LEHIGH OPENS SEASON AT RUTGERS WEDNESDAY

The Lehigh men's basketball team is ready to hit the floor for the first time on Wednesday, as the Mountain Hawks travel to nearby Rutgers to face the Scarlet Knights. Opening tipoff is set for 7 p.m. on BTN+. Lehigh features a strong mix of returning players, coupled with talented freshmen, who look to get the Mountain Hawks back into Patriot League Championship contention. Leading the way is fifth-year senior Marques Wilson, who took advantage of the extra year of eligibility (due to the COVID-19 season) to return to Lehigh for another go-around.

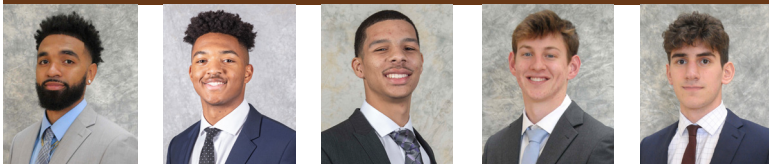
Wilson is the Mountain Hawks' top statistical returner. Last season, he was named third team All-Patriot League and second team All-District, leading Lehigh and finishing 10th in the Patriot League in scoring (15.3 points per game) and posting a team-leading 2.8 assists per contest (good for seventh in the league). Wilson was also voted preseason All-League heading into this season.

Also among Lehigh's returnees are seniors Jeameril Wilson and Nic Lynch, and juniors Evan Taylor, Reed Fenton, Jakob Alamudun and Jake Betlow, who have all made significant contributions over the course of their careers. The 2021-22 Mountain Hawks appear to be very deep, with a large number of players who have played big minutes, and started games, in their collegiate careers.

The Mountain Hawks will be playing their first "traditional" season opener since a home game vs. Monmouth on Nov. 5, 2019 - an 66-62 defeat. Last season, Lehigh opened on Jan. 2 vs. rival Lafayette and pulled out a thrilling 90-89 overtime victory. The Mountain Hawks will be facing Rutgers for the first time since 2008, which Lehigh won 76-71 (led by current head coach Brett Reed). Lehigh's last power conference opponent was Dec. 21, 2019 at No. 9 Auburn, a 74-51 defeat. The Mountain Hawks actually led that game, 20-13, more than midway through the first half before the Tigers responded. Lehigh wouldn't go away quietly as after trailing 13, the Mountain Hawks got back within seven at 48-41 with 7:56 left in the contest.

In his career, Reed owns wins over four power conferences (Big East, ACC, SEC and Pac-12), but is looking for his first over the Big Ten.

ALL-TIME VS. RUTGERS

Rutgers leads the all-time series with Lehigh, 68-36, but the Mountain Hawks did win the last meeting - on Nov. 26, 2008 by a 76-71 final. That came in Brett Reed's second season as Lehigh head coach. That snapped an 18-game Lehigh losing streak in the series, with its previous victory coming in 1967. The long-time rivals met often in the early 1900s, including the first-ever meeting on Feb. 9, 1907, an 88-23 Lehigh win.

SCOUTING THE SCARLET KNIGHTS

Last season, Rutgers finished 16-12 and 10-10 in the Big Ten to earn an at-large berth into the NCAA Tournament - its first tournament appearance since 1991. The 10th-seeded Scarlet Knights defeated seventh-seeded Clemson in the Round of 64, 60-56, before falling to No. 2 seed Houston in a close matchup, 63-60. Overall, Rutgers returns a lot of talent, but lost some significant contributors as well. Its top scorer returns in Ron Harper Jr., who averaged 14.9 points (to go with 5.9 rebounds). The team's No. 3 scorer from last season, Geo Baker, also returns after averaging 10.4 points per game. Among the biggest losses include second-leading scorer Jacob Young (who averaged 14.1 points) and top rebounder and rim protector Myles Johnson (who averaged a team-leading 8.5 rebounds and posted a team-high 68 blocks).

SCARLET KNIGHTS LAST TIME OUT...

