SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will wrap up a lengthy road stretch of playing six of seven games on the road this Wednesday night when they travel to Bucknell. The Bison have won four games in a row and Lehigh is coming off a key road win on Saturday at Boston U., which snapped its first two-game losing streak of the season.

The two teams enter Wednesday separated by just one game, with Bucknell sitting in second place in the Patriot League standings, holding the tiebreaker with third place Navy, followed by Lehigh in fourth. The Mountain Hawks won the first matchup this season 66-62 back on January 11 at Stabler Arena. The teams have had similar parallels this season, both falling by double digits at American and by three-points to Loyola. Each team enters Wednesday averaging 63.4 points per game.

Lehigh is 3-2 over the last five games, has been held under 60 points in three of those five games, and has held their opponents to 56 points or less in four of those games. Bucknell has allowed opponents to score 60 points only once in its last six games and is 8-0 in league play when holding the opposition to less than 60 points.

Lehigh will return home this Saturday afternoon to host first place American on Play4Kay and National Girls and Women in Sports Day.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 359-317 into Wednesday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. BUCKNELL

Meeting for the 83rd time in program history, Lehigh holds a 43-39 record in the all-time series against the Bison.

Bucknell has won five of the last six matchups between the two schools, including nine of the last 13 dating back to the 2011-12 season. Prior to that, Lehigh bested the Bison in 10 straight games from 2008-2012. Three of Lehigh's last four wins over the Bison have come at Stabler Arena. Lehigh last defeated Bucknell at Sojka Pavilion on Feb. 20, 2013 by a score of 49-37. Over the last three seasons, all games have been decided by an average of 12.8 points.

Last season, Bucknell won a pair of 19-point decisions over Lehigh, with departed senior and PL Player of the Year Claire DeBoer leading the Bison in scoring in both games. Quinci Mann led Lehigh in scoring in both games, collecting her 1,000th career point at Bucknell on Feb. 8.

In the first matchup this year, Mann scored 25 of her then-career-high 27 points in the second half and Cameryn Benz chipped in 13 points as Lehigh went 7-for-12 from three-point range and 13-of-15 from the free throw line.

SCOUTING THE BISON

Sitting in second place in the Patriot League at 14-8 (8-3 PL), Bucknell is riding a four-game winning streak, tying its longest streak of the season. The preseason co-favorite to repeat as league champions, the Bison have defeated Holy Cross and Lafayette on the road, plus Boston U. and Navy at home, all by double digits. Bucknell is also 8-3 on their home floor, with their only home league blemish coming in their last loss, 69-65 to Loyola on Jan. 17.

Bucknell is only allowing 50.0 points per game during its current winning streak and ranks 39th in the nation from the free throw line (75.3 percent).

As a team, Bucknell leads the Patriot League with a rebounding margin of +8.5, more than twice as much as the next closest team. Their rebounding margin is also a PL best +11.0 in league play, with the next closest team (Loyola) at +3.0. Through 11 league games, the Bison sit second in the league by scoring 66.6 points per league contest and are second by allowing an average of 55.2 points. They are holding opponents to 37.6 percent from the field and 31.3 percent from three-point range in league games.

The Bison are led by senior Kate Walker, who has moved into the team lead with 12.9 points per game this season and ranks third during league play with 16.1 ppg. Junior forward and preseason all-league selection Kaitlyn Slagus scores 11.2 points and 8.2 rebounds per game, which ranks sixth in the league. Junior Kyi English scores 10.4 ppg and Catherine Romaine shoots a team-best 50.5 percent from the field.

BUCKNELL HEAD COACH AARON ROUSSELL

Now in his sixth season with the Bison, Aaron Roussell has improved the team's record in each of his first five seasons in Lewisburg. Coming off a program record 27 wins last season and 25 in 2015-16, Roussell piloted the team to 15, 16 and 18 wins, respectively, in his first three years on the job. Last season, he led the Bison to a Patriot League Tournament title and a First Round NCAA Tournament appearance.

