LEHIGH HOSTS NAVY IN PATRIOT LEAGUE QUARTERFINALS

The Lehigh women's lacrosse team is set to kick off the Patriot League Tournament on Monday when it hosts Navy at 1 p.m. in the Patriot League Quarterfinals. It will mark a rematch of a matchup from just 23 days prior when the Mountain Hawks broke open a tight contest with the game's final six goals to pull away, 12-7. The winner of Monday's game will play Army West Point (the winner of the North Division) in the semifinals on Thursday at Loyola.

Recently, the Patriot League announced the reinstatement of the quarterfinal round (rather than four teams advancing to the postseason). The Mountain Hawks own the league's second-best Patriot League record, but the new format features the No. 2 and 3 seeds in each division meeting in the quarterfinals, then facing the No. 1 seed in the opposite division in the semifinals. In the other quarterfinal matchup Monday, Boston University travels to Colgate.

Ever since an 0-2 start, the Mountain Hawks have won seven of their last eight - with the only loss coming at No. 13 Loyola, 15-11, in an extremely competitive contest. Defensively, Lehigh has allowed seven or fewer goals in six of the last eight games while offensively, the Mountain Hawks have scored 18 or more in two straight and three of the last five. In its last two games, Lehigh beat Lafayette, 18-5, then American, 21-6. It marks the first time since the 2011 season that Lehigh has won consecutive games by 10+ goals and first time since 2009 that Lehigh has won consecutive games by 13+ goals. The Mountain Hawks' 21 goals on Wednesday were their most since 2009.

Monday will mark Lehigh's seventh straight appearance in the Patriot League Tournament, with all beginning in the quarterfinal round. The Mountain Hawks are 3-0 at home in the previous six and 3-0 on the road. Monday will be the sixth meeting between Lehigh and Navy in the Patriot League Tournament, with the Mids winning the previous five. The teams met in back-to-back years in 2017 and 2018, with Navy winning a close 9-8 final in '17.

After more than a 10-day layoff, the Mountain Hawks returned to the field on Wednesday vs. American and didn't miss a beat. Lehigh had 10 goals less than midway through the first half and a 14-3 lead with 9:48 still remaining in the first half. Graduate student Sondra Dickey filled up the stat sheet again with five goals, two assists, seven draw controls, two groundballs and a caused turnover. Senior Cecily Redfern tied career highs in goals (3) and points (5). After scoring eight goals in the first meeting with American (a 12-10 Lehigh win), sophomore Katia Carnevale added four more. In the end, the Mountain Hawks allowed just 18 shots and only 12 on goal.

PRONUNCIATION GUIDE

ALL-TIME VS. NAVY

Navy leads the all-time series 13-5 after the Mountain Hawks' snapped a streak of 11 straight Midshipmen wins earlier this season. Lehigh won the first two all-time meetings and four of the first six. In the Mountain Hawks' 11 straight defeats, there were some close contests, including a pair of one-goal defeats - both by 9-8 finals (in 2014 then 2017 in the Patriot League semifinals).

SCOUTING THE MIDSHIPMEN

Navy enters the postseason with an 8-3 record and 4-2 Patriot League mark. The Mids entered the season in the national top 25, but dropped out after three straight losses against Loyola, Drexel and at Lehigh. Since, Navy has won four straight - at George Mason (18-9), vs. Colgate (12-5), at American (20-13) and against Bucknell (14-8). Nicole Victory leads the team in goals (26), assists (14) and points (40). She is followed by Reagan Roelofs (29 points: 18 goals, 11 assists) and Marina Lazarides (28 points: 21 goals, seven assists). Roelofs also leads the Patriot League in draw controls with 84. Christine Fiore leads the team in groundballs (25) and caused turnovers (14). Jo Torres has played the majority of time in goal, tallying a 10.69 goals against average and 46.7 save percentage.

MIDS LAST TIME OUT...