INDIANAPOLIS - A historic season came to an end on Sunday night, as No. 10 seed Rutgers men's basketball fell to No. 2 seed Houston 63-60 at Lucas Oil Stadium in the Second Round of the NCAA Tournament. The Scarlet Knights broke new ground for the program this season, qualifying for the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 1991. On Friday night, the team defeated No. 7 seed Clemson for the first NCAA Tournament win for RU since 1983.

IF LEHIGH BEATS RUTGERS...

- Lehigh would win its second straight against Rutgers (coming 13 years apart). The last time Lehigh won two in a row against Rutgers was from 1961-62, when Lehigh won three in a row.
- The Mountain Hawks would win their season opener for the fourth time in the last five years.
- Lehigh would beat a power-conference opponent for the first time since winning at Mississippi State on Nov. 25, 2016 - an 87-73 Mountain Hawks' victory.
- Head coach Brett Reed would pick up his first-career victory over the Big Ten. He owns wins over DePaul and Rutgers of the Big East (the Scarlet Knights were in the Big East in 2008), Duke of the ACC, Arizona State of the Pac-12 and Mississippi State of the SEC.
- With win, head coach Brett Reed would tie former Bucknell head coach Pat Flannery for the second most overall victories, and league wins, in Patriot League history. Reed is currently at 233 and 125, respectively (see page 5 of notes for more).

SEASON OPENING NOTES

- Overall, Lehigh has won three of its last four season openers, including last year's atypical opener, a 90-89 overtime win over rival Lafayette on Jan. 2, 2021.
- In 2017, the Mountain Hawks defeated Marist in overtime, 84-76, to snap an eight-game losing streak in season openers. The previous seven came against power conference opponents: Penn State (2010), St. John's (2011), Baylor (2012), Minnesota (2013), Villanova (2014), Syracuse (2015) and Xavier (2016).
- Prior to that point, the previous season-opening victory came on Nov. 15, 2008, a 79-62 win at Saint Peter's.
- Lehigh went on to an impressive 85-61 season opening win at Monmouth on Nov. 6, 2018, giving it consecutive season-opening wins for the first time since 1998 and 1999.

LAST MEETING NOTABLES

- Lehigh shot just 40-percent from the field, including a 5-of-22 showing from three-point range, but the Mountain Hawks more than held their own on the backboards versus the Big East foe, as the Brown and White pulled down 44 boards, and only turned the ball over eight times.

- Leading the way on the glass for Lehigh was the six-foot Marquis Hall, who snagged a career-best 15 rebounds, his first-ever game of double-digit boards.

- Phil Anderson pulled down six, while Dave Buchberger grabbed five. Hall dished out a team-best five assists and was also credited with one steal.

- Rutgers was led on offense by Corey Chandler's 15 points, while backcourt mate Mike Rosario netted 14. Greg Echenique pulled down a team-best nine rebounds on a night in which Rutgers shot just 38-percent from the floor and turned the ball over 12 times.

- Lehigh led by eight in the early going, as Anderson scored in the paint with 9:03 to go in the first half. The lead reached double figures on a three-point play by Buchberger with 2:44 remaining, but Rutgers closed to within seven at halftime. Hall scored ten points in the first 20 minutes and was joined in double figures by Buchberger, who also hit for ten.

- The Mountain Hawks held onto their lead for the majority of the second half, but Rutgers closed to within three on a tip-in by Echenique at the 17-minute mark. The Scarlet Knights made it a two-point game when Chandler hit a jumper three minutes later, but from there Hall took over, scoring Lehigh's next 12 points, including a lay up with 8:37 on the clock to put the Brown and White ahead, 56-52.

LAST MEETING

PISCATAWAY, N.J. (11/26/08) - Junior Marquis Hall scored 28 points, including 18 in the second half, and ripped down a career-high 15 rebounds to lead Lehigh to a 76-71 victory over Rutgers on Wednesday evening at the Louis Brown Athletic Center. The win was Lehigh's first over a Big East school since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990 and moves the Brown and White to 4-1 for the first time since the 1980-81 season. Joining Hall in double figures for the Mountain Hawks were classmates Zahir Carrington with 15 points and Dave Buchberger with 12 points, as well as senior Phil Anderson, who netted ten points.