Roussell is the two-time reigning Patriot League Coach of the Year and enters Friday with a career record of 271-112 and a 110-62 record at Bucknell. Two years ago in 2015-16, Bucknell finished 17-1 in league play, earning a share of the regular season title with Army West Point. The team went on to capture the program's first ever win in a WNIT game with a 74-70 win over Akron in the first round.

Prior to arriving in Lewisburg, Roussell spent eight years as the head coach at the University of Chicago, where he compiled a 161-50 record, making it to the Div. III NCAA Tournament four times and the Elite Eight once.

A 2001 graduate of the University of Iowa, Roussell double-majored in journalism/mass communications and political science. In 2002, he began a two-year stint as a graduate assistant women's basketball coach at Minnesota State, completing a master's degree in sports administration.

ROAD PROGRESS

Over the last four road games, Lehigh's defense has held opponents to an average of 56.8 points and holds a +2.8 scoring margin, both well better than its season averages. LU has gone 2-2 in those games, with both losses coming by three points at Loyola and Navy.

Over the last four road games, Lehigh has averaged 8.5 steals per game, exactly two over its season average and holds a turnover margin of +1.5.

Lehigh has also trimmed nearly three points off its road scoring margin over the last four away games.

HOME COOKING

Lehigh is off to a 9-1 start at home this season, their best home start since going undefeated at Stabler Arena in 2009-10. Lehigh is shooting 44.6 percent from the field in its five league home games and 45.2 percent from three-point range. Lehigh has also made an average of 8.4 three-pointers per game at home in league play.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in five of their last six games, with the lone exception coming in a 67-64 last second loss at Loyola. The stretch includes holding Navy and their league-leading offense (68.6 ppg) to just 53 points in Annapolis.

EARNING THEIR STRIPES

Lehigh earned a big road win at Boston U. on Saturday thanks in large part to their free throw shooting. Despite going 1-for-9 from the field in the fourth quarter, Lehigh converted 13-of-14 free throws in the fourth quarter and 20-of-23 in the game to help pull away from the Terriers.

This was a stark contrast to the previous two games, where Lehigh has struggled at the line, going a combined 15-for-31, and losing both games by three points. At Loyola on Jan. 24, Lehigh went 9-for-18, including 7-for-16 in the second half. They followed that up at Navy on Jan. 27 with a 6-for-13 performance. The two games have served as the team's second and third lowest FT percentages this season (lowest- 5-for-13/38.5 percent at Sacred Heart).

FIRE BERNING

Bernadette Devaney had a career-high five rebounds in a career-best 29 minutes Saturday at Boston U. She scored 15 points, her second-highest total of the season, and went 7-for-8 from the free throw line in the fourth quarter to help Lehigh lock down the win.

Over the last five games, Devaney is averaging 7.4 points per game, nearly two points above her season average.

Q IN THE CLUTCH

Senior Quinci Mann had a career night shooting the ball on Jan. 24 at Loyola, scoring a career-high 32 points on 12-of-19 overall and 5-of-8 from three-point range. Mann's previous career-high was 27 points against Bucknell on Jan. 11. She became the first Lehigh player to score 30+ points in one game since Jenny Callan (31) on February 15, 2006 vs. Colgate.

It was the third time this season Mann has had at least five-three-pointers in a game.

LOOKING FOR A REBOUND ON THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9, but has been outrebounded in seven of its first 11 league games, and drew even with Boston U. on Feb 3. Lehigh's current rebounding margin in league play is -2.4, which ranks seventh. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are fourth in rebounding margin at +0.8.

In their first matchup this season, Bucknell outrebounded the Mountain Hawks 43-25.

40 PERCENT BETTER

The January 24 loss at Loyola was Lehigh's first defeat this season when shooting over 40 percent from the field (11-1). Lehigh is 1-8 when shooting under 40 percent.