ANNAPOLIS, Md. (4/30/21) - The Navy women's lacrosse team (8-3, 4-2 Patriot League, 2-2 PL South) earned a spot in the 2021 Patriot League Tournament with a 14-8 victory over Bucknell (3-6, 3-5 Patriot League, 1-3 PL South) on Friday evening at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. Offensively, Navy had seven players combine to net 14 goals on the day, including six players who finished with multiple goals. Reagan Roelofs (Apple Valley, Minn.) finished with a team-high three goals to notch her first hat trick of the season and the eighth of her career. Lindsay Beardmore (Annapolis, Md.), Gil Eby (Towson, Md.), Marina Lazarides (Westminster, Md.), Karoline Nease (Richmond, Va.), and Nicole Victory (Issaquah, Wash.) each added two scores apiece, while Grace Zagaja (Centerport, N.Y.) also found the back of the net. Beardmore and Nease led the team with two assists apiece, giving the duo a team-best four points each.

IF LEHIGH BEATS NAVY...

- Lehigh would win a postseason game and advance to the Patriot League Semifinals for the fourth time in the last five seasons.
- The Mountain Hawks would beat Navy twice in a season for the first time in program history.
- Lehigh would win consecutive games vs. Navy for the first time since the first two meetings (2008 and 2009).

LEHIGH IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

- This marks Lehigh's seventh straight appearance in the Patriot League Tournament and 14th overall.
- In the previous six tournament appearances, the Mountain Hawks are 3-3 in the quarterfinal, going 3-0 at home and 0-3 on the road.
- Lehigh has made it to the Patriot League Championship Game once in 2009, falling 11-9 to Navy.

DICKEY WINS NATIONAL AWARD

One day after winning Patriot League Midfielder of the Week, her sixth weekly award of the season, Lehigh women's lacrosse graduate student Sondra Dickey was named the Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) National Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Tuesday, Apr. 20. Dickey filled up the stat sheet on Saturday at Lafayette, which included a career-high six caused turnovers in the dominant 18-5 victory.

O'DONNELL INVITED TO 2021 U.S. NATIONAL TEAM TRYOUT

Lehigh women's lacrosse assistant coach Katie O'Donnell has been named to the official tryout roster for the 2021 U.S. women's national team, as announced in October. One of 50 players invited to try out, O'Donnell has been a member of the U.S. program since graduating from Penn State in 2018.

TRIO OF MOUNTAIN HAWKS RETURN FOR FIFTH-YEARS

Three different Mountain Hawks - Sondra Dickey, Alexandra Ladda and Autumn Ryan - have all returned this season for their fifth years after their senior seasons were cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic. All three are in graduate school. Dickey is working towards a Master's Degree in Management and Ladda and Ryan in Technical Entrepreneurship.

DICKEY BREAKING RECORDS

Graduate student Sondra Dickey is the only player in Lehigh women's lacrosse history in the top 10 in program history in career goals (third, 194), assists (ninth, 55), points (fourth, 249), groundballs (seventh, 137), draw controls (first, 246) and caused turnovers (tied for first, 103). *Please see page five for the complete list.*

SONDRA DICKEY

Head Coach Jill Redfern 13th Season

A National Lacrosse Hall of Famer, Jill Redfern enters her 13th year as head coach of the Lehigh women's lacrosse program in 2021. In her tenure, Redfern has led the Mountain Hawks to nine Patriot League Tournaments in 11 seasons (the 12th was cancelled due to the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020). The Mountain Hawks have qualified for the league tourney in each of the last six seasons (2014, 2015, 2016, 2017 2018 and 2019). In her time, the Mountain Hawks own a 114-83 record, including seasons of 11, 14, 10, 13, 12 and 13 victories, as Redfern continues to take the Lehigh program to new heights.

Redfern was inducted into the National Lacrosse Hall of Fame in September of 2018. During her playing days, Redfern was a two time Division III All-American at Ursinus College and was named Most Outstanding Player of the 1986 NCAA Tournament as she helped lead the Bears to a national championship. Following her collegiate playing experience, Redfern was a member of the US National Lacrosse Team from 1987-1993, and capped off her international play as a member of the winning United States World Cup Team in 1993,

As a coach, Redfern has led Lehigh to sustained success. In 2020, the Mountain Hawks were going strong, recording a 6-2 record when the COVID-19 pandemic cancelled the rest of the season. Lehigh was averaging 14.50 goals per game, led by senior Sondra Dickey and freshman Gabby Schneider. Dickey was sixth nationally goals (32) and 12th in points (42), while Schneider was seventh in assists (21) and 14th in points (41). Dickey became Lehigh women's lacrosse's second student-athlete ever named to the Tewaaraton Award

In 2019, Lehigh bounced back from a tough start to win its final four regular season games for its sixth straight Patriot League Tournament, a program record. Dickey was named IWLCA second team All-Region for a second straight year – only the Mountain Hawks' second two-time honoree since the turn of the century.