LEHIGH LAST TIME OUT

BOSTON (3/3/21) - No. 7 seed Boston University used a 16-3 run bridging the end of the first half and beginning of the second to create separation as the Lehigh men's basketball team saw its season end Wednesday night with a 69-58 loss in the first round of the Patriot League Tournament. Trailing 60-42 with less than four minutes remaining, the Mountain Hawks staged a 13-4 run to pull within 64-55 with 1:20 still on the clock, but Jonas Harper responded with a 3-pointer on the other end to erase any doubt.

COACH REED PUTTING UP THE W'S

Head coach Brett Reed reached 100-career Patriot League (regular season) wins three seasons ago, becoming just the fourth coach in league history to reach that plateau. Below is the list. Reed tied Jeff Jones of American coach for fastest to reach 100 PL wins in terms of number of seasons (11th season for both Reed and Jones). However, for both Flannery and Jones, it took fewer games to reach 100.

Here is where Reed stands among Patriot League laurels for total wins and Patriot League victories. Reed's 200th win came during a 78-72 home-opening win over Marist on Nov. 13, 2018. He tied Jones for third place with a home win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (Dec. 22) and overtook Jones with an 86-83 victory over Lafayette (Jan. 2) in Stabler Arena. With the thrilling overtime win at Lafayette on Jan. 30, 2019, Reed moved past Jones all alone into third place for Patriot League victories.

JENKINS JOINS COACHING STAFF

Head coach Brett Reed announced on Nov. 2 the addition of Willie Jenkins as assistant coach. Jenkins was a former standout at Tennessee Tech, earning Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year his senior season of 2004-05, while leading his team to the regular season title. He replaces Noel Hightower on the staff, who recently departed for a position with the Indiana Pacers. As a senior in college, Jenkins was named an honorable mention All-American, scoring 546 points for a 19.5 scoring average (along with 7.2 rebounds per game). He was inducted into Tennessee Tech's Hall of Fame in 2015. Jenkins has spent the previous three years as the head boy's varsity basketball coach at Evangelical Christian School (ECS) in Memphis, Tennessee.

WILSON PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE

Following a season which saw him earn second team All-Region, graduate student Marques Wilson was recognized as a preseason All-Patriot League honoree on Wednesday. Wilson was one of five players from around the league recognized. The Mountain Hawks' leading returning scorer, Wilson averaged 15.3 points per contest last season – good for tops on the Mountain Hawks and 10th in the Patriot League.

PAROLIN NAMED TO TEAM CANADA FOR FIBA U19 WORLD CUP

Dominic Parolin represented his country at the FIBA U19 World Cup last summer. The Coquitlam, British Columbia native was one of 14 athletes on Canada's roster for the World Cup that began in early July. Canada was seeded second. The sixteen (16) participating teams in the FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup 2021 was divided into four (4) groups (A, B, C, and D) of four (4) teams each. Each team played against all other teams in its own group (a total of three games for each team). Canada was in Group A along with Senegal, Lithuania, and Japan.

MCCOLLUM STARRING FOR TRAIL BLAZERS

- Former Lehigh standout C.J. McCollum is starring in his ninth NBA season with the Portland Trail Blazers.
 - McCollum is currently averaging 22.1 points per game this season, along with 4.1 assists and 4.3 rebounds (as of Nov. 8). The point average is 23rd in the NBA.
 - McCollum began the season with 34 points vs. Sacramento followed by 28 against reigning NBA finalist Phoenix. He scored 20+ points in eight of his first nine games of the season.
 - McCollum averaged 20+ points per game each of the previous six years (2015-21) as one of the NBA's most elite scorers.
 - On June 27, 2013, McCollum became the first player in school history to be selected in the NBA Draft. He declared for the 2012 draft, but officially withdrew from the NBA Draft on Monday, Apr. 9, 2012 to return to Lehigh for his senior season. McCollum went on to write a piece published on Sporting News' website titled "Why I'm returning to Lehigh for my senior year," citing earning his degree as one of the primary reasons.