ONE-TWO PUNCH

Camryn Buhr and Quinci Mann have finished as the team's top two scorers in five of the first 10 league games, after being simultaneously among the team's two leading scorers just once in 11 non-league contests. Lehigh is 5-1 when Buhr and Mann are the team's top two scorers.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Jan. 17 at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 7.0 rebounds and ranks second with 13.1 ppg. In league play, she ranks, sixth in assists (3.0), ninth in rebounds (7.3), and is third with 35.5 minutes per league game.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann has moved up to second in the Patriot League in scoring with 16.5 ppg, and is second with a 47.5 3FG% and ranks fourth with 2.6 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

FINISHING IN THE FOURTH

Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in its last two games. Previously, Lehigh had been outscored in the fourth quarter in four straight games. Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 18 of 23 games this season, including 16 of the first 17 games to start the season.

BOSTON, Mass. – The Lehigh women's basketball team used a 14-4 run over the final 4:11 to down Boston University 65-56 for a key road win on Saturday afternoon. Seniors Quinci Mann (18 points on 7-of-15 shooting) and Bernadette Devaney (15 points) led the way for Lehigh while Camryn Buhr scored 13. Devaney added a career-high five rebounds and was 7-of-8 from the free throw line. Hannah Hedstrom had five rebounds, five assists and four steals. Camryn Benz had six points and four rebounds, and Mariah Sexe scored four quick points on 2-of-3 shooting. As a team, Boston U. (8-13, 3-8 PL) outshot Lehigh (13-9, 7-4 PL) 43.4 percent to 38 percent and held a 34-20 edge in the paint. Each team hauled in 34 rebounds and committed 15 turnovers.

"It was an important game for us, coming off two tough road losses, this was a big one to gain some momentum," said head coach Sue Troyan. "I thought all of our seniors played well. Quinci had a big game, Bernie really stepped up and I thought Mae Williams did a nice job on the defensive end."

A three by Buhr and a layup by Williams gave LU a 5-2 lead in the opening two minutes. BU ran off the next six points before Devaney drained a three from the right to tie it 8-8 at the first media timeout at the 4:26 mark. Both teams traded baskets until Benz put Lehigh up 13-12 with a three with 2:30 to go. Hedstrom added two free throws that helped LU hold a 15-14 after one.

Gena Grundhoffer gave LU a 19-18 lead with two free throws and Mann stepped up to drain a three-pointer to make it 22-18. BU followed with four straight and retied the game twice before Lehigh built a 29-24 lead with 3:14 to go in the half. The Terriers scored a free throw and layup to get back within two before Lehigh scored six straight points over the final 1:30. Sexe came in off the bench and registered quick back-to-back layups to make it 33-27, and off a BU missed layup with four seconds left, Buhr found Benz up ahead of the pack for a breakaway layup to beat the halftime buzzer and give the Brown and White a 35-27 lead going into the locker room. Lehigh outscored the terriers 20-13 in the second quarter and shot 8-for-14 in the period.

Both teams came out firing in the second half, answering each other's hoops as BU outscored Lehigh 12-11 over the first 5:39, cutting the Lehigh lead to 46-39. A BU layup and three-pointer cut it to 47-44 before Mann dribbled into the lane and sank a foul line jumper with six seconds left to make it 49-44 after three quarters. BU shot 8-for-15 in the third and outscored LU 17-14.

Boston got within two in the opening minute of the fourth and crept back to 51-49 at the 7:11 mark. A layup by Nia Irving with 5:11 remaining gave BU its only lead of the second half at 52-51. From there, Devaney hit two free throws and Mann followed with a three-pointer to spark an 11-0 Lehigh run. The Mann basket was Lehigh's only field goal of the quarter (1-for-9). However, the Lehigh defense held BU to just 4-of-14 and forced six turnovers in the period. Following Mann's triple, Devaney added four free throws and Buhr hit a pair to give LU the 62-52 edge with 39 seconds left. Gena Grundhoffer answered to BU free throw with two of her own and Devaney added one with five seconds left to cap the scoring.
