LEHIGH HOSTS UALBANY IN PRE-HOLIDAY SHOWDOWN

The Lehigh men's basketball team will try again to hit the court after finals, when the Mountain Hawks host UAlbany on Tuesday night. Gametime is set for 7 p.m. on ESPN+. Lehigh was originally set to break a two-week hiatus of games at Syracuse Saturday, but COVID-19 protocols within Syracuse's program forced the postponement of the game. This Tuesday is Ugly Sweater Day; fans who wear a holiday sweater to the game receive a \$10 concessions voucher.

The last time they were on the court, the Mountain Hawks dropped an 81-75 final to Maryland Eastern Shore on Dec. 4. Despite the loss, Lehigh saw some of its strongest offensive play of the season to date. Juniors Reed Fenton and Jake Betlow led the way with career highs in points (20 and 15, respectively). They were each 5-of-8 from 3-point range, marking the first time Lehigh has had two with five or more made threes since Jan. 8, 2018 at Boston University (when Pat Andree was 5-of-9 and Lance Tejada finished 5-of-11). It actually marked the first time since Feb. 1, 2020 that one Mountain Hawk had 5+ made threes (when Fenton knocked down six vs. Army West Point).

Against Maryland Eastern Shore, five Mountain Hawks tallied double-figure points. Along with Fenton and Betlow, another junior Evan Taylor had 15. Sophomore Dominic Parolin recorded 11 and junior Jeameril Wilson added 10. It marked the first time Lehigh featured five in double figures since the Patriot League First Round game against Loyola on Mar. 3, 2020. First-year Ben Knostman helped facilitate the offense, tallying a career-high six assists (also the most by any Mountain Hawk this season and most since Marques Wilson dished six last Feb. 28 vs. Lafayette). For the game, Lehigh shot 51.9 percent from the floor, the first time over 50 percent since Jan. 24, 2021.

 $After Tuesday's \ game, the \ Mountain \ Hawks \ are \ scheduled \ to \ return \ home \ on \ Wednesday, \ Dec. \ 29 \ to \ host \ Eastern$ University at 7 p.m. That precedes Lehigh's Patriot League opener on New Year's Day at American.

ALL-TIME VS. UALBANY

Lehigh picked up a hard-fought 74-70 win at UAlbany in November of 2019 to take a 4-3 lead in the all-time series. That marked the first meeting between the sides since Dec. 8, 2008, which also marked the last time the teams played at Lehigh. That was also a Mountain Hawk victory, 65-64, snapping a string of three UAlbany wins in the previous four meetings. In that one-point victory, Zahir Carrington had an offensive rebound and putback with one second remaining. The teams first met on Jan. 8, 2000, a 75-74 Lehigh win. The home teams in the all-time were 3-0 before Lehigh's road victory in 2019.

SCOUTING THE GREAT DANES

UAlbany enters Tuesday with a 3-8 record, most recently falling to Niagara in Buffalo, 66-58. The Great Danes turned a 15-point first-half deficit into a second-half lead, but Niagara responded for the victory. The game prior, UAlbany picked up a 61-57 win at Boston College of the ACC. The Great Danes' other wins have come against Eastern Illinois and Columbia. UAlbany's roster is full of graduate students and transfers, including two former Patriot League players in Paul Newman (Bucknell) and Chuck Champion (Loyola). The Great Danes' leading scorer and rebounder is Temple transfer and graduate student De'Vondre Perry, who averages 12.6 points per game and 5.5 rebounds per contest. UAlbany has struggled a bit shooting the ball, hitting 39.4 percent of its field goals on the season and 29.0 percent from 3-point range. UAlbany is led by first-year head coach Dwayne Killings.

UALBANY LAST TIME OUT...

BUFFALO, N.Y. (12/18/21) - The University at Albany men's basketball team battled all the way back from a 15-point deficit in the first half, but eventually fell to the Purple Eagles in Western New York. UAlbany shot 45.8% (22-48) from the field and 22.7% (5-22) from three. Niagara shot 44.7% (21-47) from the field and 33.3% (7-21) from three.

IF LEHIGH BEATS UALBANY...