The Mountain Hawks posted a 38-17 record from 2016-18, among the most wins in the nation over that three-year stretch. Lehigh tallied a 13-6 record in 2018, including a school-record seven Patriot League wins (compared to just two losses). For the second straight season, the Mountain Hawks earned the No. 3 seed in the league tournament, hostschool-fectors seven Partiot League Wills (Compared to Just two losses). For the second straight season, the Mountain Hawks earned the No. 3 seed in the league to difficult the regular season and beginning of the postseason. The Mountain Hawks dominated Boston University in the Patriot League opener 15-8, handing the Erriers their largest-ever Patriot League defeat. Individually, Dickey emerged in leading the team in goals (54) and points (76). Dickey and Kayleen Kelly each broke the previous school record for draw controls in a season. Kelly broke Lehigh's single-game (10), season (86) and career (169) records for draw controls (which Cecily Redfern and Dickey have since broken), while Dickey added 81, each shattering the previous school record of 47. Both Kelly and Kierstyn Voiro were named All-Patriot League and Academic All-League, impressing on and off the field.

The Mountain Hawks went 12-6 in 2017, including a 6-3 mark in Patriot League play to earn the No. 3 seed in the league tournament where they defeated Bucknell 15-5 in the quarterfinals. It marked the first time in school history Lehigh won a Patriot League tournament game in back-to-back seasons. Allison LaBeau highlighted the victory, setting a Patriot League Tournament single-game record with 11 points, which included a record-tying six assists. LaBeau finished the year with a school-record 46 assists along with 91 points - second in school history. The Mountain Hawks went on to play a hard-fought game against Navy in the league semifinals, dropping a slim one-goal final against a Mids' team that went on to beat Penn, UMass and North Carolina in the NCAA Tournament to advance the Final Four.

Lehigh finished the 2016 season with a strong 13-5 record, including a 6-3 record in the Patriot League. The six league victories marked a school record while the Mountain Hawks hosted a league tournament game, and won a postseason contest, for the first time since 2010. Lehigh beat Colgate in the Patriot League quarterfinals to reach the semifinals for the first time since 2011. LaBeau was named the league's Attacker of the Year while Julianne D'Orazio and Kendall Garden were also named first team All-League, and Lauren

Beausoleil garnered second team laurels. The Mountain Hawks earned a big road victory at Boston University while taking Loyola into overtime during the regular season.

The Mountain Hawks advanced to their second straight Patriot League Tournament in 2015, finishing the season 9-8 highlighted by several quality victories. Included was a thrilling, last-second win at Bryant, a team that went on to win the NEC and advance to the NCAA Tournament. The Mountain Hawks also topped Big Ten foe Rutgers on the road in front of a nationally-televised audience on the Big Ten Network. As a team, the Mountain Hawks finished 2015 with the league's third-best goals against average (8.06) while leading the Patriot Leagué in caused turnovers per game (9.71). Sukonik's 42 goals were firth in the league while LaBeau's 48 points stood eighth. Garden led the league with 31 caused

Lehigh enjoyed a resurgent season in 2014, finishing 4-4 in league play to advance to the Patriot League Tournament for the first time since 2011. Included was a dramatic 12-11 double overtime win at Boston University to hand the eventual league finalist Terriers their first-ever Patriot League defeat. LaBeau scored both goals of overtime as she was named the league's Rookie of the Year. LaBeau was one of five Mountain Hawks to earn All-Patriot League honors as she, Alexandra Fitzpatrick and Willcox were all named to the first team while Garden and Sukonik earned second team laurels. After the season, LaBeau was invited to try out for the U.S. National Team.

