracuse.

PARTY LIKE IT'S 1997

As part of Saturday's Alumnae Day festivities, Lehigh will welcome back many of its former players, including several members of the 1997 team that captured the program's first Patriot League Championship and NCAA Tournament berth. In front of a then-record crowd of 2,561 at Stabler Arena, Lehigh defeated Lafayette in the title game 65-63 in overtime when Kelly Madden hit a buzzer-beating floater from near the foul line. Lehigh advanced to play No. 1 UConn in the opening round of the NCAA Tournament.

HOME COOKING

Lehigh is in the midst of a stretch where they are playing six of seven games on the road. Lehigh is off to an 8-1 start at home this season, their best home start since going undefeated at home in 2009-10, but are 3-5 on the road this season. Wednesday's win at Colgate snapped a four game road losing streak. Lehigh was 2-12 on the road last season.

MONKEY OFF THEIR BACKS

Despite getting outshot 34.5 percent to 33.9 percent on Wednesday, Lehigh captured their first road win in league play and ended their four game road losing streak. Colgate shrunk a 14-point fourth quarter deficit down to four with 1:23 remaining, but Cam Buhr scored a huge second chance jumper in the lane with 29 seconds left and Cam Benz tacked on two free throws to secure the win.

SIZZLING FROM THE FIELD

Since the start of league play, the Mountain Hawks rank in the top four in every major offensive category, including a league leading three-point percentage of .434. Lehigh is also tops the league with 8.0 made 3FGs per league game. They rank third in scoring offense (64.0) and fourth by allowing just 59.3 points per league game.

In their four league home games, Lehigh has shot 45.4 percent from the floor and an even 50 percent (40-for-80) from three-point range. Lehigh has averaged 10 made three-pointers in home league games, while surrendering just 3.5.

ONE-TWO PUNCH

Camryn Buhr and Quinci Mann have finished as the team's top two scorers in four of the first seven league games, after being simultaneously among the team's two leading scorers just once in 11 non-league contests. Lehigh is 5-0 when Buhr and Mann are the team's top two scorers.

BLOWN OFF THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games, but has been outrebounded in four of their first seven league games, including by a 43-25 margin against Bucknell. During non-league play, Lehigh held a +3.9 rebounding margin, but currently ranks sixth in league play at -2.1. Overall this season, the Mountain Hawks are fourth in rebounding margin at +1.6.

Army enters second overall (+3.7) in rebounding margin, but eight in league play (-3.0).

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Wednesday at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 7.3 rebounds and ranks second with 13.1 ppg. In league play, she ranks fifth in rebounds (8.3) and assists (3.6), and leads the league with 36.4 minutes per league game. She is shooting 45.5 percent from downtown, which ranks 10th during league play.

A HED ABOVE THE REST

Sophomore Hannah Hedstrom has emerged as one of Lehigh's top rebounding threats, in addition to being among the league leaders in assists. During league games, she ranks second on the team with 6.4 rebounds per game, and is collecting 5.7 per contest overall.

Hedstrom also ranks fifth overall with 3.3 assists per game, but sits 10th during league play with 2.4 apg.

She has collected at least three steals in four games this season and leads the team with 1.4 steals per game this year.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann ranks second in the Patriot League with 16.9 points per game, is second with 2.9 three-pointers per game, and is a perfect 22-for-22 from the free throw line, the only player perfect from the charity stripe (min. 18 attempts). She in second in the league with a 51.3 3FG% and ranks eighth in minutes played (31.6). She also holds a field goal percentage of .432.

Her recent dominating stretch at the free throw line has moved her into second place overall in the PL at 83.1 percent.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in four games this season and has had two games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

CLIMBING THE LADDER

Quinci Mann has climbed four spots over the last two games to move from 11th to seventh place on the school's all-time scoring list. She enters Saturday's game with 1,363 points.

In the Jan. 2 win over Navy, she moved into third place on Lehigh's career three-point list, passing Erica Prosser '11.