STRONG IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Mountain Hawks take a lot of pride in their academic performance. In the fall, 2020 semester, the team put forth an impressive 3.57 GPA and followed that with a 3.14 GPA in the spring of 2021.
 - Last spring, the Mountain Hawks placed nine student-athletes onto the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll (for a semester GPA of 3.2+) - Dominic Parolin (3.82, Mathematics), Jayshen Saigal (3.67, Business), Andrei Arion (3.66, Bioengineering), Reed Fenton (3.64, Chemical Engineering), Ben Li (3.61, Arts and Sciences), Luke Traina (3.42, Business), Evan Taylor (3.34, Sociology), Nic Lynch (3.33, Political Science) and JT Tan (3.28, Arts and Sciences).
 - In July, the Mountain Hawks received the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). Teams with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during the 2019-20 academic year were recognized.
 - At the end of 2019-20, Jordan Cohen was named Academic All-Patriot League for a third straight season, becoming just the seventh three-time honoree in league history, joining Lehigh's Gabe Knutson '13 along with Mike Muscala '13 (Bucknell), Joey Ptasinski '15 (Lafayette), Franz Rassman '16 (Loyola), Jesse Reed '16 (American) and Nana Foulland '18 (Bucknell). Freshmen are not eligible for the award.
 - Cohen was also named Google Cloud Academic All-District both in 2019 and 2020, Lehigh's first Academic All-District honoree since Marquis Hall in 2009.

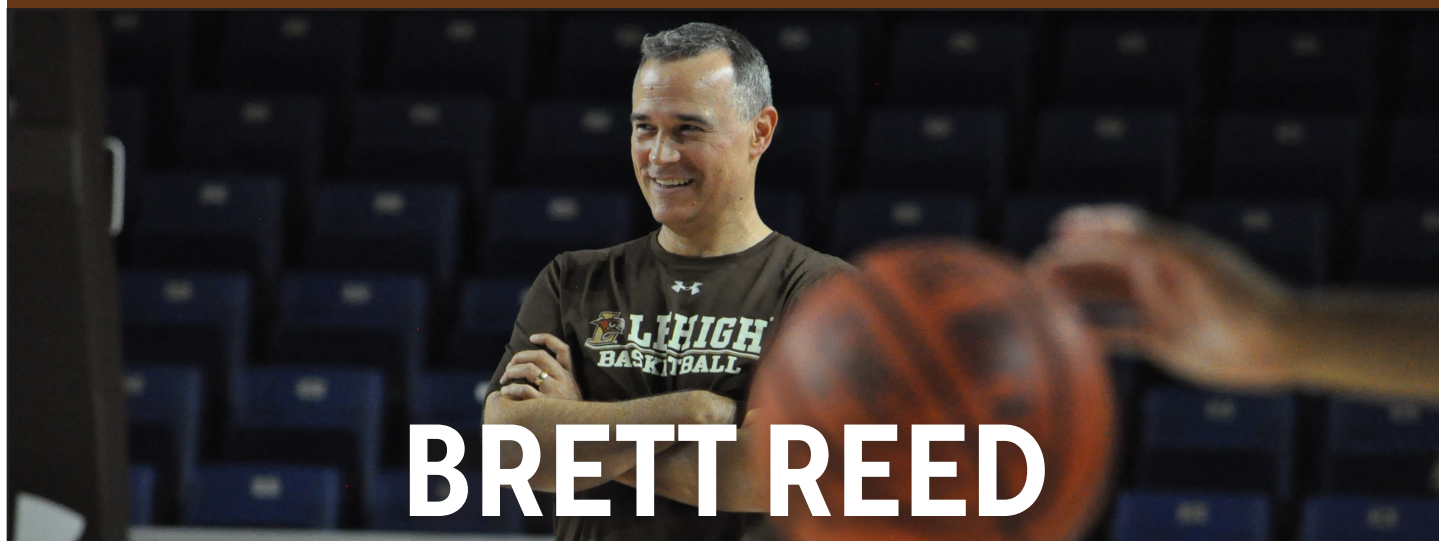

BRETT REED

Head Coach - 15th Season

The 2021-22 season is Dr. Brett Reed's 15th as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In 14 years on the sideline, Reed has become the winningest coach in Lehigh history and has won nearly 70 percent of his games at Stabler Arena.

During the 2012-13 season, Reed won his 100th career game and became the fastest coach to 100 wins in the history of the Patriot League. The same season, he also became the all-time winningest coach in school history. Early in the 2018-19 season, he reached 200 career victories. Reed is the Patriot League's second longest-tenured coach.