Sukonik's All-League honor was her third in as many years as she has posted 98 goals and 14 assists in that span, finishing her storied career with 140 goals and 18 assists. Three Mountain Hawks were named All-Patriot League in both 2012 and 2013: Sukonik (twice), Julie McBrien (twice), Leigh Ann Torcivia and Willcox. Fitzpatrick was named first team All-League as both a freshman (2011) and senior (2014) as one of the nation's elite goalies both seasons. As a graduate student, Fitzpatrick went on to lead the Maryland Terrapins to the National Championship as their starting goalkeeper in

Torcivia and McBrien played in the IWLCA North-South Game in 2012 and 2013, respectively, following Lauren Dykstra, who was named the Game's MVP in 2011. In the summer of 2013, Dykstra became the first Lehigh alum to play in the World Cup as she suited up for Israel. Dykstra finished the tournament with 20 goals (second on the team). She helped propel Israel to the World Cup Quarterfinals in the country's first appearance.

In 2011, the Mountain Hawks advanced to their fifth straight Patriot League Tournament, joining Colgate as the only teams to qualify in each of the previous five seasons. Lehigh also posted an impressive win at Navy in front of a national television audience on CBS Sports Network, joining eventual National Champion Northwestern as the only two teams to defeat the Midshipmen in Annapolis. The Mountain Hawks hung tough on the road against nationally-ranked ALC squads Florida and Penn State, taking an early second-half lead against the Gators, a team which rose as high as No. 2 in the national rankings. Lehigh finished among the national leaders in a number of statistical categories, ranking ninth in scoring margin (4.65), 11th in scoring defense (8.94), 12th in draw controls (13.94) and 13th in scoring offense (13.59).

Redfern helped lead Dykstra, who garnered three postseason All-America honors, which included becoming Lehigh's first IWLCA All-American since 1996. The multi-dimensional Dykstra finished 2011 as the nation's leader in goals per game, winning Patriot League Midfield Player of the

Year to complete the cycle of league major awards; Dykstra previously won Rookie of the Year. Offensive Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year. Redfern also coached Dykstra to a Lehigh and Patriot League record in career goals as Dykstra stands sixth in NCAA history with 257.

During her inaugural season as Lehigh head coach, Redfern led the Mountain Hawks to the fourth most victories in a single season in school annals, the most home wins in

program history and the program's third consecutive Patriot League Tournament berth as Lehigh tied the school mark for the most Patriot League victories in a single season (four). That would be one-upped as Lehigh went 5-1 in league play both in 2010 and '11. Redfern's success continued in 2010 as the Mountain Hawks jumped out to an 8-0 start before winning the Patriot League Regular Season Title and advancing all the way to the Championship Game.

Redfern was named the head women's lacrosse coach at Lehigh on June 23, 2008. Prior to that, she served as the associate head coach of the program. During that time, she helped lead the Mountain Hawks to a pair of Patriot League Tournament appearances and helped mentor 13 All-Patriot League selections, three consecutive Rookie of the Year honorees and a pair of Patriot League Scholar-Athlete of the Year award winners.

In 2008, Redfern brought on assistant coach Kelley Putnam. The two went on to mentor a program record eight All-Patriot League selections, including freshman Kelly Draper who earned the program's fourth consecutive Patriot Léague Rookie of the Year Award - a first for all programs among all sports in Patriot League history. Ředfern was also instrumental in the development of Dykstra who was named Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year, first team All-Region and was selected to the final tryout for the United States Women's Developmental Team.

Redfern's coaching career includes a previous stint at Lafayette College where she garnered Patriot League Coach of the Year honors in 2000 after leading the Leopards to the league title. Redfern also served as an assistant in both the field hockey and lacrosse programs at Lafayette for 10 years before assuming the head coaching position. Including her time at Lafayette, Redfern's career record as head coach is 125-87.

Redfern is a 1988 graduate of Ursinus College, and later earned her master's degree in Educational Leadership from Lehigh in 1991. She was inducted into the Ursinus Hall of Fame in 1998 for her exceptional contributions to women's athletics.
