SETTING THE SCENE

The Lehigh women's basketball team will take to the court on Monday night to host Army West Point at Stabler Arena in the quarterfinal round of the Patriot League Tournament. The fourth seeded Mountain Hawks and fifth seeded Black Knights each tallied 9-9 records in Patriot League play this season, and are coming off losses in their regular season finales at home last Wednesday.

Army West Point closed the regular season by winning four of their last five games to climb up into a fourth place tie with Lehigh at 9-9 in the Patriot League. Lehigh earned fourth place and the quarterfinal home game, having split with Bucknell, while the Black Knights dropped both of their matchups with the Bison. Lehigh and Army split their two games this season, with the home team winning each game.

Lehigh will be making its 27th appearance in the Patriot League quarterfinals and has advanced to the semifinals 13 times in their history. Lehigh is 10-3 over the last 14 years in the quarterfinals and is 4-4 all-time against Army in the postseason.

The winner of Monday's game will advance to play either No. 8 Lafayette or No. 1 American in the semifinals on Thursday.

LEHIGH HEAD COACH SUE TROYAN

Sue Troyan (Dickinson '88) is in her 23rd season at the helm of the Mountain Hawks, and carries a career record of 361-322 into Monday's game. Since arriving in Bethlehem, she has turned the Lehigh program into a perennial Patriot League contender. A two-time Patriot League Coach of the Year, Troyan guided Lehigh to 19 wins and a Patriot League championship game appearance in 2014-15. Over the previous eight full seasons, Troyan has led Lehigh to a 167-114 record. She has led LU to three Patriot League Championships and NCAA Tournament berths during her tenure. Prior to becoming the head basketball coach, Troyan served as an assistant basketball coach and head softball coach at Lehigh, leading the softball team to a 126-90 record in five seasons.

ALL-TIME VS. ARMY WEST POINT

Lehigh enters Monday's matchup trailing Army in the all-time series 34-31. The Black Knights have won 11 of the last 14 dating back to February 2013. The two programs met three times in 2014-15 and 2015-16, with Lehigh winning twice during the 2014-15 season, including a 76-57 win at Army in the Patriot League semifinals.

Army won the first 11 matchups in the all-time series between the two schools, with their first meeting coming in the 1983-84 season. Lehigh had a six game winning streak from 2004-2006.

Earlier this year, Lehigh ended their five game losing skid to Army with a 59-55 win at Stabler Arena. Gena Grundhoffer tallied a then-career-high 21 points and seven rebounds on 7-of-9 shooting and Camryn Buhr had 14 points and eight rebounds on 6-of-10 shooting.

Army took the second matchup this season 55-50 on Jan. 17 in West Point. Lehigh made an 8-0 run in the closing minutes before falling short, outshooting Army 43.8-41.5 percent.

SCOUTING THE BLACK KNIGHTS

Last time out, Army dropped a 75-55 decision at home to Bucknell. Janae McNeal led the way with 14 points on 6-of-15 shooting, Madison Hovren scored eight and senior Aliyah Murray returned to the lineup after missing seven games with eight points and a team-high eight rebounds. Army shot 33.9 percent for the game and 30 percent from downtown, while Bucknell held a 36-26 edge in rebounds. Bucknell was hot offensively, shooting 57.1 percent overall and from three-point range.

Hovren and McNeal represented the Cadets on the All-Patriot League teams, with Hovren earning Second Team honors and McNeal being named to the All-Defensive team. McNeal enters the postseason having scored double figures in 10 consecutive games. Hovren has registered 17 double-doubles and seven 20-point performances this season. She led Army in scoring and rebounding for the second straight year, ranking fifth in the PL with 14.6 ppg and third with 9.8 rebounds.

Murray and Hovren rank in the PL's top four in field goal percentage at 47.1 and 45.9 percent, respectively. As a team, Army ranked eighth during league by scoring 56.1 ppg, but ranked fourth in scoring defense (58.3), one spot ahead of Lehigh. Lehigh and Army were fairly even overall this season offensively, with Lehigh ranking fifth (61.6) and Army sixth (61.3). Army was also the second-best rebounding team in the league this season, holding a rebounding margin of +4.9 overall and +3.0 in league play.

ARMY HEAD COACH DAVE MAGARITY

Dave Magarity is in his 12th season as head coach at Army and his 13th overall at West Point after serving as the associate head coach in 2005-06.

Magarity led the Black Knights to their third straight Patriot League regular season championship in 2015-16, capping a streak of four straight appearances in a national postseason tournament. Army earned an automatic bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament after also doing so in 2014. The Black Knights appeared in the WNIT during the 2013 and 2015 seasons.

Army completed the best season in team history in 2015-16, totaling a program-record 29 victories as part of a 29-3 overall record to match the Patriot League standard for most wins in a season. The 29 wins also gave Army their fourth consecutive 20-win season to mark the longest streak of that kind in program history.

