SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will welcome Colgate to Stabler Arena for a Patriot League matchup on Wednesday night. The Mountain Hawks will look to bounce back from a 0-2 week last week and do so on their home court, where they are 9-2 this season.

The Mountain Hawks enter scoring 64.7 points per game at home this season and are shooting nearly 43 percent from the floor. The team ranks second overall in the league this season by connecting on 33.7 percent of their three-point attempts, including a 36.2 percent clip in league play. This is despite LU's last game on Saturday where the team had a rare shaky offensive performance at Stabler with home season-lows of 44 points and 28.6 percent shooting.

At 4-20 (0-13 PL), Colgate is in search of its first win since early December. The Raiders are coming off a 21-point loss at home Saturday to Bucknell, and dropped an overtime decision at BU last Wednesday after surrendering a four-point lead in the closing seconds of regulation.

Lehigh took the first matchup between the two 59-51 back on Jan. 17, weathering a late 12-2 run and scoring the last four points of the game to preserve the win. Quinci Mann had 15 points and Camryn Buhr picked up her most recent double-double with 12 points and 10 rebounds. Cameryn Benz tallied eight points and eight rebounds. Summer King led all scorers with 16 points on 7-of-9 shooting for Colgate.

Lehigh will hit the road this Saturday for an afternoon matchup at Army West Point at 1 p.m.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 359-319 into Wednesday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. COLGATE

Wednesday's matchup will be the 66th all-time between Lehigh and Colgate. Over the last 11 matchups dating back to the start of the 2012-13 season, the Mountain Hawks hold an 8-4 record, including a 3-3 record on the road and 5-1 mark at Stabler Arena. Lehigh leads the all-time series 39-26. Lehigh's senior class is 4-3 over their seven career games against Colgate.

The two teams have split the regular season series each of the last four years, and Colgate has not won the season series (including PLT matchups) since taking two of three in the 2004-05 season.

Last year in the regular season finale at Stabler Arena on March 1, Lehigh shot a season-high 53.6 percent and used 19 points from Mann and 17 from Gena Grundhoffer to pull away in the second half for an 83-74 win.

SCOUTING THE RAIDERS

Colgate has struggled this season and enters Wednesday in 10th place in the Patriot League standings at 4-20, 0-13 PL. The Raiders have dropped 16 straight since an 84-64 home win against UMass Lowell on Dec. 2.

Thus far in league play, Colgate has allowed an average of 67.4 points per game and a -15.2 scoring margin, along with 9.2 assists and 4.9 steals per game, all last in the league. Colgate ranks similar to Lehigh in the rebounding department with both teams tied for eighth in league play in rebounding margin (-3.2), and both ranking at the bottom of the league in offensive rebounds with Colgate at 34.4 and Lehigh with 33.8. The Raiders sit fifth by holding opponents to 30.7 percent from three-point range. The Raiders rank sixth in the league in blocked shots with 3.4 per game, compared to the Mountain Hawks who come in last at 2.2.

The Raiders came close to picking up their first league win at Boston last Wednesday. Colgate rallied from down nine early in the fourth and held a four-point lead with 14 seconds left, but BU tied it up with a three-pointer, a steal and a free throw in the final nine seconds to force overtime and win 66-64.

Junior forward Summer King has had a solid season thus far, ranking second overall in the league with a .475 field goal percentage. She sits fourth in the league overall with 1.4 blocks per game and has at least one rejection in nine of her last 10 games. She is also the team's leading scorer (9.7 ppg) and rebounder (7.1 rpg). King leads the Raiders with 9.3 points and 6.4 rebounds per game. Chesley Koren (5.6 ppg), Nia Ahart (5.5) and Tegan Graham (5.4) are all next among active players in scoring, with all three shooting between 35 and 40 percent overall.

Colgate will be without the services of sophomore Rachel Thomspson, who went down with a season ending injury against Holy Cross on Dec. 29. Last year as a freshman, she ranked third on the team with 10.2 points.

COLGATE HEAD COACH BILL CLEARLY

Following an eight-year tenure at Bloomsburg University, Bill Cleary in in the midst of his second season at Colgate. Previously in four years at Bloomsburg, the Huskies won an NCAA record 102 games and made four straight NCAA Division II Tournament appearances from 2012-2015. The team won a Pennsylvania State Athletic Conference championship and five straight PSAC East Division titles.