Earlier this year, she sank a career-high six three-pointers on Nov. 29 against Mount St. Mary's and scored a career-high 27 points against Bucknell on Jan. 11.

FINISHING STRONG

The Mountain Hawks have been at their best in the fourth quarter this season, where they have outscored their opponents by an average of 16.3-13.9. Lehigh has only been outscored three times in the fourth quarter this season, but two of those instances have come in their last two games at American and Colgate.

LU has not been outscored in the fourth quarter at home this season.

HAMILTON, N.Y. – The Lehigh women' basketball team weathered a late 12-2 run by Colgate, scoring the last four points of the game to hold on for a 59-51 road win on Wednesday night. Senior Quinci Mann led the team with 15 points and added four rebounds, and sophomore Camryn Buhr collected her fifth double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Sophomore Camryn Benz tallied eight points and eight rebounds including a pair of three-pointers, Gena Grundhoffer scored nine points Bernadette Devaney added seven points on 2-of-3 shooting.

The Lehigh defense gathered nine steals off 14 Colgate (4-14, 0-7 PL) turnovers and Lehigh (11-7, 5-2 PL) won the battle on the boards 43-37. Colgate shot 34.5 percent from the field and 23.5 percent from three-point range, while LU went 33.9 percent (20-for-29) overall and 5-for-15 from long range. "We knew it was going to be a dogfight coming in here," said head coach Sue Troyan. "They're a team that defends you pretty tough in their matchup zone. I'm proud of how we competed and glad we came out of here with a win. We won the game on the defensive end, and that's what we challenged them to do. It was a game that was won by the team, not individuals."

Buhr found Grundhoffer underneath to give Lehigh an 8-6 lead prior to the first media timeout six minutes in. Grundhoffer added three more points to build an 11-6 lead and the Lehigh defense held Colgate off the board for nearly four minutes until a three-pointer in the final minute. Devaney responded with a layup to make it 13-9 after one.

Lehigh scored the first seven points of the second quarter to extend their run to 9-0 and take a 20-9 lead, forcing a 'Gate timeout at the 6:52 mark. Following the timeout, Colgate snapped the run and rattled off eight in a row, including back-to-back threes to make it 20-17. Lehigh went 3:38 without a basket until Devaney drilled one from the corner to make to 23-17. After Colgate got within three, Hedstrom grabbed a defensive rebound and took it coast-to-coast for a layup to make it 26-21, and after a Colgate layup, Mary Clougherty hammered home a three with six seconds left to give Lehigh a 29-23 lead at the half.

Lehigh forced nine turnovers and collected six steals in the opening 20 minutes while holding Colgate to 31 percent from the floor.

Colgate opened the third on a 9-4 run to get within one at 33-32 at the 6:48 mark. Lehigh responded with three straight triples to go back up double digits, starting when Mariah Sexe found Mann for three, then then Benz hit one from straight-away and added another to make it 42-32 going in to the media timeout at 4:37. Mann added a pair from the line to make it 44-32. Lehigh would miss seven straight field goals until Buhr found Devaney up ahead of the pack for a breakaway layup with 1:12 remaining, and Hannah Hedstrom used two free throws to make it a 13-point, 49-35 game entering the fourth quarter.

"Cam Benz did a nice job stepping in," Troyan said. "She was in there for the stretch where we opened it up against them and hit a couple of big threes."

Buhr hit a layup to give LU a game-high 14-point lead at 53-39 just over two minutes into the fourth quarter. The Raiders fought back from there, using a 12-2 run to get within 55-51 with 1:23 remaining. All told, the Lehigh scoring drought lasted 5:59 before Benz grabbed a huge offensive rebound, paving the way for Buhr to hit a clutch jumper in the lane to make it a 57-51 ballgame with 29 seconds left. Following a defensive stop, Benz corralled a rebound and sank two free throws with 15 seconds left to help lock down the win.

"That was a big shot in a four-point game," Troyan said of Buhr's late hoop. "She's a great competitor and makes big buckets when we need them. I'm proud of the way she competed tonight."