The Black Knights finished 12-6 in league play last season to earn the third seed in the PL Tournament. They finished 17-1 in league play in 2015-16 last season en route to the No. 1 seed in the PL Tournament, which they won by defeating Loyola 69-51 in the championship game. The team earned the No. 13 seed in the NCAA Tournament, where they fell in the First Round to eventual national runner-up Syracuse.

ALL-TIME QUARTERFINALS

Since the start of the Patriot League in 1990-91, Lehigh is 13-13 in the Patriot League quarterfinal round. Lehigh is 4-4 vs. Army all-time in the Patriot League Tournament, including a record of 2-3 against the Black Knights in the quarterfinal round.

ALL-PARIOT LEAGUE

Senior Quinci Mann (Second Team) and sophomore Camryn Buhr (Third Team) both earned All-Patriot League honors last Friday. Mann became just the fourth Lehigh player in the Patriot League era to earn at least three all-league selections. She previously earned Third Team all-league last season and second team honors as a sophomore, in addition to an all-rookie nod in 2014-15.

Buhr earned the first all-league accolade of her career after a breakout sophomore campaign with 12.5 ppg, a team leading 6.7 rebounds per game, a team-best 43.5 FG% and five double-doubles.

GRUNDHOFFER LEADS THE LEAGUE

Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer has scored at least 20 points in three consecutive games, the first time a Lehigh player has done so since teammate Quinci Mann started the 2016-17 season with three straight games of 20+ points.

She was named the Patriot League Player of the Week on Feb. 27 after collecting 20 points and nine rebounds against Loyola, and a career-high 26 points at Lafayette on 9-of-14 shooting with three three-pointers to lead LU to a 10-point win.

For the week, she led the PL with 23 ppg, and averaged 7.5 rpg, shot 56 percent overall (14-for-25) and 50 percent (4-for-8) from three-point range.

She followed that up on Feb. 28 with game-highs of 24 points and nine rebounds vs. Holy Cross.

It is the second major weekly award for Grundhoffer in her career, and the first for Lehigh since her Rookie of the Week award in Nov. 2016. It was the first PL Player of the Week honor for Lehigh since Lexi Martins in Feb. 2016.

OFFENSE HEATING BACK UP

Lehigh shot a season-best 52 percent (26-for-50) from the field on Feb. 24 against Lafayette. Lehigh is now 3-0 this season when shooting over 50 percent.

SHOOTING FOR THE STARS

Lehigh shot 46.2 percent (66-for-143) over a three-game stretch from Feb. 17-24, their highest percentage over any three game stretch this season.

This followed a three-game stretch from Feb. 7-Feb. 14 where Lehigh combined to shoot 32.4 percent (55-for-170).

HOT DOWNTOWN

Lehigh is shooting 43.9 percent from three-point range over the last three games. The Feb. 21 game with Loyola ended a stretch where LU failed to shoot at least 20 percent from three-point range in three straight games and a stretch of six straight without hitting at least 30 percent.

Through their first four Patriot League home games, Lehigh was 40-for-80 from three-point range.

MANN MILESTONE

Quinci Mann is just three three-pointers away from becoming the third player in school history to reach 200 made threes for her career.

11 of its 18 regular season Patriot League contests, and drew even with Boston University on Feb. 3. Lehigh's rebounding margin in league play is -1.9, which is sixth in the league. Overall, Lehigh is tied for fifth at +0.3.

In non-league play, Lehigh was outrebounded only once in 11 games and held a rebounding margin of +3.9.

KEEPING THEM OFF THE BOARD

Lehigh has held opponents to 56 points or less in eight of its last 13 games, only allowing 60 points in five of those games.

40 PERCENT

Lehigh's win on Feb. 24 at Lafayette moved the team to 13-2 this season when shooting at least 40 percent overall. The team's two losses came on 1/24 at Loyola and 2/17 at Army.

AHEAD OF THE PACK

Hannah Hedstrom has led Lehigh in rebounding in two of the last five games, tying a career-high with 11 against Colgate on Feb. 14 and adding nine on Saturday at Lafayette.

In the Colgate game, she also tied her career-high with five steals and dished out seven assists, her second-highest total of the season.

BERN BABY BERN!

Senior Bernadette Devaney tied her career-high with 20 points on Feb. 21 against Loyola, shooting 7-for-10 from the field and 3-for-5 from three-point range. It was the second 20-point game of her career. Gena Grundhoffer also scored 20 points in the win.

It was the second time this season Lehigh had two players score 20 points in the same game, joining Mann and Devaney (20 each) vs. Mount St. Mary's on Nov. 29.

TOP WOMANN

During league play, Quinci Mann is sixth with 14.9 ppg, is first with a 42.0 3FG% and ranks third with 2.1 three-pointers per game.