Reed owns a 55.3 career winning percentage, among the best in Patriot League history and second among active coaches. Reed's 233 overall wins, and 125 Patriot League victories, are both third in league history.

Reed has consistently won at Lehigh, eclipsing 20 wins three times in a four-year span from 2009-13, which also included three national postseason appearances. The Mountain Hawks twice won the Patriot League and advanced to the NCAA Tournament while advancing to the College Basketball Invitational in 2013. Lehigh reached back-to-back Patriot League Championship Games in 2016 and 2017, marking the third and fourth times in eight seasons the Mountain Hawks played in the title game. In 2018-19, Reed led Lehigh to 20 victories for the fifth time in 10 years, finishing in the top four of the league standings in nine of the last 10 seasons. Reed's teams have played their best basketball when it matters, posting a 22-2 record in February between 2016 and 2018 (9-0 in 2016, 6-2 in 2017 and 7-0 in 2018). The Mountain Hawks are 27-5 in February from 2016-19, 32-9 from 2016-20 and 65-40 in the month during Reed's head coaching career.

Lehigh has developed plenty of impressive talent in Reed's tenure, led by two-time All-American and Patriot League Player of the Year C.J. McCollum '13 who was selected 10th overall by the Portland Trail Blazers in the 2013 NBA Draft and has developed into an NBA star. McCollum has finished at or near the top 20 in the NBA in scoring each of the last three seasons (23.0 points per game in 2016-17, 21.4 in 2017-18, 21.0 in 2018-19 and 22.2 in 2019-20). Tim Kempton '17 was a two-time Patriot League Player of the Year, who was invited to play for the Milwaukee Bucks in the NBA Summer League following graduation, leading to a professional contract overseas. Reed has recruited at an extremely effective rate, as 19 alumni have signed pro contracts over his first 13 years as head coach.

Reed will be most remembered for the 2011-12 season, when the Mountain Hawks posted a school-record 27 wins, along with the program's third Patriot League Championship (and second in the three years). The highlight was a historic 75-70 NCAA Tournament win over Duke, becoming only the sixth No. 15 seed to ever beat a No. 2 seed and second in the same day (Norfolk State defeated Missouri just hours earlier). McCollum led the way with 30 points as Lehigh never trailed by more than five and was leading for much of the game. Mountain Hawks' largest lead came in the final minute (eight) as the squad always had an answer for the Blue Devils' runs.

That game helped put the Lehigh men's basketball program squarely on the map as over the ensuing days, the Mountain Hawks were featured in an endless number of national media outlets including SportsCenter, ESPN Radio, Fox Sports Radio, Sports Illustrated, USA Today and much more. The Mountain Hawks entered the following season ranked among the mid-major's best teams by numerous outlets. The 2011-12 season also featured a school record for nonleague wins (12), the Mountain Hawks shattered the program's previous wins record of 22 (also set by a Reed-led team). Along the way, Lehigh played tough against power conference foes, including NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed Michigan State when the Mountain Hawks held a 38-35 lead at the half.

The Mountain Hawks earned two more wins against power conference foes during the 2014-15 season as Lehigh took a big step forward in its quest to return to championship contention. The Mountain Hawks' season was highlighted by two wins over power conference opponents DePaul and Arizona State, and a tight loss to eventual No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament Villanova. The Mountain Hawks rebounded by winning seven-of-eight games midway through the Patriot League schedule. Late in the season, Lehigh dominated eventual regular season champion Bucknell to clinch a home game in the Patriot League Quarterfinals.

Several individuals took their play to new levels in 2014-15, highlighted by Kempton who was named the league's Player of the Year as just a sophomore. Along with Kempton, freshman Kameron Ross became the Mountain Hawks' fifth Patriot League Rookie of the Year in the previous nine seasons, along with Marquis Hall (2007), Rob Keefer (2008), McCollum (2010) and Kempton (2014). Ross set a single-game record with 14 assists in Lehigh's thrilling win at Arizona State.