Cleary was named the PSAC East Coach of the Year three times and was named the 2015 WBCA Atlantic Region Coach of the Year. He also coached four of his players to reach 1,000 career points. Prior to Bloomsburg, Cleary spent five years at fellow DII foe Wilmington. After winning just two games for the sixth straight year in his first season on the job, Cleary turned Wilmington around to a 22-9 program by his fifth year and led the team to a Div. II ECAC title.

Cleary graduated with a degree in political science from Villanova in 1998.

HOME COOKING

Lehigh is off to a 9-2 start at home this season, their best home record since going undefeated at Stabler Arena in 2009-10. Lehigh is shooting 42.9 percent from the field in its six league home games and 36.3 percent from three-point range. Lehigh has also made an average of 6.7 three-pointers per game at home in league play.

ROAD PROGRESS

Over the last five road games, Lehigh's defense has held opponents to an average of 57.2 points and holds a +0.8 scoring margin, both well better than its season road averages. LU has gone 2-3 in those games, with two of those losses coming by three points at Loyola and Navy.

Over the last five road games, Lehigh has averaged 7.8 steals per game, 1.4 over its season average and holds a turnover margin of +1.4.

Lehigh has also trimmed nearly three points off its road scoring margin over the last five away games.

PROTECTING THE BALL

Lehigh turned the ball over just 12 times against Bucknell, their third lowest total of the season (11 vs. Bucknell and Monmouth). Lehigh has averaged 13.6 turnovers in their last three games, which is below their season average of 15.9 per game.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in five of its last eight games, with their 67-64 loss at Loyola and their two losses to unbeaten American being the only games where they have allowed 60 points during that stretch. The stretch includes holding Navy and their league-leading offense (68.3 ppg) to just 53 points in Annapolis.

POWER OUTAGE

Lehigh had its worst offensive output of the season at home in Saturday's loss to American, with their 44 points, 28.6 field goal pct., and 16 made field goals all home season lows. Overall, each of those stats was the second lowest output of the season, ahead of only the Nov. 17 game vs. Villanova at PPL Center.

JUMPING THE 'GATE

Quinci Mann has had success against Colgate in her career, averaging 18.2 points per game over her last five games against the Raiders, and 14.4 ppg over seven career games against them.

DOWNTOWN CLOSED OFF

Through their first four Patriot League home games, Lehigh was 40-for-80 from three-point range. Over their last two, the team has gone a combined 6-for-34 (17.6 percent). Lehigh is shooting 33.7 percent from 3pt range this season (2nd in the PL) and is second in the Patriot League play (36.2).

two games. Lehigh scored seven points in the first quarter and six points in the fourth against American on Saturday. LU tied a season-low with five points in the first quarter last Wednesday at Bucknell.

LU also had a five-point quarter earlier this season vs. Bucknell.

MILESTONE TRACKER

Quinci Mann is 22 points away from passing Jessica DePalo '05 and moving into sixth place on the school's all-time scoring list.

FREE THROW STORY

Free throws were a common denominator in the outcomes of Lehigh's four games from Jan. 24-Feb. 7. Lehigh earned a big road win at Boston U. on Feb. 3 after converting 13-of-14 free throws in the fourth quarter and 20-of-23 in the game to help pull away from the Terriers for a nine-point win.

In their three losses over that stretch at Loyola, Navy and Bucknell, Lehigh was a combined 23-for-45 (51.1 percent), losing two of those games by just three points.

FIRE BERNING

Bernadette Devaney averaged 12 ppg over LU's two games at Bucknell and Boston U. On Feb. 3 at BU, she had a career-high five rebounds in a career-best 29 minutes. She scored 15 points, her second-highest total of the season, and went 7-for-8 from the free throw line in the fourth quarter to help Lehigh lock down the win.

LOOKING FOR A REBOUND ON THE BOARDS

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9, but has been outrebounded in nine of its first 13 league games, and drew even with Boston U. on Feb. 3. Lehigh's current rebounding margin in league play is -3.2, which is tied for eighth with Colgate. Overall, this season the Mountain Hawks are sixth in the PL at an even rebounding margin of +0.0.