Mann has knocked down at least four three-pointers in six games this season and has had three games with at least five triples. It is the most 4+ three-point games she has had in one season.

STORY OF THE FOURTH

Lehigh has been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in five of its last seven games. Lehigh has either tied or been outscored by its opponents in the fourth quarter in nine of its last 13 games.

Overall, Lehigh has outscored its opponents in the fourth quarter in 20 of 29 games this season, but 16 of those came in the first 17 games of the season.

SKIDS IN GROUPS OF FOUR

From Feb. 7-17, Lehigh was held to 52 points or less in four straight games for the first time since a four-game stretch spanning the end of the 2010-11 season, and the first three games of the 2011-12 season, when the team combined for an average of 46.3 points (all four games were on the road).

BETHLEHEM, Pa. – A late rally by the Lehigh women's basketball team fell short on Wednesday night at Stabler Arena, as Holy Cross held on for a 65-62 win. Sophomore Gena Grundhoffer finished with gam-highs of 24 points and nine rebounds and senior Bernadette Devaney scored 16 points on 4-of-7 shooting with four three-pointers. Senior Quinci Mann also added eight points on 2-of-3 shooting from downtown. Holy Cross (12-17, 7-11 PL) finished the game 23-for-52 from the field and 7-for-20 from three-point range, while Lehigh (15-14, 9-9 PL) shot 38.5 percent overall and 11-for-23 (47.8 percent) from downtown. Holy Cross outscored Lehigh 28-16 off turnovers and 22-12 in the paint.

"We struggled in the first half taking care of the basketball, and a lot of turnovers led to a lot of easy buckets for them," said head coach Sue Troyan. "We certainly didn't take care of the basketball, which was a priority coming into the game for us, and it was our Achilles heel in this game."

Grundhoffer and Mann hit back-to-back threes after a 0-for-3 start to get Lehigh within 7-6. Holy Cross then sprinted out on a 9-0 run, starting the game 8-for-11 and 3-for-4 from beyond the arc to take a 19-8 lead, forcing a Lehigh timeout at the 3:43 mark. Lehigh would hold Holy Cross without a field goal the rest of the quarter, as Camryn Benz broke the run with a three-pointer following the break to cut it to 19-11, and Devaney added a three in the final minute to make it 20-14 after one. HC scored the first five points of the second before Grundhoffer broke the run with a three and Camryn Buhr added a long jumper to make it 25-19. Holy Cross went on a 5-0 run following the break after two free throws from a technical foul, and a three-point play to go back up by nine, 30-21. Lehigh responded by closing the half on an 8-0 run to pull within one. Mary Clougherty entered the game and quickly sank a long jumper, Buhr grabbed a steal and went the length of the court for a layup and Grundhoffer capped the run with four from the line to cut it 30-29. Overall Lehigh held the Crusaders to just 25 percent shooting in the second quarter, outscoring them 15-10 and holding them to just one field goal over the final 8:13.

Lehigh outshot Holy Cross 45.5-39.3 percent through the first 20 minutes and 45.5-30.8 percent from beyond the arc.

"Gena's just playing with a lot of confidence and a lot of emotion," Troyan said. "She played with a lot of passion and when she's good, she's really good and makes a big difference. This one's a bit of a tough one to swallow with how well she played. Bernie came off the bench and gave us some great minutes as well."

Lehigh scored the first seven points of the second half, extending their run from the first half to 15-0 to take a 36-30 lead. Holy Cross scored six straight, capped by a steal and basket to tie the game at 36, and eventually grew the run to 15-3 to build a 45-39 lead. Mann hit a floater in the lane and Mae Williams followed with a pair from the line to make it 45-43 before the Crusaders used a layup with 32 seconds left to go up 47-43 after three.

After trailing by as much as nine, Devaney got the team within three at the 4:31 mark with a three before Holy Cross ran off seven straight to go back up by double digits, 61-51. Grundhoffer scored a three-point play after drawing a full with a move underneath and Devaney hit two free throws to make it 61-56 with 50 seconds remaining. Holy Cross would hit one of two free throws before Devaney hit her fourth three-pointer of the night to make it 62-59 with 33 seconds left, and Mann answered for Lehigh with a triple to cut it to 64-62 with 12 seconds remaining. After Lehigh fouled, the Crusaders missed both free throws giving Lehigh one last chance to tie or win the game, but a solid drive to the basket and game-tying look from Clougherty rimmed out.

All told, Holy Cross shot 50 percent in the second half and was 6-for-10 in the fourth quarter.

"We executed down the stretch," Troyan said. "Quinci hit a big shot and Bernie hit a big shot coming out of a timeout. We executed the sideline stuff well and got the shots we were looking for. Mary did a good job getting a good shot at the basket to try and tie it. She can get in the paint and create some things for other people. I thought it was a great shot and if we had to do it 10 other times, I'd have her take the same shot."