Lehigh rebounded from a slow start in 2015-16 winning 11 straight games beginning in early February, tying the program's 90-year school record. The Mountain Hawks surged to the No. 2 seed in the league tournament and went on to host the quarterfinals, semifinals and championship game. It marked the sixth time in seven seasons that Lehigh has played at least one Patriot League Tournament game at home. The Mountain Hawks wrapped up an undefeated February, their first undefeated month since November of 1993. When all was said and done, Lehigh finished the season with a school-record 13 Patriot League victories.

Kempton and Ross were each named first team All-Patriot League, marking the first time in school history Lehigh has featured multiple first team honorees. Ross broke the school's single-season record for assists (194), previously held by Mackey McKnight. Kempton was also named Patriot League Player of the Year for the second straight season, becoming just the third player in league history to earn the honor twice before his senior season. The others were McCollum and Colgate's Adonal Foyle. As a team, Lehigh finished the season 15th nationally in three-point percentage (39.2).

The Mountain Hawks finished the 2016-17 season with a 20-12 record, tied for second in the league standings before defeating Colgate and Boston University in the Patriot League Tournament to reach their second straight title game. Among Lehigh's wins was an 87-73 win at Mississippi State, the program's first-ever victory over the SEC. The Mountain Hawks also defeated eventual Ivy League Champion Princeton as one of four wins over NCAA Tournament teams. Kempton led the league in points (20.4) and rebounds (10.4) and was named a Final Five Finalist for Kareem-Abdul Jabbar National Center of the Year. He also became Lehigh's first-ever participant in the 2017 Reese's® Division I College All-Star Game, going on to score a game-high 21 points.

In 2017-18, Lehigh graduated over 4,000 points and 1,600 rebounds from the previous year, but still found itself near the top of the league standings. The Mountain Hawks won eight straight games to end the regular season tied for third place in the league. Among the victories was a thrilling overtime win over Bucknell in early February, handing the eventual Patriot League Champion its last defeat until the NCAA Tournament. Lehigh finished the season 4-1 in overtime. Ross finished his career as the Lehigh and Patriot League all-time career leader for assists. He was named second team All-Patriot League, becoming the program's first-ever four-time All-League honoree. Ross also became the first student-athlete in program history to finish his career 4-0 at archrival Lafayette. In

one stretch, Lehigh exceeded 50 percent from three-point range in six straight games. The Mountain Hawks had double-digit makes in eight straight and 10-of-11, finishing the year 40.6 percent as a team, good for ninth nationally.

The hot shooting continued in 2018-19 as Lehigh knocked down 42.3 percent of its three-pointers, leading the nation and almost a full percent more than any other team in the country. It also marked a Patriot League record. The Mountain Hawks finished the year 20-11 and 12-6 in league play, their fifth straight season with 10+ Patriot League victories. Lehigh's 7-4 nonleague record was its best since 2011-12. Lance Tejada received All-League recognition for a second straight season, garnering first-team laurels for the first time. The Mountain Hawks did not lose two straight games all season, showing strong resiliency and an ability to bounce back. In the Patriot League Quarterfinals vs. Army, Lehigh came back from a double-figure second-half deficit to advance, marking the Mountain Hawks' third double-figure second-half comeback against the Black Knights of the season. In the Patriot League opener at Holy Cross, Lehigh erased an 18-point deficit to beat the Crusaders in overtime, the largest comeback in Reed's head coaching tenure. Tejada tied the program record for three-pointers with 10 in the victory, tying the mark set by Joe Knight and teammate Pat Andree. Less than a month later, Lehigh went on to erase a 19-point deficit at Army West Point.

The 2019-20 season saw the Mountain Hawks fight through some early struggles, but never quit and finished the season 6-3 over their final nine games. It included wins over three of the four eventual Patriot League semifinal teams, and a home Patriot League Tournament victory over Loyola. It was the 10th time in 11 seasons Lehigh hosted at least one PLT contest.

Another impressive season under Reed came in 2012-13 when the Mountain Hawks finished 21-10 and played in a national postseason tournament for a second straight season and third time in four years. Lehigh began the season 9-2, including an eight-game winning streak capped off by a 90-75 win at North Texas. McCollum went down with a season-ending injury at VCU on Jan. 5, but the Mountain Hawks wouldn't go away quietly. Lehigh posted a 10-4 record in league play to tie for second in the league standings. Reed picked up his 100th career win in style as the Mountain Hawks defeated Fairleigh Dickinson, 102-62. He went on to post his school record-breaking victory in a 72-43 win at Navy. Following the season, McCollum, the Patriot League's all-time leading scorer, became the first player in school history and second in league history selected in the NBA Draft.