COACH REED PUTTING UP THE W'S

Head coach Brett Reed reached 100-career Patriot League (regular season) wins three seasons ago, becoming just the fourth coach in league history to reach that plateau. Below is the list. Reed tied Jeff Jones of American coach for fastest to reach 100 PL wins in terms of number of seasons (11th season for both Reed and Jones). However, for both Flannery and Jones, it took fewer games to reach 100.

Here is where Reed stands among Patriot League laurels for total wins and Patriot League victories. Reed's 200th win came during a 78-72 home-opening win over Marist on Nov. 13, 2018. He tied Jones for third place with a home win over Saint Francis (Pa.) (Dec. 22) and overtook Jones with an 86-83 victory over Lafayette (Jan. 2) in Stabler Arena. With the thrilling overtime win at Lafayette on Jan. 30, 2019, Reed moved past Jones all alone into third place for Patriot League victories.

- The Mountain Hawks extended their lead to 17 midway through the first half. The Great Danes staged a comeback and pulled as close as three in the final seconds, but James Karnik knocked down a big free throw with eight seconds remaining for a four-point lead, which proved to be the final as the Mountain Hawks' spoiled the season (and home) opener for the perennial America East contenders.
- Karnik filled the stat sheet with 16 points, five rebounds (to reach exactly 500 in his career), a steal and three blocks. It marked Karnik's second straight game with three blocks after never tallying more than two in a game over his first two seasons.
- Jordan Cohen led the offense with 17 points while Jeameril Wilson also reached double figures for the first time this year, scoring 10. Marques Wilson filled up the stat sheet with eight points, seven rebounds and four assists while Reed Fenton scored eight points as well, along with a rebound and two
- Fenton's point total was his high through two games. Same was true for classmates Jake Betlow (five points) and Jakob Alamudun (six). Alamudun scored four first-half points, marking the first points of his collegiate career.
- It marked Lehigh's first win against an America East team since Dec. 28, 2014, a 58-55 victory at UMBC. Lehigh has only played five current members of the America East (Albany, New Hampshire, Stony Brook, Vermont and UMBC).

The Mountain Hawks bounced back from Tuesday's season-opening defeat to Monmouth in a big way, defeating the perennial America East contenders on their opening night. Senior Jordan Cohen led the offense with 17 points on 6-of-8 shooting while junior James Karnik enjoyed another strong effort, tallying 15 points, five boards and three blocks.

JENKINS JOINS COACHING STAFF

Head coach Brett Reed announced on Nov. 2 the addition of Willie Jenkins as assistant coach. Jenkins was a former standout at Tennessee Tech, earning Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year his senior season of 2004-05, while leading his team to the regular season title. He replaces Noel Hightower on the staff, who recently departed for a position with the Indiana Pacers. As a senior in college, Jenkins was named an honorable mention All-American, scoring 546 points for a 19.5 scoring average (along with 7.2 rebounds per game). He was inducted into Tennessee Tech's Hall of Fame in 2015. Jenkins has spent the previous three years as the head boy's varsity basketball coach at Evangelical Christian School (ECS) in Memphis, Tennessee.

WILSON PRESEASON ALL-LEAGUE

Following a season which saw him earn second team All-Region, fifth-year senior Marques Wilson was recognized as a preseason All-Patriot League honoree on Wednesday. Wilson was one of five players from around the league recognized. The Mountain Hawks' leading returning scorer, Wilson averaged 15.3 points per contest last season - good for tops on the Mountain Hawks and 10th in the Patriot League.

PAROLIN NAMED TO TEAM CANADA FOR FIBA U19 WORLD CUP

Dominic Parolin represented his country at the FIBA U19 World Cup last summer. The Coquitlam, British Columbia native was one of 14 athletes on Canada's roster for the World Cup that began in early July. Canada was seeded second. The sixteen (16) participating teams in the FIBA U19 Basketball World Cup 2021 was divided into four (4) groups (A, B, C, and D) of four (4) teams each. Each team played against all other teams in its own group (a total of three games for each team). Canada was in Group A along with Senegal, Lithuania, and Japan.