BUHR'S BIG GAMES

Sophomore Camryn Buhr picked up her fifth double-double of the season and her fourth in league play, on Jan. 17 at Colgate. Overall, she leads the team with 7.0 rebounds and ranks second with 12.9 ppg. In league play, she ranks ninth in rebounds (7.4), is tied for third with 35.2 minutes, and tied for sixth with teammate Hannah Hedstrom in assists (3.1) per league game.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann is tied for third with 15.4 ppg, is third with a 44.6 3FG% and ranks fourth with 2.4 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in five games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STORY OF THE FOURTH

Lehigh has been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in six of its last eight games. Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 18 of 24 games this season, but 16 of those came in the first 17 games of the season.

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – The Lehigh women's basketball team fell for the first time at home in Patriot League play Saturday afternoon, as American closed the game on a 20-6 run to pull away for a 60-44 win. American remains unbeaten in league play at 13-0 and moves to 20-4 overall, while Lehigh drops to 13-11, 7-6 PL. Quinci Mann led the Mountain Hawks with 15 points on 5-of-10 shooting and Mae Williams tallied six points, two rebounds and two assists on 2-of-4 from the field. Camryn Buhr tallied eight points and seven rebounds and Gena Grundhoffer scored six.

American shot 43.4 percent from the field to Lehigh's 28.6 percent. Both teams shot under 20 percent from three-point range. American outrebounded LU 42-29, including 14-11 on the offensive end. Lehigh's 44 points and .286 field goal percentage were both season lows at home.

"They forced us into some bad shots," said head coach Sue Troyan. "I thought we settled for some three-point shots that weren't great looks. Credit their defense; I thought that was the difference in the game. I thought our defense gave up some easy baskets that gave them some momentum. Their defense makes it very tough on you by not making many mistakes or giving you open shots. And when we did have some open looks, we didn't knock them down."

American scored the first four points before Mann put Lehigh on the board with a three. Lehigh took a 7-6 lead after a jumper from Buhr and layup from Gundhoffer with 6:22 to go. After that, American closed the first quarter on a 10-0 run to hold a 16-7 lead. Lehigh closed the frame by missing their last 12 shots after a 3-for-3 start.

American extended the run to 12-0 following a second chance layup in the opening moments of the second. Buhr hit a runner in the lane at the 8:39 mark to break the streak and make it 18-9. Down 20-11, Lehigh went on an 8-2 run heading into the 4:59 media timeout, highlighted by a four-point play from Williams, who drained a three from in front of the American bench while being fouled, then hitting the ensuing free throw to make it 22-17. Williams made it six straight after taking a pass underneath for a layup to make it 24-19. Both teams traded layups before Mann sank two free throws and Mariah Sexe tacked on one from the line with 10 seconds left to cut it to 28-24 going into the half. Both teams went 5-for-16 from the floor in the second quarter.

Both teams exchanged runs to begin the third quarter, starting with seven straight for the Mountain Hawks. Mann and Grundhoffer added buckets in the first minute, and Hedstrom followed with a three to give Lehigh the 31-28 lead. The Eagles answered back with eight unanswered to take a 36-31 lead. Lehigh battled back within two as Grundhoffer and Cameryn Benz added jumpers, and Devaney followed with a three to cut it to 40-38 at the 2:16 mark. American closed the quarter with six straight to take a 46-38 lead into the fourth.

"I thought Mae (Williams) was a big spark for us on both ends of the floor and did a good job against Cecily Carl," Troyan said.

The Eagles kept it rolling through the final 10 minutes, outscoring Lehigh 14-6 in the frame and holding the home team to just six points on 2-of-11 shooting. Mann got Lehigh within six in the opening minute, and Buhr made it a six-point game once again with two free throws at 7:56, but the Eagles got the lead to double digits with 5:40 remaining and were able to put the game away. Overall, American outscored Lehigh 20-6 over the final 12:05.

"We knew they could rebound the ball, their guard are tough and go after a lot of things, but I don't think we did a good job of team rebounding," Troyan said.

Lehigh wore pink uniforms as part of its annual Play4Kay Day and National Girls and Women in Sports Day festivities, with \$1 being donated to women's cancer foundations, courtesy of Dunne Manning.

"It's a really special game for our program, and women's basketball in general has done a really good job with this initiative and raising money for breast cancer research," Troyan said. "We're very fortunate for Dunne Manning for what they provide in terms of sponsoring this game and the donation they have provided for a cause that's very personally near and dear to our team's heart."