Reed's first Patriot League Title as head coach came in 2009-10 when he led the Mountain Hawks to their second Patriot League Tournament Championship, first outright regular season league title, the most wins in school history (at the time) and the most-ever wins at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks also led the Patriot League in scoring offense, scoring margin, three-point percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio and defensive rebounds. Their 220 made three-pointers established a new school record, later broken just four seasons later when Lehigh knocked down 235 in 2013-14. The 2009-10 team also set a mark for the most dominant run in the Patriot League Tournament's history, winning every game by 15 points or more. They also excelled in the classroom. Lehigh's starting five of Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Hall, McCollum and Gabe Knutson achieved an average grade point average of 3.2.

During Reed's second season at the helm in 2008-09 season, the Mountain Hawks continued to build upon the solid foundation established at the beginning of his Lehigh career. The accomplishments included the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a Big East foe. Hall went onto become Lehigh's first-ever Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Carrington was the school's first All-District selection since 1988.

In his first season as a collegiate head coach, Reed led the Mountain Hawks to the third most wins for a first-year headman in the 108-season history of Lehigh Basketball. Reed mentored the Mountain Hawks' second consecutive Patriot League Rookie of the Year in Keefer as Lehigh became the first school in the league to accomplish that feat. In addition, Reed oversaw a defensive unit that held league foe Bucknell to just 39 points on February 27, 2008 - the second fewest points ever allowed by the Brown and White since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990.

Reed has recruited and developed some excellent basketball talent over the course of his career at Lehigh. In addition to McCollum and several Rookie of the Year performers, there have been a host of others who have enjoyed individual accomplishments and recognition. Lehigh has also featured high-level performers in the classroom and community as well. Hall was named the Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year in consecutive seasons while Knutson was a three-time Academic All-Patriot League performer. Andree and Jordan Cohen were named Academic All-League in 2017-18. Hall, McCollum and Kempton have been named finalists for the Senior CLASS Award while Knutson, Corey Schaefer, Austin Price and Tejada have been named candidates for the prestigious award.

Reed was named Lehigh's head coach on August 10, 2007. He had been an assistant at Lehigh for the previous five years, serving as associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

Prior to his time at Lehigh, Reed served as the top assistant coach at High

Point University in North Carolina for two seasons. Reed was an integral part of the coaching staff that led the Panthers to the Big South Championship Game in 2002. Included in that two-year period, Reed recruited a Big South Rookie of the Year and a Player of the Year.

Reed spent 1999-2000 as the Director of Basketball Operations at the University of North Carolina - Greensboro. He began his collegiate coaching career at Oakland (Mich.) Community College where he was an assistant for his father's program.

A native of Waterford, Michigan, Reed attended Eckerd College in St. Petersburg, Florida where he contributed at point guard and helped lead his team to a conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Reed graduated with honors, earning his Bachelor's degree in 1995 before earning his Master's at Wayne State in 1998. In 2003, Reed received his Ph.D. from Wayne State University in Instructional Technology with a Cognate in Sports Administration. He is one of only two Division I men's basketball head coaches in the entire nation to have earned their doctorate degrees. Reed was also honored during his academic career with a number of awards including the prestigious Thomas C. Rumbell Fellowship.

Reed and his wife Kindra reside in Bethlehem with their sons Brendan and Calvin, and daughter Makenna.

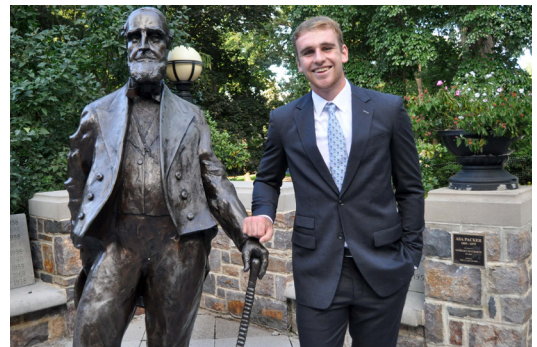