HOME VICTORY OVER COLUMBIA (NOV. 24)

- Lehigh's 79-72 win on Nov. 24 snapped a four-game losing skid vs. the Lions and gave Lehigh its first win against Columbia since Jan. 2, 2009. The Mountain Hawks' 79 points marked their most against Columbia since Dec. 1, 1994 an 85-75 Lehigh victory (19 meetings prior).
- Lehigh shot 50.0 percent from the floor in the first half, and 55.6 percent from 3-point range, while only turning the ball over five times. That led to a 41-31 halftime advantage.
- Junior Evan Taylor led Lehigh's offense with a career-high 18 points, 13 coming in the first half.
- Sophomore Dominic Parolin filled up the box score with 12 points on 5-of-6 shooting, seven rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal.
- Senior Jeameril Wilson also had 12 points while junior Jakob Alamudun added 10.
- Senior Nic Lynch scored six points to eclipse 500 in his career, while also adding five rebounds.
- In the end, all 10 Mountain Hawks who saw action scored in a total team effort.
- First year Ben Knostman tallied five points, four assists and two steals in a season-high 33 minutes.
- Fifth-year senior Marques Wilson knocked down a big tie-breaking 3-pointer to give Lehigh a 64-61 lead, sparking a 10-0 Mountain Hawks' run. He also caused a big turnover defensively with just over four minutes remaining and Lehigh up by five.

MCCOLLUM STARRING FOR TRAIL BLAZERS

- Former Lehigh standout C.J. McCollum is starring in his ninth NBA season with the Portland Trail Blazers.
- McCollum is currently averaging 20.6 points per game this season, along with 4.5 assists and 4.1 rebounds (before games Dec. 19). The point average is 22nd in the NBA.
- On Dec. 7, it was announced that McCollum had a collapsed lung and would need to undergo further evaluation.
- McCollum began the season with 34 points vs. Sacramento followed by 28 against reigning NBA finalist Phoenix. He scored 20+ points in eight of his first nine games of the season.
- McCollum averaged 20+ points per game each of the previous six years (2015-21) as one of the NBA's most elite scorers.
- On June 27, 2013, McCollum became the first player in school history to be selected in the NBA Draft. He declared for the 2012 draft, but officially withdrew from the NBA Draft on Monday, Apr. 9, 2012 to return to Lehigh for his senior season. McCollum went on to write a piece published on Sporting News' website titled "Why I'm returning to Lehigh for my senior year," citing earning his degree as one of the primary reasons.

STRONG IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Mountain Hawks take a lot of pride in their academic performance. In the fall, 2020 semester, the team put forth an impressive 3.57 GPA and followed that with a 3.14 GPA in the spring of 2021.
- Last spring, the Mountain Hawks placed nine student-athletes onto the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll (for a semester GPA of 3.2+) Dominic Parolin (3.82, Mathematics), Jayshen Saigal (3.67, Business), Andrei Arion (3.66, Bioengineering), Reed Fenton (3.64, Chemical Engineering), Ben Li (3.61, Arts and Sciences), Luke Traina (3.42, Business), Evan Taylor (3.34, Sociology), Nic Lynch (3.33, Political Science) and JT Tan (3.28, Arts and Sciences).
- In July, the Mountain Hawks received the NABC Team Academic Excellence Award by the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). Teams with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher during the 2019-20 academic year were recognized.
- At the end of 2019-20, Jordan Cohen was named Academic All-Patriot League for a third straight season, becoming just the seventh three-time honoree in league history, joining Lehigh's Gabe Knutson '13 along with Mike Muscala '13 (Bucknell), Joey Ptasinski '15 (Lafayette), Franz Rassman '16 (Loyola), Jesse Reed '16 (American) and Nana Foulland '18 (Bucknell). Freshmen are not eligible for the award.
- Cohen was also named Google Cloud Academic All-District both in 2019 and 2020, Lehigh's first Academic All-District honoree since Marquis Hall in 2009.

UP NEXT...

Lehigh will return home next Wednesday to host Eastern University at 7 p.m. The Mountain Hawks then open Patriot League play on New Year's Day at American.

Head Coach - 15th Season

The 2021-22 season is Dr. Brett Reed's 15th as the Murray H. Goodman '48 Head Men's Basketball Coach at Lehigh University. In 14 years on the sideline,

Reed has become the winningest coach in Lehigh history and has won nearly 70 percent of his games at Stabler Arena.

During the 2012-13 season, Reed won his 100th career game and became the fastest coach to 100 wins in the history of the Patriot League. The same season, he also became the all-time winningest coach in school history. Early in the 2018-19 season, he reached 200 career victories. Reed is the Patriot League's second longest-tenured coach.

Reed owns a 55.3 career winning percentage, among the best in Patriot League history and second among active coaches. Reed's 233 overall wins, and 125 Patriot League victories, are both third in league history.

Reed has consistently won at Lehigh, eclipsing 20 wins three times in a four-year span from 2009-13, which also included three national postseason appearances. The Mountain Hawks twice won the Patriot League and advanced to the NCAA Tournament while advancing to the College Basketball Invitational in 2013. Lehigh reached back-to-back Patriot League Championship Games in 2016 and 2017, marking the third and fourth times in eight seasons the Mountain Hawks played in the title game. In 2018-19, Reed led Lehigh to 20 victories for the fifth time in 10 years, finishing in the top four of the league standings in nine of the last 10 seasons. Reed's teams have played their best basketball when it matters, posting a 22-2 record in February between 2016 and 2018 (9-0 in 2016, 6-2 in 2017 and 7-0 in 2018). The Mountain Hawks are 27-5 in February from 2016-19, 32-9 from 2016-20 and 65-40 in the month during Reed's head coaching career. Lehigh has developed plenty of impressive talent in Reed's tenure, led by two-time All-American and Patriot League Player of the Year C.J. McCollum '13 who was selected 10th overall by the Portland Trail Blazers in the 2013 NBA Draft and has developed into an NBA star. McCollum has finished at or near the top 20 in the NBA in scoring each of the last three seasons (23.0 points per game in 2016-17, 21.4 in 2017-18, 21.0 in 2018-19 and 22.2 in 2019-20). Tim Kempton '17 was

a two-time Patriot League Player of the Year, who was invited to play for the Milwaukee Bucks in the NBA Summer League following graduation, leading to a professional contract overseas. Reed has recruited at an extremely effective rate, as 19 alumni have signed pro contracts over his first 13 years as head coach. Reed will be most remembered for the 2011-12 season, when the Mountain Hawks posted a school-record 27 wins, along with the program's third Patriot League Championship (and second in the three years). The highlight was a historic 75-70 NCAA Tournament win over Duke, becoming only the sixth No. 15 seed to ever beat a No. 2 seed and second in the same day (Norfolk State defeated Missouri just hours earlier). McCollum led the way with 30 points as Lehigh never trailed by more than five and was leading for much of the game. Mountain Hawks' largest lead came in the final minute (eight) as the squad always had an answer for the Blue Devils' runs.

That game helped put the Lehigh men's basketball program squarely on the map as over the ensuing days, the Mountain Hawks were featured in an end-less number of national media outlets including SportsCenter, ESPN Radio, Fox Sports Radio, Sports Illustrated, USA Today and much more. The Mountain Hawks entered the following season ranked among the mid-major's best teams by numerous outlets. The 2011-12 season also featured a school record for nonleague wins (12), the Mountain Hawks shattered the program's previous wins record of 22 (also set by a Reed-led team). Along the way, Lehigh played tough against power conference foes, including NCAA Tournament No. 1 seed Michigan State when the Mountain Hawks held a 38-35 lead at the half.

The Mountain Hawks earned two more wins against power conference foes during the 2014-15 season as Lehigh took a big step forward in its quest to return to championship contention. The Mountain Hawks' season was highlighted by two wins over power conference opponents DePaul and Arizona State, and a tight loss to eventual No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament Villanova. The Mountain Hawks rebounded by winning seven-of-eight games midway through the Patriot League schedule. Late in the season, Lehigh dominated eventual regular season champion Bucknell to clinch a home game in the Patriot League

Several individuals took their play to new levels in 2014-15, highlighted by Kempton who was named the league's Player of the Year as just a sophomore. Along with Kempton, first-year Kahron Ross became the Mountain Hawks' fifth Patriot League Rookie of the Year in the previous nine seasons, along with Marquis Hall (2007), Rob Keefer (2008), McCollum (2010) and Kempton (2014). Ross set a single-game record with 14 assists in Lehigh's thrilling win at Arizona State.

Lehigh rebounded from a slow start in 2015-16 winning 11 straight games beginning in early February, tying the program's 90-year school record. The Moun-

tain Hawks surged to the No. 2 seed in the league tournament and went on to host the quarterfinals, semifinals and championship game. It marked the sixth time in seven seasons that Lehigh has played at least one Patriot League Tournament game at home. The Mountain Hawks wrapped up an undefeated February, their first undefeated month since November of 1993. When all was said and done, Lehigh finished the season with a school-record 13 Patriot League victories. Kempton and Ross were each named first team All-Patriot League, marking the first time in school history Lehigh has featured multiple first team honor-

ees. Ross broke the school's single-season record for assists (194), previously held by Mackey McKnight. Kempton was also named Patriot League Player of the Year for the second straight season, becoming just the third player in league history to earn the honor twice before his senior season. The others were McCollum

and Colgate's Adonal Foyle. As a team, Lehigh finished the season 15th nationally in three-point percentage (39.2).

The Mountain Hawks finished the 2016-17 season with a 20-12 record, tied for second in the league standings before defeating Colgate and Boston University in the Patriot League Tournament to reach their second straight title game. Among Lehigh's wins was an 87-73 win at Mississippi State, the program's Kempton led the league in points (20.4) and rebounds (10.4) and was named a Final Five Finalist for Kareem-Abdul Jabbar National Center of the Year. He also became Lehigh's first-ever participant in the 2017 Reese's® Division I College All-Star Game, going on to score a game-high 21 points.

In 2017-18, Lehigh graduated over 4,000 points and 1,600 rebounds from the previous year, but still found itself near the top of the league standings. The Mountain Hawks won eight straight games to end the regular season tied for third place in the league. Among the victories was a thrilling overtime win over

Bucknell in early February, handing the eventual Patriot League Champion its last defeat until the NCAA Tournament. Lehigh finished the season 4-1 in overtime. Ross finished his career as the Lehigh and Patriot League all-time career leader for assists. He was named second team All-Patriot League, becoming the program's first-ever four-time All-League honoree. Ross also became the first student-athlete in program history to finish his career 4-0 at archrival Lafayette. In

one stretch, Lehigh exceeded 50 percent from three-point range in six straight games. The Mountain Hawks had double-digit makes in eight straight and 10of-11, finishing the year 40.6 percent as a team, good for ninth nationally

The hot shooting continued in 2018-19 as Lehigh knocked down 42.3 percent of its three-pointers, leading the nation and almost a full percent more than any other team in the country. It also marked a Patriot League record. The Mountain Hawks finished the year 20-11 and 12-6 in league play, their fifth straight season with 10+ Patriot Léague victories. Lehigh's 7-4 nonleague record was its best since 2011-12. Lance Tejada received All-League recognition for a second straight season, garnering first-team laurels for the first time. The Mountain Hawks did not lose two straight games all season, showing strong resiliency and an ability to bounce back. In the Patriot League Quarterfinals vs. Army, Lehigh came back from a double-figure second-half deficit to advance, marking the Mountain Hawks' third double-figure second-half comeback against the Black Knights of the season. In the Patriot League opener at Holy Cross, Lehigh erased an 18-point deficit to beat the Crusaders in overtime, the largest comeback in Reed's head coaching tenure. Tejada tied the program record for three-pointers with 10 in the victory, tying the mark set by Joe Knight and teammate Pat Andree. Less than a month later, Lehigh went on to erase a 19-point deficit at Army West Point.

The 2019-20 season saw the Mountain Hawks fight through some early struggles, but never guit and finished the season 6-3 over their final nine games. It included wins over three of the four eventual Patriot League semifinal teams, and a home Patriot League Tournament victory over Loyola. It was the 10th time in 11 seasons Lehigh hosted at least one PLT contest.

Another impressive season under Reed came in 2012-13 when the Mountain Hawks finished 21-10 and played in a national postseason tournament for a second straight season and third time in four years. Lehigh began the season 9-2, including an eight-game winning streak capped off by a 90-75 win at North Texas. McCollum went down with a season-ending injury at VCU on Jan. 5, but the Mountain Hawks wouldn't go away quietly. Lehigh posted a 10-4 record in league play to tie for second in the league standings. Reed picked up his 100th career win in style as the Mountain Hawks defeated Fairleigh Dickinson, 102-62. He went on to post his school record-breaking victory in a 72-43 win at Navy. Following the season, McCollum, the Patriot League's all-time leading scorer, became the first player in school history and second in league history selected in the NBA Draft.

Reed's first Patriot League Title as head coach came in 2009-10 when he led the Mountain Hawks to their second Patriot League Tournament Championship, first outright regular season league title, the most wins in school history (at the time) and the most-ever wins at Stabler Arena. The Mountain Hawks also led the Patriot League in scoring offense, scoring margin, threepoint percentage, assist-to-turnover ratio and defensive rebounds. Their 220 made three-pointers established a new school record, later broken just four seasons later when Lehigh knocked down 235 in 2013-14. The 2009-10 team also set a mark for the most dominant run in the Patriot League Tournament's history, winning every game by 15 points or more. They also excelled in the classroom. Lehigh's starting five of Dave Buchberger, Zahir Carrington, Hall, McCollum and Gabe Knutson achieved an average grade point average of 3.2.

During Reed's second season at the helm in 2008-09 season, the Moun-

tain Hawks continued to build upon the solid foundation established at the beginning of his Lehigh career. The accomplishments included the most overall road wins since 1991 and the school's first-ever victory over a Big East foe. Hall went onto became Lehigh's first-ever Patriot League Men's Basketball Scholar-Athlete of the Year, while Carrington was the school's first All-District selection since 1988.

In his first season as a collegiate head coach, Reed led the Mountain Hawks to the third most wins for a first-year headman in the 108-season history of Lehigh Basketball. Reed mentored the Mountain Hawks' second consecutive Patriot League Rookie of the Year in Keefer as Lehigh became the first school in the league to accomplish that feat. In addition, Reed oversaw a defensive unit that held league foe Bucknell to just 39 points on February 27, 2008 - the second fewest points ever allowed by the Brown and White since the inception of Patriot League play in 1990.

Reed has recruited and developed some excellent basketball talent over

the course of his career at Lehigh. In addition to McCollum and several Rookie of the Year performers, there have been a host of others who have enjoyed individual accomplishments and recognition. Lehigh has also featured high-level performers in the classroom and community as well. Hall was named the Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year in consecutive seasons while Knut-son was a three-time Academic All-Patriot League performer. Andree and Jordan Cohen were named Academic All-League in 2017-18. Hall, McCollum and Kempton have been named finalists for the Senior CLASS Award while Knutson, Corey Schaefer, Austin Price and Tejada have been named candidates for the prestigious award.

Reed was named Lehigh's head coach on August 10, 2007. He had been an assistant at Lehigh for the previous five years, serving as associate head coach for the 2006-07 campaign.

Prior to his time at Lehigh, Reed served as the top assistant coach at High

Point University in North Carolina for two seasons. Reed was an integral part of the coaching staff that led the Panthers to the Big South Championship Game in 2002. Included in that two-year period, Reed recruited a Big South Rookie of the Year and a Player of the Year.

Reed spent 1999-2000 as the Director of Basketball Operations at the University of North Carolina - Greensboro. He began his collegiate coaching career at Oakland (Mich.) Community College where he was an assistant for his father's program.

A native of Waterford, Michigan, Reed attended Eckerd College in St. Petersburg, Florida where he contributed at point guard and helped lead his team to a conference championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Reed graduated with honors, earning his Bachelor's degree in 1995 before earning his Master's at Wayne State in 1998. In 2003, Reed received his Ph.D. from Wayne State University in Instructional Technology with a Cognate in Sports Administration. He is one of only two Division I men's basketball head coaches in the entire nation to have earned their doctorate degrees. Reed was also honored during his academic career with a number of awards including the prestigious Thomas C. Rumbell Fellowship

Reed and his wife Kindra reside in Bethlehem with their sons Brendan and Calvin, and daughter Makenna.


